INTERPRETATION APPLICATION

Ruling (2)

THE parties negotiated and entered into a collective agreement at their own level which was effective from 1st April, 1980, for a period of two years. It is a matter of great regret that such enlightened parties having negotiated, concluded and signed a collective agreement themselves soon thereafter were in serious disagreement as to what they had signed! Inevitably the onerous task of telling the parties what they had agreed and to decide for them fell on this court.

The court announced its award on 26th October, 1982, and the claimants made an application for interpretation of the court award on 20th January, 1983. The court heard the parties on 11th February and in order to facilitate the implementation of the collective agreement, the court announced its ruling on the same day in the following words:

1. Having considered the parties' submission, the court finds that the claimants' interpretation in respect of those journalists beyond the seventh and eighth years scales is correct.

2. The journalists should get the increase in accordance with their appointments and not the functions they perform.

Finally the court noted that the journalists benefit according to their salary positions or salary brackets.

The court had earlier in its award directed that the claimants and the respondents should get together under the chairmanship of Mr. Wangia of the Division of Manpower Planning and Development and work out the dues of each and every journalist who is affected by their collective agreement as it was obvious that the respondents had interpreted the agreement to the disadvantage of the journalists.

After the court's interpretation on 11th February, 1983, the Nation Newspapers Ltd., one of the respondents, met the claimants under the chairmanship of Mr. Wangia and the court was told that in a matter of three days all the arrears due to the journalists employed by the Nation were worked out and there was no further area of any disagreement as far as they are concerned.

It is indeed very unfortunate that the other respondents—the Standard Ltd.—have not been able to do the same and although they did meet the claimants under the chairmanship of Mr. Wangia no progress of any consequence was made and the Standard Ltd. moved the court for a further interpretation of the court's award on the collective agreement which the parties themselves had negotiated and concluded. In this application, apart from the seven areas of disagreement in the calculation of arrears which the Standard Ltd. have put forward, they have made a scathing attack on Mr. Wangia and have questioned his impartiality in the matter. Mr. Wangia who was in court and who also made his report to the court stated that the parties as a matter of fact had never reached a deadlock during the meetings he had held and that he had adjourned a meeting of 5th May, 1983, with the intention of continuing the next day and to his surprise the next development was this interpretation application to the court by the Standard Ltd.! The claimants, however, were not as discreet as Mr. Wangia and bluntly attacked

the financial controller of the Standard Ltd., Mr. Wyeth, as being the root cause of all the disagreement in the implementation of the court award. They complained that other members of the management who had played a leading role in these negotiations had deliberately stayed away thus making the parties to make do with inconclusive evidence.

The Standard Ltd. requested the court that they were not prepared to meet under the chairmanship of Mr. Wangia and asked the court to appoint another chairman preferably an auditor. The claimants strongly objected to this suggestion and accused the Standard Ltd. of fiddling with the figures and of trying to erode the authority of the court by not implementing an award which was quite clear.

The court has carefully considered the parties' submissions and rules as follows on the areas of disagreement as put forward by the Standard Ltd.:

- (a) The court is not able to help the parties on deciding what the existing wage records or the actual salaries paid to the various journalists are. This is a matter of verification by the parties and the respondents should make available all the necessary records during future meetings and the claimants should produce if they object to any such records any documentary evidence they may have in their possession to the chairman.
- (b) For the purposes of the implementation of the parties' collective agreement the relevant salary structure is the one as at 31st March, 1980.
- (c) During the hearing it transpired that the anniversary month of each employee is not an area of disagreement as it is a simple matter to determine the date of each journalist's appointment.
- (d) The court has made it very clear in its ruling on the first interpretation application that the percentage increases are to be granted to journalists on their salary positions or salary brackets. The court overrules the Standard Ltd.'s contention that each employee has a job category and whether or not the salary may be higher than the minimum quoted, the percentage increase per annum relates to the years of service detailed. The court has ruled that the percentage increased is to be based on all the journalists' salary positions or salary brackets in which they were on 31st March, 1980. The court would like to draw the parties' attention to pages 2, 3 and 4 of its award where this position has been clarified. The court's decision was arrived at after a careful study of the collective agreement which the parties themselves negotiated and signed. If the Standard Ltd. now find that it was their intention to do that then it is entirely the fault of their own team during negotiations for not having taken care of this particular point. All the evidence leads to the claimants' interpretation being correct and the court upholds it.
- (e) and (f) On the question of lunch allowance and meal award, the court rules that the KSh. 150 lunch allowance during the end of 1980 was consolidated in the journalists' salaries and is not a fringe benefit. This was an agreement made between F. J. Ojiambo, father of the chapel and the then managing director of the Standard Ltd., J. J. Austen Brown. The lunch allowance is part of the journalists' salary for the purpose of working out their salary increases. During calculating journalists' arrears, care should be taken so that the journalists do not get any double payment on this item.
- (g) On the question of merit increases that have been granted to journalists during the lifetime of the collective agreement in dispute, the court directs that such merit increases are not in any way to be offset against the journalists' entitlement under the collective agreement. They are in addition to the benefits awarded by the court but they do become a part of the journalists' salary from the date they are granted so that any percentage increase due after a merit increase has been given will be worked out on the salary inclusive of the merit increase.

The court directs that Mr. Wangia should continue to chair the meetings between the claimants and the respondents but in order to allay the fears of the Standard Ltd., the court has decided to reinforce the independent panel appointing the Chief Industrial Relations Officer or his deputy to assist Mr. Wangia in this exercise.

The court directs the Standard Ltd. to embark on the exercise of working out the journalists' arrears as directed by the court without any further delay.
