Dismissal of Elijah Kinywee.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Kenya Farmers Association (Co-operative) Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 11th January, 1984 and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The respondents also called the following witnesses:

A. K. Gakena.

H. R. ole Kulat.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 20th May, 1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 24th August together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The grievant, E. Kinywee, started working for the respondents since 1966 and was dismissed on 11th March, 1981. It is not seriously in dispute that for all these fifteen years he had a clean record as no warning letters issued to him were produced during the hearing.

The circumstances leading to his dismissal are that on 4th March, 1981, he sought permission from his immediate manager to see his in-laws. The manager denied this leave because Mr. Kinywee refused to disclose to him the reason why he wanted to go and see his in-laws. The grievant, however, insisted that he be granted such leave with the result that the manager telephoned the personnel manager in Nakuru about the matter. During the telephone conversation between the two the personnel manager asked the Mombasa manager to go and inquire from the grievant the reason why he wanted leave to which again Mr. Kinywee refused to divulge the reason and on hearing this the personnel manager ruled that he should not be granted leave.

Mr. Kinywee even suggested to the manager that in order to compensate for the time that he was on leave he was prepared to work outside the normal working hours but because that was not possible the manager turned that idea down. When the leave was refused Mr. Kinywee worked on 5th March but on 6th and 7th March he did not go to work and came back on the following Monday and started working without even telling the manager where he had been. The manager called him and asked for an explanation to which he was told that he had gone to see his in-laws at Machakos.

The manager had informed the head office on 6th March about Mr. Kinywee's absence and on 9th March he sought guidance from the head office. He was instructed that Mr. Kinywee should be dismissed. The manager told him verbally about the decision which was later confirmed in writing by the personnel manager dated 11th March, 1981. The reason for the dismissal was that he had committed an act of insubordination which could not be tolerated.

The aforesaid facts were confirmed in evidence by the respondents' witnesses and were not really challenged by the claimants. The claimants, however, vigorously argued that the management's refusal to grant him leave was most unreasonable and they very much doubted if the Mombasa manager had communicated the truth to the personnel manager at Nakuru. They also referred the court to clause 15 in the parties' collective agreement under the heading of absence from duty which reads:

"Absence from duty without leave or lawful cause shall be treated as an offence and shall be without pay. Deductions from salaries/wages in respect of such absence shall be calculated on the hourly rate up to seven consecutive days. Should an employee remain absent for more than seven days without permission or lawful cause he shall be deemed to have terminated services at his own will."

The claimants argued that Mr. Kinywee could have been absent for seven days and would have been penalized only by way of deductions from his salary but because he took the responsible action of asking for leave which was unreasonably refused he was dismissed.

The respondents termed the claimants' submissions as baseless oratory and insisted that Mr. Kinywee had committed his fifteen years' service without any warnings but pleaded that an act of insubordination and insolence. They admitted an act of insubordination and indiscipline could not be tolerated. They added that Mr. Kinywee had refused all along to give the pressing reason why he wanted to see his in-laws and he chose defiantly to remain absent. As far as clause 15 was concerned the respondents submitted that it was to discourage workers from remaining absent without due reason.

The dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour who found that since Mr. Kinywee had worked faithfully for fifteen years without any warning letter he deserved a much more lenient treatment for his action and his case should have been viewed within the provisions of clause 15 of the parties' collective agreement. A warning letter and perhaps loss of wages for the days of absence would have sufficed. As a result the ministry found that he had suffered a wrongful termination and recommended that his dismissal should be reduced to normal termination with terminal benefits and eight months' wages by way of compensation.

The court finds that this to be a rather interesting case because Mr. Kinywee could have been absent without leave or lawful cause for up to seven days before he could have been deemed to have absconded. He did not, however, choose to remain absent in this manner but instead asked for permission which was refused. He then defied the management and helped himself to two days off. So under the circumstances he was absent without leave. Clause 15 clearly covers cases of absence from duty without leave and the court can see no reason why he should not have been treated within the provisions of that clause. The mere fact that he applied for leave which was refused would not take his absence from duty outside the provisions of this clause. Had the parties' collective agreement not contained a clause of absence from duty as in clause 15 then Mr. Kinywee's action would have certainly amounted to grave insubordination and insolence but even then the court doubts if in view of his clean record of fifteen years he would have merited dismissal or termination. A warning would have been more appropriate.

The court has carefully considered all aspects of this dispute and finds the ministry's findings to be correct and reasonable under the circumstances. The court accordingly awards that the respondents should pay Mr. Kinywee his terminal benefits plus four months' salary by way of compensation for the wrongful dismissal that he has suffered.
