Issue in dispute:

Termination of services of Peter Kimani Kaime.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Weithaga Secondary School shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 12th March, 1984, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The claimants also called Peter Kaime to give evidence.

Award

3. The Minister for Labour forwarded this dispute to the court on 19th October, 1983, in accordance with section 8 of the Trade Disputes Act.

The grievant, P. Kimani Kaime, was employed by the respondents on 1st January, 1972, as a night watchman. The respondents were under harambee management at the time and when the government took over the school he was issued with a letter renewing his appointment.

On 22nd February, 1979, he was informed that the board of governors had a meeting on 20th November, 1978, and had decided that his services should be terminated with effect from 28th February, 1979, and he would be paid three (3) months' salary in lieu of notice. The reason for the termination was that the school was dissatisfied with his work as a school watchman.

The claimants having stepped in on his behalf reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour and the termination was investigated. The ministry's finding was that his termination was unlawful and recommended that he should be reinstated without loss of service with the period between his termination and reinstatement to be treated as leave with quarter pay. The respondents rejected these recommendations.

From the evidence that was produced before the court it is obvious that the claimants' meeting with the board of governors which was held on 5th April, 1979, could not really discuss the issue as it appears that the parties deadlocked on whether or not Mr. Kimani should be allowed to attend the meeting. The

only worthwhile point to note about this meeting is that it started with prayers and concluded with a short prayer! The chairman of the meeting was the Rev. E. Githinji. The matter was later discussed on 29th May, at the provincial education officer's (P.E.O.'s) office under the chairmanship of L. Kago. The relevant minute regarding Mr. Kimani read as follows:

"The watchman was appointed in 1972. He reports on duty at 8 p.m. The contractor's men had keys for the store and could get into the store between 6 and 8 p.m. before the watchman reported on duty. The police took one of the conractor's people and not the watchman for interrogation. No previous warnings were served on the watchman hence the procedure followed to discipline him was arregular. Decision: That the watchman is reinstated without loss of benefits."

The respondents were not happy at this decision and appealed against it on the ground that the headmaster who attended the meeting had no mandate to present the board. The P.E.O. then tried to organize another meeting but there is no record of it having taken place. On 19th September, 1980, the Permanent Secretary for Education informed the respondents' headmaster through the P.E.O. that the ministry goes along with the decision of the P.E.O. recommending the reinstatement of Mr. Kimani without loss of benefits and the headmaster was asked to implement the decision. Then surprisingly on 1st December the same officer writing on behalf of the permanent secretary informed the claimants that Mr. Kimani's termination was proper in accordance with the collective agreement and that P.E.O.s, Nyeri's intervention had confused the issue and since the board of governors were the employers and they did not want Mr. Kimani the ministry could not help. The court was told that this particular officer was victimized and has since been transferred to another ministry.

The respondents have resisted the claim in this dispute on the ground that Mr. Kimani used to remain absent repeatedly and failed to explain the reasons for that and used to argue that as a watchman he had a hiding place which nobody ought to know! Moverover he had no concern regarding the loss of cement belonging to the school when the matter was brought to his notice and when questioned he was very rude. Finally he showed utter disrespect for authority and those above him as he would insist doing his work his own way instead of following the guidelines laid down by the headmaster.

The court notes that as stated above the respondents refused to sign the Notification of Dispute Form "A" with the result that the Minister for Labour sent the dispute to the Industrial Court using his powers under section 8 of the Trade Disputes Act. There is no evidence of previous warnings having been issued to the grievant about his poor service in the past, Regarding the incident of loss of cement apparently the contractor who was building the school had put his materials in the school's store but Mr. Kimani did not have the key to the store, the contractor had the key. The police picked up Mr. Kimani when cement was lost from the store but later they released him as there was no evidence against him and eventually one of the contractor's employees was arrested. The count has no reason to disbelieve this part of the evidence given by Mr. Kimani. The court is also satisfied that the board of governors and the headmaster at no time gave a hearing to the grievant on the allegations against him. The respondents violated the principles of natural justice for having failed to do so.

The court is also rather intrigued at the ministry's stand in this matter as at one stage they wanted the respondents to reinstate him and a couple of months later the same officer had to swallow his own words and say that the ministry could not support him. The court cannot rule out the possibility of political inteference in this matter.

The court has carefully considered the submissions and the evidence given in this dispute and finds that Mr. Kimani has suffered a wrongful termination but the court is not prepared to award his reinstatement as there is no vacancy in the school and has decided to award him three (3) months' salary by way of compensation for the wrongful dismissal that he has suffered in addition to the three (3) months' salary in lieu of notice which the respondents had offered him.





Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kerwa.

EXTRACT FROM THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION D-Kenya Gazette
