Position, title and division.—ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, EDUCATION PROGRAMME.

Grade and classification.—D-3.

General:

The education programme is one of the functional divisions of the human resource development group of the Commonwealth Secretariat. The task of the education programme is to plan and implement schemes of Commonwealth education co-operation in priority areas identified by member governments and to act as a catalyst or broker in the exchange of information and experience within the Commonwealth within the field of education. The programme staff organize the triennial conferences Commonwealth ministers of education as well as other specialist conferences, workshops and training seminars. It provides the secretariat for the Commonwealth Standing Committee on student mobility. An important function is that of a clearing-house for the collection and dissemination of educational information and this activity is supported by a vigorous publications programme. Close contact is maintaining with Commonwealth governments in the field of education as well as with other international organizations and institutions.

The main fields of special concern include Commonwealth student mobility and higher education co-operation; resources for education and their cost-effective use; education and youth employment; non-formal education and distance teaching; the educational problems of small states; teaching and learning about the Commonwealth.

The current staff of the programme include a director (presently Peter Williams from Britain), assistant director (post now being recruited for), four chief project officers, and three education officers. There is also a supporting clerical and secretarial staff. The fields of specialism of existing professional staff include a wide spectrum of specialisms with four posts currently designated for higher education, technical and vocational education, science education, nonformal education and distance teaching.

Duties of the assistant director.—The assistant director assists the director of the education programme in planning, supervising and implementing the work of the secretariat in the field of education. The assistant director deputizes for the director whenever required to do so and this responsibility includes representing the secretariat at international and other meetings. In particular the person appointed to the assistant director's post will be expected to take responsibility, under the overall supervision of the director, for:

- (a) Co-ordinating the work schedules of the programme's professional staff and overseeing certain of the projects and programmes.
- (b) Supervising and managing the programme's supporting staff and overseeing the operation of the programme's office.
- (c) Preparation of the programme's expenditure estimates and supervision of the budget.
- (d) Sharing in the direction of the programme's activities such as workshops, training courses, conferences and seminars.
- (e) Taking responsibility for particular educational programmes within the professional areas of competence of the assistant director.

The post involves travel mainly but not exclusively within the Commonwealth, normally for up to three months total in a twelve-month period.

The appointment will normally be for a period of two to three years in the first instance.

Qualifications.—The successful candidate would normally be a person holding a good university degree or recognized equivalent and probably hold a post-graduate qualification in education or a closely related area. The person appointed should have management experience of successfully running a unit/department/project in the field of education and a recognized professional expertise in some major educational field. Experience in one or more Commonwealth developing countries and a sensitivity to their problems is desirable and knowledge of the work of governments and international organizations in the field of education would be important advantages.

VACANCY OFFERED BY COMMONWEALTH SECRETARIAT—(Contd.)

The assistant director will be expected to shoulder responsisibility and take initiatives. He/she must be an effective writer and communicator and be able to deal sensitively with personal relationships with and among staff. The ability to give leadership to a team of professional colleagues and to draw the best out of them is particularly important.

Salary scale.—£14,316; £14,832; £15,756 per annum net of current British income tax.

Basic gross salary.—£19,176; £20,040; £21,612 per annum.

Expatriation allowance.—17.5 per cent of basic gross salary (married), two-thirds of married rate (single).

Dependants allowance.—£250 for each dependent* child (net) per annum.

Installation grant.—9 per cent of net basic salary (married) or 6 per cent of net basic salary (single) on taking up appointment.

Transfer grant.—9 per cent of net basic salary (married) or 6 per cent of net basic salary (single) on termination of appointment

Furnished accommodation (outer London).—Single £125 per week, married £139 per week, married with 2 or 3 children £166 per week, married with 4 or more children £195 per week.

Travel.-Economy class by air.

Entertainment allowance.—An entertainment allowance of up to £570 per annum.

Children education assistance.—An education assistance is payable in respect of dependent children attending school or university:

- (a) In the United Kingdom.—Basic tuition fees at a day school or tuition and boarding fees at a boarding school within a maximum of £2,660 per annum per child. Fees for tuition and boarding in respect of university education within a maximum of £2,660 per annum per child.
- (b) In the officer's home country.—Basic tuition fees at a day school or tuition and boarding fees at a boarding school or university within a maximum of £2,660 per annum per child.
- (c) In a third country.—With permission of the secretarygeneral an officer's children may be educated in a third country at boarding school or university and tuition and boarding fees will be payable within a maximum of 2,660 per annum per child.

Reimbursement of education fees up to the ceilings above will only be made on production of receipted bills.

Cost of packing.—The secretariat will pay the cost of packing, transporting by sea and unpacking a staff member's effects up to 1,000 cubic feet in the case of an unmarried officer, and up to 1,500 cubic feet in the case of a married officer plus an allowance of 100 cubic feet per dependent child residing with the head of the family. In addition, up to 15 kilograms of excess accompanied luggage by air will be allowed on joining and termination for the officer, his wife and each dependent child. No separate allowance will be made for transporting an automobile and not more than one automobile may be allowed to be transported. The secretariat will meet the reasonable cost of insurance of personal effects.

When first taking up an appointment and provided an officer stays in an approved hotel, subsistence allowance at the appropriate rates will be paid in respect of the officer, his wife and his dependent children for a period of up to one month from the date of officer's arrival in post.

Annual leave.—Thirty working days per year. The officer is entitled to home leave approximately once in every two and a half years of qualifying services and the secretariat will pay the return air fares for the officer, his wife and his dependent children.

Pension/gratuity.—If the officer is not required to contribute to a superannuation scheme of the seconding government or any private or university superannuation scheme, he may join the secretariat's pension scheme. The officer will in that event be required to contribute 6 per cent of gross salary. If the officer leaves the secretariat before the completion of five years' service and has joined the secretariat's pension scheme only his contributions will be refunded; where the officer leaves the secretariat after having completed five years' service, he will be entitled to a deferred pension payable from age 60 years.

Overseas officers, however, normally decline to join the pension scheme and opt instead, at the end of the contract and subject to satisfactory performance thereof, to be eligible for consideration to receive at the sole discretion of the secretary-general a gratuity free of U.K. income tax up to a maximum of 15 per cent of gross salary.

Diplomatic immunities and privileges.—To enjoy (provided they are not citizens of, or permanently resident in, the United Kingdom) the privileges and immunities appropriate to a diplomatic agent or comparable rank, appropriate arrangements being made in respect of British income tax.

This implies full personal immunities extending to the family of the officer, inviolability of private residence, continuing customs privileges, relief from non-beneficial rates and purchases without payment of tax of British motor cars and of supplies of dutiable spirits, etc.

Travel time.—An officer recruited from overseas will be allowed travel time not exceeding three days for the direct journey from his overseas base to London and he may be paid for this travel time basic salary only.

*Definition of a dependent child.—A dependent child is an unmarried child who normally resides with the staff member concerned and who is under the age of 18 years or, if the child is in full-time attendance at an educational institution, under the age of 21 years. If the child is totally and permanently disabled, the requirements as to school attendance and age may be waived.
