### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 4th November, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 13th January, 1983, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The grievant L. Khata worked for the respondents from 24th October, 1978, until 15th August, 1981, when he was dismissed for an alleged misconduct. He was a cabinet maker earning KSh. 933 per month at the time of his dismissal.

The incident that led to dismissal took place on 15th August, 1981, when a telegram was delivered to him sometime in the morning on receipt of which Mr. Khata is alleged to have gone to the office of the personnel officer and created a big commotion by, it is alleged, using insulting language and threatening physical violence against the personnel officer for having withheld the telegram the previous day.

After the above scene in the office of the personnel officer the court accepts the evidence that Mr. Khata came back to his bench and all the other workers gathered around him obviously to discuss his complaint. There was definitely a stoppage of work of productive time but after the supervisor told them to get back to their places of work they obeyed him. In these circumstances it would be stretching it a bit too far to say that Mr. Khata caused an illegal strike.

The court will concern itself with the incident of the telegram and Mr. Khata's alleged behaviour on 14th August. Mr. Khata stated in his evidence that he worked overtime on 14th August in the evening but the relevant records for that day show that he worked overtime during the lunch hour and not in the evening as claimed by him. Furthermore, Mr. Khata claimed that the messenger, L. Kadenge, told him on 14th at 5.30 p.m. when they were going home that a telegram had come for him, Mr. Khata. Mr. Kadenge in his sworn testimony denied having told Mr. Khata any such thing and stated that after collecting the mail he came to the factory sometime after 5 p.m. and did not see Mr. Khata either in the factory or outside at that time or afterwards. It is obvious that one of them was telling lies but in view of the fact that Mr. Khata according to official records was working overtime during lunch hour and not in the evening the court is inclined to believe Mr. Kadenge's evidence. This means that there was no delay, deliberate or otherwise, on the part of the personnel officer or his assistants to deliver the telegram to Mr. Khata. This they did at the earliest opportuninty which was in the morning on 15th August.

The respondents called two other witnesses who confirmed their version of the incident and the court is satisfied that after Mr. Khata had received the telegram on 15th August he did create a very serious commotion in the office of the personnel officer. The noise generated by this incident was heard in other offices.

The court has to determine under these circumstances if Mr. Khata's dismissal was wrongful. The only point in favour of Mr. Khata is that the respondents did not ask him to explain his misbehaviour before summarily dismissing him. Apart from this aspect the court is satisfied that his behaviour regarding

the telegram incident was most unreasonable especially when the contents of the telegram are taken into consideration which simply read "Njoo upesi kesi ya shamba"! In this dispute the court cannot agree with the ministry's finding that the allegations against Mr. Khata had not been conclusively proved and that he had suffered a wrongful dismissal. It had recommended that the dismissal be reduced to normal termination and in addition he should be paid two months' salary by way of compensation.

The court has carefully considered all aspects of this dispute and finds that Mr. Khata's behaviour certainly entitled the respondents to terminate his services but because they did not offer him an opportunity to explain his conduct the court awards that instead of the summary dismissal the respondents should reduce it to normal termination which would entitle Mr. Khata to pay in lieu of notice and other terminal benefits as laid down in the collective agreement which was in force at the time. The court further rules that his notice pay and benefits are to be calculated on the basis of the collective agreement prior to the one which came into effect on 15th February, 1982, as Mr. Khata's services had been terminated before that date. The court would like to add that Mr. Khata should get his house allowance entitlement for the duration of the notice pay. Apart from this award the court rejects all the other demands made by the claimants on his behalf.

### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 31st July, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 22nd March, 1983, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Miss Mberia worked for the respondents as a machinist from November, 1978, until 18th August, 1981, when she was summarily dismissed. The reasons for her dismissal were careless performance of work, behaving in an abusive manner to the supervisor and abusing her workmate who detected the careless performance of her work.

The dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour and the ministry found that the dismissal was rather harsh and recommended that it should be reduced to normal termination.

The claimants have asked the court to award that in addition to her terminal benefits, Miss Mberia should be paid eight months' wages as compensation for wrongful dismissal that she had suffered.

From the parties' submissions and the evidence given by the witnesses called by them the court finds it proved that Miss Mberia did lose her temper when certain articles on which she was working had been found to have certain defects due to poor workmanship. She was asked to remedy the defects three times but on the third occasion she threw them back at the controller, Lucy Wairimu. After that Miss Mberia followed the controller to the ladies' dressing room and there she abused her in Kiswahili and English. The matter was reported to Mr. Mwanja, the production supervisor, who called both of them to his office where Miss Mberia started banging the table and said that Wairimu could rectify the defects herself if they had not been properly stitched. She also challenged Mr. Mwanja to do what he liked.

