1. Post title.—CHIEF TECHNICAL ADVISER—Expert in geothermal.

Job description.—KEN-120-2-002-01-M.

Duration.—One year with possibility of extension.

Duties.—In general the chief technical adviser will advise the Technical Division of the Ministry of Energy (MOE) on all aspects of exploration and evaluation of geothermal resources in a project area of about 12,000 km² of the central rift valley in Kenya. Part of the investigations may be carried out under separate foreign aid programmes, bilateral or others. The chief technical adviser will supervise the overall-planning and co-ordination of all the exploration programmes involved and participate as may be required in negotiations relating to various foreign aid programmes whether bilaterally or otherwise financed. Specifically the adviser will in co-operation with experts and consultants provided to the project under the United Nations Development Programme financing:

(1) Review existing scientific and technical documentation regarding geoscientific aspects of the rift valley; and prepare a detailed work plan for the first one to two years of the project operation. This work plan will be revised periodically.

(2) Draft job-descriptions for experts and consultants; supervise drafting of specifications for equipment and services needed by the project.

(3) Supervise collection of data relevant to the development of the geothermal resources. These data will include the location, description, temperature and flow rate of geothermal manifestations (reconnaissance surveys).

(4) Supervise collection and samples and analyses of thermal fluids and interpretation of results.

(5) Supervise detailed geologic and hydrogeological mapping on areas selected on basis of the reconnaissance and geochemical surveys.

(6) Supervise implementation of geophysical surveys of areas of interest and interpretation of geophysical data.

(7) Supervise selection of sites drilling of temperature gradient and or deep, slim diameter exploratory holes, as may be required.

(8) Try to define through integration of interdisciplinary exploration data economically promising geothermal prospects for development. Such prospects should be recorded in preliminary evaluation reports presenting a synopsis of the exploration data, tentative model of the thermal system, an order of magnitude estimate of reserves and recommendations for an exploratory drilling programme.

(9) Supervise and assist in training of counterpart staff in the techniques involved in above work.

(10) Supervise reporting by experts and consultants on their work and findings. Preparation of routine administrative reports.

(11) Custody of U.N.D.P. provided equipment and resources.

(12) Submit to the United Nations (department of technical co-operation for development) and to the government, any partial and/or final reports as may be required, within the period of service.

Qualifications.—Geologist/geochemist with wide experience in exploration of natural thermal areas and appraisal of their potential for geothermal resources development. Administrative experience and experience in organizing and implementing the types of surveys outlined above is very important.

Language.—English.

Background information.—The U.N.D.P. project KEN/70/525, development of geothermal resources, phase I proved in 1970-76 the presence of geothermal energy potential in the Olkaria field of Kenya. This field has since been developed for power. The

first geothermal unit of 15 mW was commissioned in 1981, a second 15 mW unit will follow in 1983-84 and the third unit is being planned. The purpose of the present project KEN/82/002—Exploration for Geothermal Energy, phase III is:

(1) To up-grade the national technical capability for carrying out exploration and development of the geothermal resources of Kenya.

(2) To explore an area of about 12,000 km² in the central rift valley of Kenya in order to identify new geothermal prospects and evaluate their potential.

The programme is expected to take five years and confirm at least three new commercially feasible geothermal projects, where production drilling could start in the late 1980s.

The U.N.D.P. will provide a team of international consultants under the leadership of a chief technical adviser, who will plan and execute the exploration, interpret, evaluate and record the project results, all in co-operation with national counterpart staff. Fellowships will be granted for overseas training (about 90 m/m). Equipment worth about US\$740,000 will be provided.

2. *Post title*.—CHIEF TECHNICAL ADVISER (manpower development).

Job description.—BGD-120-1-065-01-M.

Date required.—September 1983.

Duration.—Three months preparatory assistance (followed by twenty-seven months project work).

