THE Commissioner of Lands, on behalf of the President, invites applications for alienation of plots in Nakuru Municipality described in the schedule hereto. A plan showing the plots may be seen in the Public Map Office, Lands Building, City Square, Nairobi, or may be obtained therefrom on payment of KSh. 10, post free.

2. Applications may be sent so as to reach the Nakuru District Commissioner, P.O. Box 81, Nakuru, not later than 17th June, 1983, and should not be sent direct to the Commissioner of Lands.

3. The official application forms will be available free of charge from the Lands Office Building, District Commissioner's office, Nakuru, and Nakuru Municipal Council offices. They must be filled in triplicate.

4. Applicants must enclose with their application forms a banker's cheque, postal order, money order or cash for KSh. 1,000 made payable to the Commissioner of Lands, Nairobi, as deposit. Personal cheques will not be accepted.

The deposit will be dealt with as follows:

- (a) Credited to a successful applicant.
- (b) Refunded to an unsuccessful applicant.
- (c) Forfeited if a successful applicant fails to pay for the offer of a plot within thirty (30) days from the date of letter of allotment, and applicant shall have no further claim thereto.

5. Each application should be accompanied by a statement indicating:

- (a) The amount of capital available for the purchase of the plot.
- (b) The amount of capital available for the development of the plot. Attach a bank statement or letter from a bank or other financial institution indicating the amount of development loan they are prepared to give you, if you are allocated with a plot.
- (c) The manner in which it is proposed to raise the balance required for development, if any.
- (d) Full details of any plot owned by the applicant in the town.
- (e) Applicants should give their identity card numbers and their nationalities.

General Conditions

The grant will be prepared under the provisions of the Government Lands Act, and the title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap. 281).

2. The grant will be issued in the name(s) of the allottee(s) as stated in the letter of application and subject to special conditions set out below.

3. The term of grant will be 99 years.

Special Conditions

NO building shall be erected on the land nor shall additional external alteration be made to any building otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the local authority. The Commissioner shall not give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily.

2. The grantee shall, within six calendar months of the actual registration of the grant, submit in triplicate to the local authority and the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the buildings and a system of drainage for disposing of sewage, surface and sullage water) drawings, elevations and specifications of the building the grantee proposes to erect on the land and shall within twenty-four (24) months of the actual registration of the grant complete the erection of such building and the construction of the drainage

system in conformity with plans, drawings, elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner:

Provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in or implied by the Government Lands Act, if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him, on behalf of the President, to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the Commissioner of Lands in respect of any antecedent breach or any condition herein contained.

3. The grantee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.

4. Should the grantee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he/she/they is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid the Commissioner of Lands may (at the grantee's expense) accept a surrender of the land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given—

- (a) within 12 months of the commencement of the term, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 50 per centum of the stand premium paid in respect of the land; or
- (b) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 25 per centum of the said stand premium; or
- (c) in the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made.

5. The land and building shall only be used for shops, offices and flats purposes.

6. The buildings shall not be used for the purpose of any trade or business which the Commissioner of Lands considers to be dangerous or offensive.

7. The buildings shall not cover more than 50 per centum of the land or such lesser area as may be laid down by the local authority in its by-laws.

8. The grantee shall not subdivide the land.

9. The grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such as the Commissioner may estimate to the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost either pay (within seven (7) days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid.

10. The grantee shall from time to time pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner may assess.

11. The grantee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge duties or part thereof except with the prior consent in writing of the President. No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until special condition No. 2 has been performed.

12. Should the Commissioner of Lands at any time require the said roads to be constructed to a higher standard, the grantee shall pay to the Commissioner on demand such proportion of the cost of such construction as the Commissioner may assess.

13. The grantee shall pay such rates, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever description as may be imposed, charged or assessed by the government or local authority upon the land or the buildings erected thereon, including any contribution or other sum paid by the President in lieu thereof.

14. The President or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purposes shall have the right to enter the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground and the grantee shall not erect any building in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of mains or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains.

15. The Commissioner of Lands reserves the right to revise the annual ground rental payable hereunder after the expiration of the 33rd and 66th year of the term granted. Such rental will be at the rate of 4 per centum as assessed by the Commissioner of Lands.

INTERPRETATION APPLICATION RULING

THE court announced its award on 8th December, 1982, and granted wage increases to the workers as follows:

- (i) 5 per cent wage increase on their salaries as at 31st July, 1981.
- (ii) 10 per cent wage increase with effect from 1st January, 1982, on the workers' salaries as at 31st December, 1981.
- (iii) 7½ per cent wage increase on their salaries as at 31st December, 1982.

