THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

CAUSE No. 48 of 1983

Parties:

Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers and

Doughty Limited

Issue in dispute:

Wrongful dismissal of Raphael Kamau.

THE Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Doughty Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 10th and 11th October, 1983, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses:

Claimants.-R. Kamau.

Respondents:

- J. S. K. Dass.
- B. Francis.
- S. Nderitu.
- S. Waweru.

Award

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 18th February, 1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 3rd June, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The grievant, R. Kamau, worked for the respondents from 15th June, 1976, to 31st December, 1981, when he was dismissed for refusing to obey a lawful order.

It is alleged that on 30th December, at about 3 p.m. he was asked by his supervisor to clean his place of work which the court was told was the grease ramp and the used oil dustbin which was at a distance from the ramp. The supervisor told him to clean the oil which Mr. Kamau had spilled near the used oil dustbin where he was pouring the oil which he had drained from a car at the ramp. Mr. Kamau refused to do so saying that he was a mechanic and hot a sweeper. The supervisor reported the matter to the workshop manager, B. Francis, who called Mr. Kamau and instructed him to go and clean his work place meaning the oil which he had spilled near the used oil dustbin. Mr. Kamau again refused. workshop manager then took him to the service manager, J. K. Dass and explained to him what had happened. The service manager then asked Mr. Kamau to clean the area but he refused despite the fact that he was told that it was a normal practice for mechanics to clean their place of work. He was given time to think and then the shopstewards were called and another senior mechanic was also called. They all tried to persuade him to do as he was told but Mr. Kamau remained adamant. By then it was 4,30 p.m. and the service manager asked Mr. Kamau to come back the next day on 31st December, when he was again asked if he was going to clean as ordered and he refused and stated that he would rather be sacked because he was a mechanic and not a cleaner. It was then decided to dismiss him.

The claimants' story on the other hand is that Mr. Kamau was asked by his supervisor on 31st December, at about 11 a.m. to sweep the whole workshop which he being a mechanic refused. The claimants stressed that there was no dispute on the point that all the mechanics were required to clean their working bay or working area and Mr. Kamau had no objection to that but he had objection to sweeping the whole workshop. This, they submitted, was outside his job description and therefore he had every right to disobey an unlawful order.

The dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour whose finding was that Mr. Kamau during his five year service had a clean record with no warning letters but it was surprising that he had refused to clean his bay despite specific instructions from three members of the management and the shopstewards. He therefore refused to comply with a lawful order. The Ministry found that the termination was justified and lawful and rejected the claimants' demand.

During the hearing the court heard the evidence from Mr. Kamau and the respondents' witnesses—the workshop manag

the then service manager, a senior mechanic and the shop-steward, W. Waweru. From the evidence given by these witnesses the court is satisfied that Mr. Kamau was not asked to sweep the whole workshop but that he was asked to clean the area near the used oil dustbin where he himself had spilled oil. The court is also satisfied from the documentary evidence that on 3ltst December, there was no car on which Mr. Kamau was working at the greasing bay as claimed by him and rejects his story that the instructions were given to him on 31st December. The court accepts the evidence of the respondents' witnesses that the whole incident started in the afternoon of 30th December. The court cannot conceive for a minute that such senior officers working for the respondents would be a party to a conspiracy to sack a greaser and in doing so would come and commit perjury.

The court notes that the respondents did not hurriedly dismiss him—in fact it appears that all the way from his supervisor right up to the service manager and the two shopstewards begged him to clean his place of work and keep his job but Mr. Kamau remained obstinate throughout. The court supports the ministry's finding and recommendation in this dispute and is satisfied that Mr. Kamau deserved dismissal. The point raised by the claimants regarding the convening of the local negotiating committee meeting, etc. are minor technical points and have really no bearing on the case.

