THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Milling Corporation of Kenya Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 17th August, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions

AWARD

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 18th January, 1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 11th May together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner

This dispute has arisen from the parties' attempt to conclude the first ever collective agreement between them as they signed a recognition agreement on 6th March, 1980. On 21st November, 1980, the claimants asked the respondents in view of the Waruhiu commission report to commence negotiations on terms and conditions of employment of their employees who number 256 (as at 30th June, 1983) out of which 184 are unionizable. The respondents asked for negotiations to be postponed as they were going through a difficult time due to shortage of maize. The claimants, however, were not prepared to wait and submitted their proposals on 16th January, 1981. The respondents were not able to start any negotiations and the claimants reported a trade dispute to the minister on 20th March, 1981.

On 3rd April, 1981, the respondents gave an indication that they might commence negotiations as a result of which the ministry advised the parties to meet and discuss the issues in dispute at their own level within four weeks. The parties met but were not able to agree on eighteen items. Subsequently conciliators were appointed by the ministry and the parties were able during the next few months to settle all items except the three in dispute. The last conciliation meeting was held in Nakuru, on 18th January, 1983, where the parties detailed their final positions.

The claimants supported their demands on the items in dispute by quoting the collective agreement which they had with the National Cereals Board and argued that since the board owned the respondents, there was no reason why the same terms and conditions of employment could not be applied to the respondents' employees. The claimants criticized the management for awarding themselves salary increases and overlooking other workers and bitherly complained that at the moment the respondents were paying a consolidated wage of KSh 480 only. They also accused them of having shown the depreciation rates at a very high level in their accounts and maintained that they had the necessary funds to meet the demands which they had made. They insisted that the effective date of the agreement should be 1st January, 1979, for two years so that as soon as the award is announced they can start negotiations with the respondents all over again.

The respondents pleaded that they were a very young miller as they had started their operations in 1977 and currently their accumulated loss stood at KSh 29,833,761 and strongly resisted the backdating of the collective agreement saying that there was no logic in the claimants' demand to commence it from 1st January, 1979. They proposed the effective date to be 1st January, 1983, for two years.

The court has gone through various documents produced by the parties and their submissions and the report from the

Division of Manpower Planning and Development of Ministry of Labour and has decided to make the following award on the three issues in dispute

Basic wage—The court awards the following basic wages per month and house allowance for the various job groups

General wage increase—The court awards that all the respondents' employees from the effective date should be brought up to the aforesaid basic minimum wage and then on top of that they should be granted the following wage increases

The court would like to add that the respondents clearly informed the court that they would have no objection to this type of an award being made
