Parties:

Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers and

Nararashi Wholesalers (K) Limited

Issue in dispute:

House allowance.

Wages.

Effective date and duration.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Nararashi Wholesalers (K) Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nainobi on 10th June and 15th July, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. Originally the hearing had been fixed for 12th May, 1983, but the respondents failed to submit their memo in time with the result that the hearing had to be re-scheduled.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 9th July, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 31st January, 1983, together with the statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner.

The parties had negotiated a collective agreement which was effective from 1st August, 1978. Since then there has been no collective agreement for the reason which appears to be connected with the issue of hours of work and overtime. The claimants accused the respondents of having violated the 45 hours per week clause in the agreement by making their employees work from 7.15 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. from Mondays to Saturdays without paying them the proper overtime. The matter dragged on and although during the hearing of this dispute the claimants made vigorous submissions on the issue of overtime and the arrears that were due to their members, the fact remains that neither the issue of overtime nor the payment of any arrears in respect thereof is an issue in dispute before the court. In this dispute the court is precluded from looking into these items and the claimants would be well advised to follow the laid down machinery if they want to seriously pursue their demands in respect of these items. The court will address itself to the aforesaid stated three issues in dispute.

On 5th January, 1981, the claimants submitted to the respondents proposals to review the 1978 collective agreement. The respondents appeared not to have been very keen to meet the claimants for negotiations and the claimants were forced to report a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour on twenty-one items on 12th February, 1981. The dispute was accepted and then there appears to have been some delay at conciliation because of the conciliator having been changed twice. In the end the parties are deadlocked on the three items only.

On the issue of wages the claimants have put forward proposals by increasing the existing minimum rates for the seven grades by between 8.7 per cent going up to 50 per cent giving an average of 36.6 per cent. On top of this the claimants are demanding a wage increase of 24 per cent each year for those earning up to KSh. 900 per month and 20 per cent each year for those earning above KSh. 900.

The claimants' main argument in support of their demand on wages and house allowance is that the respondents' competitors who are in the same business but on a much smaller scale than them are paying wage rates and house allowance far superior than the respondents. They also accused the respondents of misleading the court and strongly submitted that the respondents being under the ownership of prominent Kenyans should take a lead and set an example for other business enterprises to follow.

The respondents have put forward a plea that they are in serious financial difficulties and are not able to meet the claimants' demands. They attributed their financial trends in the drinking habits of various factors like changing trends in the drinking habits of the patrons who now prefer to drink in the suburbs of Nairobi than the centre of the city and certain amount of financial mismanagement. They disclosed to the count that they were operating on an overdraft of approximately six million shillings. The claimants, however, took them to task over this by pointing out that the bank statements which the respondents had produced had not taken into account the commission that the respondents earned from the business.

The D.M.P.D. report reveals that the scope of labour costs under the guidelines for the period August, 1978 to July, 1980, is 15.2 per cent and for the period August, 1978 to March, 1983, the average would be 64 per cent and up to 73.7 per cent for lower income.

The respondents have offered a 7 per cent increase each year the first increase, effective from 1st March, 1983, as they strongly pleaded that they cannot afford to pay any arrears.

On house allowance the claimants' demand is KSh. 200 per month for employees earning up to KSh. 900 per month and KSh. 250 for those earning above KSh. 900. The respondents have rejected this demand and have submitted that they should be allowed to continue paying consolidated wages as in the past.

Finally the claimants have demanded that the effective date should be 1st August, 1980, for a period of two years but during the hearing they stated that they would not be opposed to having a four year agreement with the expiry date being 31st July, 1984. The respondents on the other hand have asked for the effective date to be 1st March, 1983.

