IT IS notified for general information that this year's Administrative Officers' Examination will be held on Wednesday, 22nd, Thursday, 23rd and Friday, 24th August, 1984, in accordance with the provisions of Personnel Circular No. 1 of 4th February, 1971.

#### SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

2. The examination will consist of the following six test papers, held over three days as follows:

#### Wednesday, 22nd August, 1984

- (1) Law (Parts I and II) 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
- (2) Government Organization and Practice, 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Thursday, 23rd August, 1984
  - (3) Civil Service Regulations, 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
  - (4) Public Financial Management and Control, 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

#### Friday, 24th August, 1984

- (5) General Knowledge of East African and World Affairs, 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
- (6) Applied Logic and Report Writing, 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.
- 3. There is no change to the syllabi given in Appendix "B" to the Personnel Circular No. 6 of 1970.

#### FUGIRILITY TO ENTER

4. The examination is open to administrative officers in the service, serving either as administrative officers in the provincial administration, assistant secretaries in the ministries or second/third secretaries in the foreign service.

#### EXEMPTIONS

- 5. (a) Candidates who have attempted this examination before and passed in one or more subjects will be exempted from those subjects they passed. They will have to resit only those subjects they failed.
- (b) Serving officers with legal qualifications from accredited universities may, on application to the Permanent Secretary, Office of the President, Nairobi, be exempted from sitting Part I of the Law Paper. Exempted candidates must quote reference numbers of their letters of exemption when they submit their entry forms.

#### ENTRY FEE

6. Each candidate will be required to pay a registration fee of KSh. 100 only, regardless of the number of subjects to be attempted. The fee should be paid in either crossed money/postal order or cash, payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Nairobi. Personal cheques will not be accepted. The fee is not refundable.

#### EXAMINATION ENTRY FORM

7. Candidates are required to complete the entry form in triplicate as set out in the Appendix to this circular letter.

The forms should be reproduced and cyclostyled by each ministry/department as necessary, as no further supplies will be obtainable from this office.

The completed entry forms, accompanied by the correct registration fee should be submitted through the Permanent Secretary, Office of the President, Harambee House, Nairobi, to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Nairobi, so as to reach him not later than Friday, 22nd June, 1984. Under no circumstances will late entries be accepted.

The Permanent Secretary, Office of the President is asked to ensure that all entry forms are properly filled in accordance with paragraph (4) above.

#### **EXAMINATION CENTRES**

8. The provincial headquarters in Mombasa, Nyeri, Embu, Nairobi, Nakuru, Kakamega, Kisumu and Garissa will be the centres for this examination. Centres outside Kenya may be established for the eligible candidates in the foreign service.

#### EXAMINATION PAPERS AND STATIONERY

9. Arrangements for the issue of examination test papers and stationery, appointment of invigilators, arrangement for examination venues will be made by the provincial education officer in each centre.

Candidates will, however, provide their own rulers, pens and ink. They may also bring their own law text books to be referred to during Part II of the Law Paper if they are presenting themselves for the same. The provincial education officers

are, however, requested to ensure that the relevant law books are available at their centres for the candidates' use during Part II of the Law Paper.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 80 of 1983

Parties:

Jos Hansen & Soehne (E.A.) Ltd.

Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers

Issue in dispute:

Redundancy.

Jos Hansen & Soehne (E.A.) Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 22nd and 23rd Nevember, 1983, and 8th March, 1984, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

#### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 27th May, 1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 13th September, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The claimants started their operations in Kenya in July, 1953, with a workforce of twelve. Now they have two branches in addition to Nairobi, at Mombasa and Eldoret, and have ninety-two people working for them. During all these years they have not declared any employees redundant and this is the first application since they started operating in Kenya to declare nineteen of their workers redundant. This was the figure with which they started the redundancy exercise but during the hearing they informed the court that now they wanted to declare redundant only fifteen employees. It appears that four workers left the employment for one reason or the other. The point is that these four are no longer in the claimants' employment.

The main reasons why the claimants want to take this most unpleasant and extreme step are because of the imposition of the custioms duty on the components of the pumps which they used to import and assemble here but had now decided to discontinue this practice and import complete pumps as they are cheaper that way. Further the claimants had suffered due to the restricted number of import licences granted to them. They gave details of how their business had deteriorated because of the reduction in the value of their approved import licences.

The claimants are engaged in three main activities namely office machines, water pumps and accessories and pharmaceutical products and stated that they needed at least imports valuing 37 million shiffings per year to remain in business with the same number of employees. They pleaded that they had not declared dividend for the shareholders for the last three years and their losses exceeded over one million shiftings. They pointed out that the government owed them a lot of money which was coming in extremely slowly if at all and as a matter of fact three quarters of their overdraft was pegged against government debt of about 1.2 million shiftings.

The respondents have naturally very strongly resisted this application and emphasized that the economy was now improving and that the import licences worth 17 million shillings had been approved for the claimants. They also relied on the analysis prepared by the Division of Manpower Planning and Development which they claimed indicated that there was no need for any redundancy in the claimants' undertaking. The respondents were particularly opposed to the post of technical manager who they claimed was not really needed. They also stressed that the 1983 accounts had not been tabled by the claimants.

The court has carefully considered the parties' submissions and the D.M.P.D. report and it has also noted that the claimants dubbed the D.M.P.D. report as being biased against them.

The original nineteen employees who were to be declared redundant were made up as follows:

The court finds that the claimants have made out a case for some redundancies but certainly not to the extent of fifteen as they wanted. The main area where they have convinced the court that some redundancy is necessary is the one concerning the assembly of the pumps which they used to do previously but have now discontinued because of the heavy customs duty. In the other sections only a couple of other employees need to be declared redundant.

The court must emphasize that it is extremely particular about matters of redundancy but then there are situations where this most unpleasant exercise has to be undertaken in the wider interest of the undertaking which otherwise would collapse and lead to the loss of the employment of the whole workforce.

The court awards that the claimants declare only six employees redundant as stated below and not fifteen for which they had made the application:

The count directs that the claimants may declare the aforesaid six employees redundant and this exercise should commence from the first of the month following the count award. Each one of these employees should be paid their benefits strictly in compliance with the parties' collective agreement.

Finally the court orders that as and when the need arises for the claimants to take on new employees due to improved economic conditions then these six employees should be given first preference in their respective jobs provided they are still unemployed at the time.
