- (2) Familiarize himself with the relevant data available in libraries and archives of ESCAP and the Mekong Secretariat.
- (3) Identify and design the geophysical and hydrogeologic parameters that can be mapped in the Mekong Delta with electrical resistivity methods: these may include sea water—fresh water relationships along levees, canals and in the plain of reeds, location of faults, etc.
- (4) Design a field programme using electrical resistivity to map the parameters identified and give preliminary field assistance with this programme and with field techniques in general.
- (5) Assist geophysical counterparts with interpretation procedures (in order that the upper 100 metres of recent alluvium or the Holocene Delta complex is the result of a previous marine transgression. It is only partially flushed and hosts a discontinuous water table aquifer in most regions.
- (6) Assist the geophysical counterparts with planning, preparation and presentation. It is believed that each locality worked should be the subject of a separate job report.
- (7) Prepare a short mission report which should include recommendation on equipment suitability, problems likely to be encountered (equipment and terrain), ordering requirements to keep the geophysical programme functional and future programmes, etc.).
- (8) Be prepared to give one or two formal topical lectures on geophysics and its application to hydrogeologic matters to project personnel and counterparts.
- (9) Prepare a final report, setting out the findings of his mission, and his recommendation to the government on further actions which might be taken.

Qualifications.—University degree in geology and geophysics and cosiderable experience in dealing with hydrogeological matters and problems. Although this assignment deals principally with electrical resistivity, advice may be sought on seismic infraction techniques and their application in the Mekong Delta, also on electric well logging and airborne magnetic and EM methods.

Language.—English.

Background information:

As a part of massive efforts launched by the government for agricultural rehabilitation and reconstruction of rural, urban and industrial areas, a large programme of ground water reconnaissance is being implemented.

The two projects, phase I (VIE/76/004) and Phase II (VIE/81/004) form a continuous programme of ground water exploration, with phase I covering work in the lower Red River Valley, delta and adjacent coastal sandbeds, and phase II covering the western Mekong Delta region, together with uncompleted work from the previous phase I.

Detailed exploration of the aquifers required different works, such as geological and geophysical survey, exploration drilling and interpretation of relevant data.

Additional information has thrown new light on the hydrogeological conditions of these areas. Particular attention is given to the existence of saline waters in the Red River Valley and Mekong Delta, which demands a reassessment of potential and careful analysis of the data obtained.

The eventual possibility that ground water will not satisfy all requirements in the project areas demands a professional approach to the problem with an orientation to possible development strategies.

Based on all information, a project terminal report with maps and supporting data covering the two project areas will be prepared.

The United Nations would welcome the participation of suitably qualified male and female candidates in the technical co-operation programmes. The receipients of this job description are, therefore, urged to make every effort to locate and nominate suitable candidates both female and male, for this vacancy. It should be emphasized in this connection that experts are engaged in duties which consist in the transfer of knowledge, techniques and aptitudes. Success in their assignment depends as much on their expressive skills, their empathy with and sensitivity to the needs, particularities and values of the host country, as on their academic background and professional competence.