During the hearing there was no dispute on the point that workers had received a wage increase of 10 per cent as a result of an agreement made between the shopstewards, the workers and the respondents, with effect from 1st January, 1982, and were to get a further increase of 7½ per cent, with effect from 1st January, 1983.

The claimants are interpreting the award to mean that these wage increases which the workers received from the respondents as per above agreement are to be in addition to the court award. For this reason the respondents have left to the court to clarify the issue.

The court would like to draw the parties' attention to the D.M.P.D. report which shows that the workers' entitlement over a period of two years under the guidelines is 20.3 per cent for the two-year period. In view of this if the claimants' interpretation is upheld, then the workers would be getting increases in excess of their entitlement under the guidelines. In any case the court was satisfied during the hearing on the evidence produced by the respondents that their financial position was precarious. The respondents have about 26 workers in their employment and the court did not want to put their jobs in jeopardy when the court announced its award. The position still remains the same.

The court would like to clarify that it did not intend the workers to get 17½ per cent wage increase for 1982 and 1983, over and above the 17½ per cent which the workers had agreed with the respondents and out of which they had already received 10 per cent with effect from 1st January, 1982.

The court rules that the respondents should grant a 5 per cent wage increase to the workers on their salaries as they were on 31st July, 1981. Thereafter the workers are entitled to a 10 per cent wage increase on their salaries as at 31st December, 1982. The respondents have, however, already given the 10 per cent increase but since for the previous six months they had not granted the 5 per cent wage increase as awarded by the court, the workers are entitled to a slight adjustment and payment of those arrears. In other words, the respondents should now work out the wage of all the employees by giving them a 10 per cent wage increase on their salaries as at 31st December, 1981 (which should include the 5 per cent wage increase). They should then deduct the 10 per cent which they have granted to all of them and pay the workers the balance due.

Finally the respondents should grant a further 7½ per cent wage increase on the employees' new salaries as at 31st December, 1982.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 7th April, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 2nd November together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. Otieno worked for the respondents from 9th September, 1973, until 14th September, 1979, when he was summarily dismissed. The incident that led to his dismissal occurred on 14th September, 1979, when at about 5.30 p.m. he was found by the watchman to have hidden a van belt inside his folded apron which he was holding in his hands. The watchman who caught him was Mr. Saviyo who on finding the respondents' property in possession of Mr. Otieno, immediately called the factory foreman, Mr. Omukoko, who came and saw the van belt. The item in question was retained by the watchman and Mr. Otieno was told that his case would be dealt with on Monday when Mr. Goldberger would be in. He was dismissed on 14th September, 1979.

The claimants took up the matter and reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour and the investigator found that the respondents had failed to convince him that they had tried to call the police on 7th September, 1979, and were told that the police did not have transport. The investigator wondered why the respondents did not take Mr. Otieno to the police station. He further found that there was no letter of suspension or termination given to him and that he was still living in the respondents' labour camp. He found the respondents' action unjustified and recommended that Mr. Otieno be reinstated and paid half salary from 14th September, 1979, to date.

The watchman and the foreman both gave evidence in the court and the court was very impressed by their evidence and is accordingly satisfied that Mr. Otieno was found with van belt which he was trying to take out of the company premises in a surreptitious manner. The court accepts the evidence of Mr. Omukoko who said that Mr. Otieno had pleaded with him that "you are like my father, forgive me for this".

Mr. Otieno and the claimants on his behalf have denied that this incident took place but the court does not believe Mr. Otieno's evidence and his story about not having been paid his mid-advance and so on as it is only an attempt to confuse the issue and to side track the court's mind.

In view of the evidence which was given by the respondents' witnesses in such clear and forthright manner, the court is very surprised at the investigator's findings and the court can only conclude that he apparently fell into the trap of confusion Mr. Otieno had created. He obviously overlooked one very important aspect in this dispute which is, of the circumstances under which Mr. Otieno was found trying to remove the property of his employers from the factory premises without proper authority. Apart from the criminal aspect of this incident, it is gross misconduct for which the respondents were entitled to dismiss him summarily under section 17 (g) of the Employment Act.

The court finds that Mr. Otieno deserved a termination for this serious offence which he had committed and the court notes that the employers have offered him KSh. 698 less deductions of KSh. 347. In view of the fact that the respondents did not give him a letter of dismissal, the court awards that in addition to above, the respondents should pay him one month's salary which the court was told was KSh. 600.