The court is very concerned that the respondents' employees have not had a wage increase from 1st August, 1980, to date. There seems to be no valid reason why they were deprived of the wage increases in these days of high inflation. The full compensation percentage due to the workers under the guidelines is between 58.4 per cent to 77.9 per cent. This is three-quarters of the full rate compensation. Since the court is not satisfied as to the respondents' financial inability to pay the workers their dues the court has decided to award the workers their wage increases, with effect from 1st August, 1980, but the house allowance award will be effective from 1st August, 1982. The court awards the following wage increases:

- 10 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1980.
- 10 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1981, on the employees' salaries as at 31st July, 1981.
- 12 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1982, on the employees' salaries as at 31st July, 1982.
- 12 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1983, on the employees' salaries as at 31st July, 1983.

House allowance.—The court awards that the workers in addition to their wages should be entitled to a house allowance of KSh. 90 per month, with effect from 1st August, 1982.

Effective date and duration.—The court awards the effective date to be 1st August, 1980, and in view of the parties' submissions that they would not mind a four-year award, the court awards the duration period to be four years from 1st August, 1980.

Issue in dispute:

Demotion of Mohamed Tajiri from bus inspector to a P.S.V. conductor.

THE Transport and Allied Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Kenya Bus Services (Mombasa) Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents. 2. The parties were heard in Natirobi, on 18th July, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The respondents also called J. O. Ocharo to give evidence on oath.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 19th November, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 5th April, 1983, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

In this dispute the grievant who had been promoted to the post of inspector by the respondents and after about three months was demoted to his previous post of conductor, is fighting to get back his promotion on the ground that he was unfairly demoted and that the respondents had no grounds for doing so.

He was selected for the post of inspector traince, with effect from 1st December, 1980, and on 24th April, 1981, he was confirmed inspector No. 4, with effect from 1st March, 1981, and he was informed that his probation period started from that date. It is not disputed that while as a traince inspector there were no complaints against him and there is no evidence either of any offence having been committed by him during the three months' period from 1st March, 1981, although there is a reference of an offence in the letter informing him of his demotion on 22nd June, 1981.

The evidence on which the respondents relied in demoting Mr. Tajiri was an unsigned secret observation of respondents inspectors and conductors on duty by a secret informer which led the claimants to make an allegation that the respondents acted on nameless allegations and the court may add faceless too! The court while appreciating the respondents' motives in trying to track down their defaulting employees must, however, point out that an employee against whom certain allegations are made should be given an opportunity to face his accuser and ask him appropriate questions in his defence. In the absence of such an opportunity the secret informers can cause immense mischief to the detriment of the employees. For instance, the secret informer alleged that Mr. Tajiri let five lorries to pass without tickets on 17th May, 1981, but the claimants pointed out that the regular forry users of the ferry never paid any cash as they had running accounts with the respondents.

This dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour and the court is not supprised that the ministry's finding was that the respondents had erred when they did not caution Mr. Tajiri or warned him about his weaknesses as an inspector on probation. The ministry found that the respondents had relied on hearsay when arriving at a decision that would affect Mr. Tajiri as a result. The ministry expected the respondents at a meeting of 19th June, 1981, to have extended his probationary period rather than demote him and recommended that he should be reinstated to his position as an inspector and be paid any arrears arising out of his demotion.

The only worthwhile point which the respondents have put forward is that from 23rd June, to 9th August, 1981, Mr. Tajiri had not reported for work and that the claimants had not even claimed any dues for this period on his behalf. On 7th August, 1981, a joint meeting was held between the parties at which a decision was taken that he should be reinstated in his former job as a P.S.V. bus conductor, with effect from 10th August, 1981. Considering all the circumstances of this dispute the court feels that it would not be fair to penalize Mr. Tajiri for this absence which the claimants attributed to a great psychological stress on him when he was faced with the prospect of going back and working with people whom he used to supervise.

The court has carefully considered all the submissions and supports the findings of the ministry. The court, however, feels that although Mr. Tajiri should be reinstated to the post of inspector he should not be awarded any arrears for the period that he was demoted.

The court accordingly awards that Mr. Tajiri should be reinstated to the post of an inspector with the respondents, with effect from the first of the month following the date of the court ward. The court does not award him any arrears.