The court cannot help an employee who was literally begged by all the members of the management to obey a reasonable order which was within his duties to perform and which he refused to obey and declined by saying that he would rather be sacked. The court rejects the claimants' demands made on his behalf and upholds the respondents' action.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

Cause No. 57 of 1983

Parties:

Kenya Engineering Workers' Union and K. Kay Engineering Services Ltd.

Issue in dispute:

Dismissal of Paskal Ockech.

THE Kenya Engineering Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and K. Kay Engineering Services Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 24th October, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The respondents also called C. G. K. Kuhle to give evidence on oath.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 15th November, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 10th June, 1983, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

In this dispute the grievant worked for the respondents for one and a half years only. During this period he was warned four times and on his fifth misconduct he was dismissed.

The dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour, whose findings established that there was no warning clause in the parties' collective agreement with the result that the parties' relationship in this particular regard was subject to the general order. In this event Mr. Ockech had four written warnings which were above the requirement of the order. The Ministry upheld the summary dismissal meted out to him. During the

hearing, the claimants did not produce any convincing arguments which would persuade the court to go contrary to the ministry's findings and recommendation.

The only point which the claimants put forward was that Mr. Ockech's removal from the membership of the works committee had not been notified to the respondents officially therefore he had every right to attend a meeting of the committee from which he was ordered out and which order he refused to obey. The facts regarding this particular meeting were narrated to the court by the respondents' managing director, C. G. K. Kuhle, who told the court that the claimants' works committee had asked him to attend a meeting at which they wished to make a request for a loan from the company to all employees for school fees. The committee members were present in the works manager's office and Mr. Kuhle was then called. Soon after his arrival Mr. Ockech also came into the room. The managing director inquired from the committee if he was a member and they all denied that he was. Mr. Kuhle then asked Mr. Ockech to leave the room and he flatly refused to do so. Thereafter two committee members, i.e. Mr. Ockech's workmates physically romoved him from the room and the meeting continued. The court is satisfied from this incident that although Mr. Ockech at one time was a member of the committee, the workers had lost confidence in him and they no longer treated him as a member.

The claimants' contention that unless they informed the respondents about a change in the meinbership of the works committee the respondents could not recognize any changes, is rather far fetched and impracticable under the circumstances. The managing director was guided by the workers themselves on this issue and in any event it is the workers who elected the works committee. This, however, is besides the point. The fact is that at that meeting the managing director gave him an order to leave the meeting because all the workers told him that he was no longer a member and Mr. Ockech refused to obey that order which under the circumstances was lawful. He should have obeyed the order then and taken up the matter about his membership through the claimants with the respondents in due course. He had no business to misbehave at the meeting which resulted in his removal by two of his colleagues.

The court cannot understand why these four previous warnings were not challenged by Mr. Ockech or the claimants at the time they were issued, instead they challenced their validity during the hearing of this dispute. Their attempts, however, to prove that the warning fetters were not justified have failed and the court is of the view that this worker instead of being productive was, to put it mildly, destructive. He damaged the company property and on one occasion he was partly responsible for breaking a new vice. On another occasion he made an ID fan short by two inches and to make matters worse someone other than the management had altered that letter of warning which is a crude forgery. It does not need much imagination to guess who did that. Then there is the occasion when he was given a gate pass to go to the respondents' private doctor, Dr. Taylor, but instead of going there where he would have been attended to expeditiously he chose to waste the whole day at Kenyatta National Hospital where he was examined at 6.30 p.m., by Dr. M. Patel, who in the end stated that no abnormality was found on the body of Mr. Ockech.

The court must say that this is one case which should not have come before the Industrial Court as it was an utter waste of time. The claimants had absolutely no case whatsoever and the court must reject their claims for his reinstatement or payment of compensation. He is entitled to only what the respondents have offered him when handing out a summary dismissal.

Finally the court would like to record that the claimants withdraw their claim for underpayment on Mr. Ockech's behalf because he had all along claimed that he had a grade 3 trade test whereas Mr. Wamalwa, who appeared on his behalf conceded that he could find no record of him having obtained a grade 3 trade test.