THE Kenya Local Government Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Eldoret Municipal Council shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 5th January, and 23rd March, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The claimants also called Mr. Ratemo to give evidence in court.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 29th July, 1981, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 12th July, 1982, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The dispute was originally fixed for hearing on 14th December, 1982, but the parties were not ready to proceed with the hearing.

The grievant used to work for the respondents as a storekeeper in 1979. He was summarily dismissed on 19th June, 1979, under paragraph 25 (e) of the terms and conditions of

service for salaried grades. The facts leading to his dismissal are that a building inspector, Mr. F. K. Kinor, along with his staff demolished an unauthorized structure. After the demolition, the materials, i.e. corrugated iron sheets and timber, were loaded into a lorry and taken to the municipal yard for storage purposes. This was done in two trips and there is no doubt that these materials were unloaded in the yard. They were stocked in an area in the yard which was open. The court was told that the whole yard is enclosed by partly concrete wall but in the main by a timber and wire fence.

There is no evidence before the court that these materials were formally handed to Mr. Ratemo, the storekeeper, although it is obvious that someone working in the store must have opened the main entrance gate to enable the lorries to come in and dump the materials in the yard. Mr. Ratemo while giving evidence stated that when these materials were brought in the yard he was not in the store as he was in town on official duty. He did, however, see them in the yard when he came back. He said he had not been handed officially any part of these materials. His junior had been in the yard in his absence. In addition to him and his junior there was a watchman also who stayed there permanently.

On the evidence before it, the court fails to see how in these circumstances Mr. Ratemo could have been held responsible for the loss of these materials which came to light when the owner came and asked for them. The only point in favour of the respondents is an extract from the minutes of the meeting of the finance staff and general purposes committee where under minute F.71/79 it is recorded:

"Mr. Ratemo after being interviewed admitted that he saw two lorry trips of building materials being brought and unloaded at the stores yard by the building inspector but no delivery record to him was made by the inspector. He also admitted that the action of not recording these particular goods was irregular and contrary to the storekeeping procedures. He stated that at all times he is in possession of the stores keys but did not know how these particular goods disappeared. He also admitted that he was negligent in his duties as a storekeeper thereby causing unnecessary disappearance of these materials."

Mr. Ratemo denied having admitted that he was negligent in his duties as a storekeeper thereby causing unnecessary disappearance of these materials. He said that the minutes are not properly recorded.

The dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour and the ministry's finding was that there was not sufficient evidence to show that the building inspector had delivered to Mr. Ratemo the materials from the demolished structure and if there was any loss of such materials, the inspector should be answerable on his own without his pulling other in the mess. Mr. Ratemo was unfairly dismissed and the ministry recommended that he should be reinstated and paid six months' salary for loss of earnings.

Mr. Ratemo is now working at Webuye paper mills since March 1980 and although the claimants stated that he would like to come back to his old job the court feels that that would not be proper under the circumstances of the dispute.

The court notes that there were about 5,000 items in the store for which Mr. Ratemo was responsible and not even one item was found to be missing.

The court concurs with the findings of the Ministry of Labour that under the circumstances of this dispute Mr. Ratemo could not have been held responsible for the loss of the building materials as they never officially came into his possession because they were not properly handed over to him and it was the duty of the building inspector to ensure that he handed them officially to Mr. Ratemo which he failed to do. The court wonders what the watchman did at the material time.

The court finds that Mr. Ratemo has suffered a wrongful dismissal and it awards that in addition to his lawful terminal benefits he should be paid three months' salary by way of compensation.

THE Kenya Chemical Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Dodhiafoam Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 7th April, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 9th November, 1981, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 10th December, 1982, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The parties signed a recognition agreement following the court award in cause No. 85/79 and thereafter started negotiations for a collective agreement. They have settled all items except the two in dispute. The court would like to record that the agreed effective date of the collective agreement is 1st September, 1980, and the parties are agreed that the duration period should be three years from that date although at one stage, during the hearing, a four-year period was also mentioned but the court finds that three years' duration under the circumstances of this dispute would be reasonable.

