3. SYLLARI

There is no change to the syllabi given in appendix "B" to the Personnel Circular No. 6 of 1970.

4. ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

The examination is open to administrative officers in the service, serving either as administrative officers in the provincial administration, assistant secretaries in the ministries or second/third secretaries in the foreign service.

5. EXEMPTIONS

- (a) Candidates who have attempted this examination before and passed in one or more subjects will be exempted from those subjects they passed. They will have to resit only those subjects they failed.

Provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in or implied by Government Lands Act, if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of the President to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the commissioner in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained.

- 3. The lessee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.
- 4. Should the lessee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that she/he/they/is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid, the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the lessee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given (1) within twelve (12) months of the actual registration of the lease, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund the lessee 50 per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund the lessee 25 per cent of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period, no refund shall be made.

- 5. The land and buildings shall only be used for shops, offices and flats, workshop and residential purpose.
- 6. The lessee shall not subdivide the land without prior written consent of the Commissioner of Lands.
- 7. The lessee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the possession of the land or any part thereof or any building thereon except with prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands. No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until special condition No. 2 has been performed.
- 8. The lessee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sum as the commissioner may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost either pay (within seven (7) days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid.
- 9. The lessee shall from time to time pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner of Lands may assess.
- 10. Should the Commissioner of Lands at any time require the said roads to be constructed to higher standard, the lessee shall pay to the commissioner on demand such proportion of the cost of such construction as the commissioner may assess.
- 11. The lessee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever description as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any government or local authority upon the land or the buildings erected thereon, including any contribution or other sum paid by the President of the Republic of Kenya in lieu thereof.
- be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground and the lessee shall not erect any buildings in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of main or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains.
- 13. The Commissioner of Lands reserves the right to revise the annual ground rental payable hereunder after the expiration of the thirty-third (33rd) and sixty-sixth (66th) years of the term granted. Such rental will be at a rate of 4 per cent of unimproved freehold value of the land as assessed by the Commissioner of Lands.
