THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 30 of 1984

Parties:

Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions Hospitals and Allied Workers

and

All Africa Conference of Churches

Issue in dispute:

Redundancy of 13 employees.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and All Africa Conference of Churches shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 12th September, 1984, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 16th November, 1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 2nd April, 1984, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are an international church organization and are dependent upon foreign donations, at least 80 per cent of its operation budget comes from overseas church organizations. The respondents found themselves in serious financial difficulties and had to resort to curtailing their activities and reducing their staff.

On 29th November, 1979, the respondents wrote a letter to the Minister for Labour giving detailed background of all the employees they intended to declare redundant—fifteen at that time—and served the minister a notice of their intention to declare them redundant under section 4 (iv) of the Trade Disputes Act. They however, did not wait for the minister's approval to their intended redundancy and proceeded to declare them redundant. They, however, paid each one of them terminal basic salary, transport allowance, dependent allowance, house allowance, safari pay leave due and provident fund.

The claimants were very bitter and disappointed at this trend of events and reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour and the ministry carried out an investigation whose finding was that when the respondents had applied to the minister for permission to declare them redundant, the minister had advised them to discuss the matter with the claimants but they had written back saying that their employees were not unionizable as each one of them had signed an undertaking in letter of appointment that they would not belong to any trade union. At this juncture the minister advised them to wait for further communication from him but the respondents proceeded to declare all the employees redundant by 28th November, 1979. The ministry found that the redundancy was unlawful and recommended that the thirteen employees be paid two months' salary as compensation for being declared redundant unlawfully. The respondents rejected the recommendation.

The court must express its astonishment and displeasure that a respectable organization should require their employees to sign an agreement requiring them not to become a member of any trade union during the term of his/her employment with them. The workers are entitled to their right of freedom of association in Kenya.

The claimants alleged that the respondents got rid of Kenyans only and that they were all replaced by non-Kenyans from other African nations. They, however, could not prove this point conclusively to the court's satisfaction.

The court finds that the respondents were in financial difficulties and that except for the fact that they did not wait for the minister's approval to these redundancies they have paid all the other benefits that are due to redundant workers. They have in fact committed a technical breach of the law and the court has come to the conclusion that keeping in mind the financial position of the respondents this dispute does not call for a heavy deterrent award and the court awards that each one of the thirteen employees should be paid in addition to all other terminal benefits which they have received one additional month's salary by way of compensation for their wrongful redundancy on a mere technicality.

Issue in dispute:

Dismissal of Joel Chirchir Kiptoo.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Rift Valley Bottlers Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 4th and 5th June and 30th August, 1984, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses: Claimants.—J. C. Kiptoo.

Respondents:

D. Ongeri.

D. O. Midega.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 24th May, 1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 29th December together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The grievant was employed by the respondents on 24th November, 1980, and the court was told by the claimants that he was selected from three applicants after an interview. He was to work as a boiler mechanic. He was dismissed in February, 1982. The claimants stated that his salary at that time was KSh. 600 per month. It is in dispute whether he was a casual employee all this time or whether he was a permanent employee.

The reason for his dismissal was that on 7th February, 1982, he was arrested on suspicion of having stolen sixteen gunny bags which he was seen throwing over the fence. He was arrested, prosecuted but was acquitted. The claimants demanded his reinstatement without loss of privileges but the respondents maintained that they were under no obligation to employ a casual whose contract expired at the end of the day.

The dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour whose finding was that Mr. Kiptoo was a casual employee from 1980 to February, 1982 and that his wage was on a daily basis at an hourly rate ranging from KSh. 2.30 to KSh. 2.50 per hour and the ministry recommended that the matter should be left to stand and the claimants demand be rejected.

During the hearing the claimants' stand was that Mr. Kiptoo was not a casual employee and through him they produced an employment card which he claimed was issued to him by the respondents. This card, however, did not bear his picture. Mr. Kiptoo claimed that the card had fallen into the boiler and the picture had dissolved.

The court believes that Mr. Kiptoo was performing duties alone on the boiler during shift "b" but the court has grave doubt if he was a permanent employee. On the other hand the court finds that the respondents have been shown to be using casuals excessively in their operations and the ratio appears to be 20 to 24 casuals for every 10 permanent employees. The court notes that the claimants had stressed that it would be highly unlikely that a casual would be used on such an important job as a boiler attendant on which the whole operation depended. The fact, however, remains from the documentary evidence produced during the hearing that Mr. Kiptoo's earnings varied from fortnight to fortnight. If he was on monthly terms then this would not be so. The court, however, would like to leave this point for the time being and come to the real reason why he lost his job. The court is satisfied on the evidence of the respondents' administration and personnel officer that the security guard on duty on 7th February, 1982, had caught Mr. Kiptoo with sixteen gunny bags which previously he had thrown over the fence. Although he was acquitted of the oriminal offence, the court finds that he has not been able to exonerate himself from this gross misconduct, i.e. the attempted conversion of the respondents' property for his own use. After careful consideration of all the facts the court finds itself in agreement with the ministry's finding and recommendation and the claimants' demand for his reinstatement is rejected.

The court, however, is disturbed at the manner in which casuals are being use by the respondents as is evident from the dispute before the court and the court directs the claimants to take up this matter with the provincial labour officer with a view to streamlining this matter in order to cut the excessive use for long periods of casual employees. The claimants if need be should seek the assistance of the Labour Commissioner in this matter.
