THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

Cause No. 82 of 1982

Parties:

Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers

and

Association for the Physically Disabled of Kenya

Issues in dispute:

House allowance.

Annual leave travelling allowance.

Medical treatment.

Salary and wages.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Association for the Physically Disabled of Kenya shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 20th December, 1982, and 25th February, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 24th February, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 17th August, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are a charitable organization and derive their funds from donors both locally and in some cases overseas. In addition, until last year, they used to get grants in aid from the government and the Nairobi City Council. These grants, however, were not received by them in 1982. Instead they received K.Sh. 150,000 from the national fund for the disabled. It is interesting to note that out of the revenue needed by the respondents to run their various activities only 10 per cent is from grants in aid and the remaining 90 per cent is from private donors.

The respondents' main concern is the rehabilitation of the physically disabled in Kenya especially young children.

The parties entered into a recognition agreement on 29th April, 1981, with the claimants insisting that this recognition agreement covers all respondents' employees working in their Nairobi branch workshop, Mombasa Likoni workshop, Machakos School for Physically Disabled and Nyabundo Rehabilitation Centre. Their demand is that the award should cover employees at all these places. The respondents, however, have resisted this demand strongly and have pleaded with the court to make its award applicable to their Nairobi activities only.

The court and the parties had before it the reports compiled by the Division of Manpower Planning and Development at the court's request.

The claimants have formulated an elaborate job classification divided into four groups and have demanded minimum wages ranging from K.Sh. 1,200 per month for cleaners to K.Sh. 3,500 per month for physiotherapists. As against this the respondents are paying currently minimum wage as follows:

The claimants in addition to the above extraordinarily high minimum wage of K.Sh. 1,200 have also demanded a further increase of 25 per cent for the first year and another 25 per cent for the second year with effect from 1st May, 1981. The respondents have offered 4 per cent wage increase for the first year and another 4 per cent for the second year.

On housing the claimants are demanding a house allowance of K.Sh. 250 p.m. in addition to the monthly wage for all the employees. The respondents had been paying their employees a consolidated wage from 1976 but since August 1982, they had deconsolidated the wages by identifying 15 per cent of their wages as house allowance.

These two items are by far the most important ones in this dispute and while the court sympathizes with the claimants' aspirations and demands on behalf of their members unfortunately the respondents are not in possessions of funds to meet these demands. The respondents are not as such a profit-making organization. And if they do get some income in their workshop that again goes for the welfare activities which they undertake.

The court accepts the fact that the disabled and able workers should get the same remuneration for the same amount of work they do. There should be no discrimination against disabled workers in this regard.

After a careful consideration of all the submissions made by the parties the court awards with effect from 1st August, 1982, a wage increase of 12 per cent to all the respondents' Nairobi employees on their deconsolidated wages. The court awards a further wage increase of 10 per cent with effect from 1st August, 1983, on the wages as at 31st July, 1983. The court rejects the claimants' job classification and the minimum wages as demanded by them as the court cannot see any justification for this sort of sophistication being introduced in a charitable organization for the time being.

In addition to the 15 per cent deconsolidated housing element the court awards a house allowance to each employee of K.Sh. 50 p.m. with effect from 1st August, 1982.

Annual leave travelling allowance

The court awards a leave travelling allowance of K.Sh. 100 to all the respondents' employees when they proceed on leave. The court feels that the claimants' demand of K.Sh. 300 is very much on the high side.

Medical treatment

The claimants' demand is that the medical treatment should be given as prescribed in the Employment Act (Medical Treatment Rules of 1977) except in emergency cases where an employee shall be allowed to attend a private hospital/dispensary and all expenses incurred should be met by the respondents. The respondents have strongly resisted this demand and in view of the financial set up of the respondents, the court is not inclined to make an award as demanded by the claimants. The court rules that the workers should take advantage of the free medical treatment offered in government and in local authority hospitals and health centres.

The court has carefully considered the question of whether its award should extend to the respondents' undertaking outside Nairobi but in view of the fact that the other institutions although under the name of the respondents are autonomous bodies the court feels that the claimants should negotiate collective agreements with them individually. The court is aware that in the respondents' annual report all their accounts are consolidated but the fact remains that the accounts of each of their sections out of Nairobi are prepared separately. Their incomes are also separate from the head office to a large extent.

The court accordingly rules that its award should apply to respondents Nairobi activities only.