The main bone of contention between the parties is that the claimants are insisting that the respondents should adopt and pay the same as far as all the terms and conditions of employment of their employees are concerned as those of their immediate competitors—Vitafoam Kenya Ltd. and Foam Plastics Ltd. The job titles and the various rates for Vitafoam Kenya Ltd. start at the lowest from KSh. 705.55 with effect from 1st May, 1980, going up to KSh. 1,049.75 with effect from 1st May, 1983, and at the highest they start at KSh. 914.85 and go up to KSh. 1,361.20. The wage increments for the first two years is 13 per cent and for the third year is 14 per cent.

Foam Plastics Ltd. job rates are somewhat better than Vitafoam Kenya Ltd. and the wage increment for the first year is 15 per cent, second year 13 per cent and third year 15 per cent.

The claimants stressed that as far as they were concerned they wanted all the workers in this industry to be paid the same rate by all the firms because the operations involved were the same. They strongly resisted the respondents' submission that because they were situated at Ruiru and the other firms were in Nairobi, they should be allowed to have different rates.

The respondents pleaded that they were a Ruiru based company and as they were one of early entrants in the Ruiru industrial scene, they had to train most of their workers as they had no industrial work experience at all. Unfortunately, in 1979, there was a fire which destroyed a substantial part of their factory affecting the areas where slitting and finishing operations were carried out. During the repair period, in order to avoid redundancy, they moved part of the reproduction operations to a temporary godown on Nanyuki Road in Nairobi. The respondents had to airlift replacement machinery from Europe at a very high cost to enable them to continue operations and to keep the workers in jobs. In May 1982, they moved back to Ruiru.

The respondents having suffered an economical set-back were placed in receivership in 1982 and although the receivership has now been lifted, they were still in financial difficulties. They added that while in Nairobi they had increased the wages

of their employees to comply with the Nairobi rates and although they had now gone back to Ruiru those wage rates had been maintained. They made the following offer on the two issues in dispute:

"Minimum consolidated rates of pay per month:

General wage increase:

- (i) The employees who were in the employment as at 31st August, 1980, and were earning more than the rates specified above be granted wage increase of 5 per cent with effect from 1st September, 1980.
- (ii) Those who got increases of less than 5 per cent in July 1981, be granted the difference of their entitlement of 5 per cent wage increase and what they actually got."

The court notes that since this is the parties' first collective agreement the relevant period for determining the cost of increases would be from May or thereabout 1978 to September 1980. The D.M.P.D. report shows that the maximum compensation ceiling under the guidelines would amount to an average wage entitlement of 15.7 per cent for a two-year period.

The court after considering the respondents' financial difficulties finds that it would not be in the interest of the enterprise to impose on them the fairly high wage rates of the other two well-established firms in this industry. The court accepts the claimants' submission that all the firms, in one industry should pay wage rates which are closely allied but that would be a long-term objective as it is not possible just now in the case of the respondents. The court would not like to drive the respondents into liquidation with the consequent loss of employment of all the workers. Keeping these factors in mind and the fact that the parties' collective agreement will be expiring in August this year, the court feels it is not necessary to make any award on the minimum consolidated rates of pay per month. The court, however, directs that during the next collective agreement the parties should adopt the Vitafoam Kenya Ltd. and Foam Plastics Ltd. job titles. The court would like to add that the rates for those job titles will not necessarily be the same and the parties will negotiate those rates taking into account the respondents' financial position at that time.

General wage increase.—The court has decided that the workers should get a 15 per cent wage increase per year with effect from 1st September, 1980, 1st September, 1981, and 1st September, 1982. These 15 per cent wage increases per year should be granted to workers on their wages as at 31st August, 1980, 31st August, 1981, and 31 August, 1982.

The court hopes that with the directives it has given in this award, the parties will be able to achieve a reasonable settlement on the wage rates and general wage increase during the next round of negotiations.