The court also found it proved that on the following Monday, Miss Mberia had tried to accost and catch Wairimu at the factory gate but Wairimu avoided her and ran into the factory.

The court agrees with the ministry's findings that Miss Mberia was rightly asked to rectify the defects on the materials which was her duty to do and which materials she had initially made badly. It had also been revealed that she had indeed allowed her temper to get the better of her when she threw the materials at Wairimu who had detected the defects. The ministry's findings also confirmed that Miss Mberia's shouting and banging the table while being interviewed by the production supervisor was indeed rude.

The fact, however, remains that this appears to be an isolated incident as there is no real evidence of any unsatisfactory performance on her part or such behaviour prior to this date. For this reason the court confirms the ministry's recommendation that her summary dismissal should be reduced to normal termination which would entitle her to get pay in lieu of notice and other accrued benefits under the provisions of the collective agreement which was in force at time of the incident.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 15th June, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 7th April, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 9th November, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Minister for Labour and Labour Commissioner.

The grievant, Jenifer Atieno Daniel, worked for the respondents from 15th November, 1976, until 19th August, 1981, when she was served with a letter of termination and offered one month's salary in lieu of notice.

In the beginning she worked as an order co-ordinator and apparently worked satisfactorily until the middle of 1980. On 2nd September, 1980, she was transferred from the stores to the head office, with effect from the 4th and assigned duties in the costing section under the cost accountant. It is alleged by the claimants that she was not trained in accounts and her transfer to this section was most unreasonable because she had not been trained for her new duties.

Interestingly she was informed of the reasons for her transfer to accounts department on 15th September, 1980, and the three principal reasons put forward were her inability to cope with her conduct on telephone which left a lot to be desired and her working relationship with her colleagues in the warehouse which it is alleged was very bad and that she had had too many fights. She strongly refuted these allegations.

Between September, 1980 and August, 1981, a couple of letters were addressed to her one of which was headed "first written warning" for an unbefitting and embarrassing behaviour towards L. Njoroge, the sales manager. On 10th December, 1980, another letter was sent to her. The court was told that this was a final warning letter to her. The principal allegation in this letter was that on several occasions when she had been asked or told to do something she had started crying and it was alleged that her crying left her little time to do anything else. The allegation of making private phone calls was made again together with her lack of interest in work. It was also alleged in other letters that she had remained absent without leave or prior permission. The respondents stressed that despite all these warnings and letters to her there was no change in her attitude towards persons placed in authority over her, no improvement in her performance of duties and she continued to absent herself from duty without leave or prior permission. This forced them to terminate her services.

The court finds an unusual feature in this dispute and that is that Miss Daniel's case was discussed at a management meeting sometime in August, 1981, at which the sales manager, J. Mboss and other managers namely J. Wainaina, L. Njoroge, G. Waciuma, F. Mulwa and P. Wangira were present. Arising out of this meeting Mr. Mboss wrote a memo to A. Subai, the personnel and administrative manager with copies to all the other participants in which he stated that the meeting had arrived at the following conclusion regarding Miss Daniel:

"(1) Miss Daniel is not productive where she is.

(2) She should be transferred to some other department and J. Miboss to suggest how to best utilize her—the original idea of sacking her was quashed as it was unanimously agreed that an individual may fail in one area and succeed in another."

Then her new job description was set up.

To this memo Mr. Subai replied by saying that "I wish to refute your assertion that we all agreed unanimously that Miss Daniel should not be sacked. It was a mere general consensus that we should try to retain our employees whenever we possibly can".

The court has carefully examined all the circumstances surrounding this case and finds that the findings of the Ministry of Labour are proper. The ministry found that the respondents did not produce any documents to confirm their allegations of Miss Daniel's shortcomings and she had produced medical certificates regarding her alleged absenteeism. She had worked for the respondents for four years and ten months and her salary had risen from KSh. 1,500 per month to KSh.3,504 per month which means the respondents appreciated her work. The ministry further found that the managing director was misled by the personnel manager in dismissing her services as the managerial staff had decided to transfer her to another department.

The court concurs with the ministry's findings that she has suffered a wrongful dismissal but cannot accept the claimants' demand that she deserves twelve months' salary by way of compensation. The court has decided to award her four months' salary by way of compensation in addition to one month's salary in lieu of notice and her other terminal benefits and awards accordingly.
