THE GOVERNMENT LANDS ACT (Cap. 280)

PLOTS FOR ALIENATION-MOIBEN TOWN

- 2. Completed applications should be submitted to the Commissioner of Lands, Nairobi, through the Clerk, Wareng County Council, P.O. Box 100, Eldoret, on the prescribed forms which are available from the District Lands office, P.O. Box 103, Eldoret, and the office of the County Clerk, P.O. Box 100, Eldoret.
- 3. Applications must be sent so as to reach the town clerk not later than 12 noon on 26th October, 1985, and the applicants must enclose with their applications either a banker's cheque, money order or postal order for KSh. 1,000 made payable to the Commissioner of Lands. Deposit will be dealt with as follows:
 - (a) Credited to a successful applicant.
 - (b) Refunded to an unsuccessful applicant.
 - (c) Forfeited if a successful applicant fails to pay within thirty (30) days of the offer of a plot, and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto.
- 4. Each application should be accompanied by a statement indicating:
 - (a) The amount of capital it is proposed to spend on the project.
 - (b) The amount of actual capital available for development with banker's letter or other evidence of financial status in support.
 - (c) The manner in which it is proposed to raise the balance required for development, if any.
 - (d) Full details of both residential and/or commercial properties owned by the applicant in town.
 - (e) Individual applicants to indicate their identity card numbers.
 - (f) In case of companies, names of directors to be included.
- 5. The successful allottee of a plot shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within thirty (30) days of notification that his/her application has been successful, the stand premium and proportion of the annual rent together with conveyancing, stamp duty, registration fees, contributions in lieu of rates, roads and drains charges and survey fees. In default of payment within the specified time, the Commissioner of Lands may cancel the allocations and the applicant shall have no claim to the plot.

General Conditions

- 1. The grant will be made under the provision of the Government Lands Act/Trust Lands Act, and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap. 281) or the Registered Land Act (Cap. 300) as the case may be.
- 2. The grant will be issued in the name of the allottee as given in letter of application and will be subject to the special conditions set out below.
- 3. The term of the grant will be for ninety-nine (99) years from the first day of the month following the issue of the letter of allotment.

Special Conditions

- 1. No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additional or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands. The commissioner shall not give approval unless it is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily.
- 2. The grantee shall within six (6) calendar months of the actual registration of the grant submit in triplicate to the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the buildings and system drainage for the disposal of sewage surface and sullage water) drawings elevations and specifications of the buildings the grantee proposes to erect on the land and shall within twenty-four (24) months of the actual registration of the grant complete the erection of such

buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with such plans, drawings elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner of Lands.

Provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained or implied by the Government Lands Act, if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this conditions it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the Commissioner of Lands in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained.

- 3. The grantee shall maintain in good substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.
- 4. Should the grantee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that she/he/they is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid, the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the grantee's expense) accept a surrender of the land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given twelve (12) months of the commencement of the term of the lease, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 50 per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee five (5) per cent of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made.

- 5. The land and the buildings shall only be used for one private dwelling house, shops, offices, flats and light industries.
- 6. The building shall not cover more than 50 per cent, 75 per cent and 90 per cent of the area of the land or lesser area as may be laid down by the local authority in its by-laws.
- 7. The land shall not be used for the purpose of any trade business which the local authority considers to be dangerous or offensive.
- 8. The grantee shall not subdivide the land without prior consent in writing of the county council and the Commissioner of Lands.
- 9. The grantee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the possession of the land or any part thereof or any building thereon except with the prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands. No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until special condition No. 2 has been performed.
- 110. The grantee shall pay to the local authority on demand such sums as the Commissioner of Lands may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads, drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost either pay (within seven (7) days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid.
- (III. The grantee shall from time to time pay to the local authority on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner of Lands may assess.
- 12. Should the Commissioner of Lands at any time require the said roads to be constructed to a higher standard, the grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of such construction as the commissioner may assess.
- 13. The grantee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever description as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any government or local authority upon the land or the buildings erected thereon including any contribution or other sum paid by the President or the county council thereof.
- 14. The President or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains of ail descriptions whether overhead or undercover or interfere with any existing alignments of main or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electrict mains.
- 15. The Commissioner of Lands reserves the right to revise the annual ground rent payable hereunder after the expiration of thirty-third (33rd) and sixty-sixth (66th) years of the term granted. Such rental will be at the rate of 4 per cent of the unimproved freehold value of the land as assessed by the Commissioner of Lands.

Violation of Clause 27 (Housing) of the parties collective agreement.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and B.A.T. Kenya Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard on 10th June, 1985, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

Award

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 22nd August, 1984, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 20th December, 1984, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The parties to this dispute have an existing recognition and collective agreement governing terms and conditions of employment.

This dispute concerns some 345 unionizable employees housed by the respondents of which about 310 are housed in respondents' village in Nairobi while the remaining 35 are based in rural areas. This arrangement has been in existence for a number of years.

The dispute arose after the parties had negotiated and signed the latest collective agreement over the administration of the house allowance to be paid to the housed employees.

The respondents in the past paid a consolidated wage inclusive of housing element prior to April, 1981. This position changed after the parties agreed that the respondents would provide housing, but, where housing was not available a housing subsidy would be given on top of the consolidated wage, depending on the grades as shown below:

Grades	Sh. per monti
1-3	280
4-5	230
6-8	200
Rural areas	50

The above allowances were, however, only paid to employees not housed in the respondents' village in Nairobi or, other company centres in accordance with clause 27 of the parties collective agreement.

During a central joint council meeting of 18th June, 1981, it was resolved that:

"The employees will get the housing subsidy or be housed at a subsidised rental but will not get both."

The question of a new housing subsidy was to be a subject of further negotiations together with other terms and conditions of employment as was the case previously.

The respondents, however, submitted that, when the last agreement expired on 31st March, 1983, the parties entered into new negotiations which, among others included the subject of a new housing subsidy. This issue was vigorously contested by the claimants arguing that the wages had already been deconsolidated after the introduction of a housing subsidy. The respondents pointed out that the subsidized rental charge paid by those housed in the respondents' village in Nairobi and elsewhere was the workers' contributions towards the cost of utilities paid for by the respondents on their behalf. In fact, revenue collected from those housed by the company amounted to some KSh. 388,800 against monthly electricity and water charges of about KSh. 448,674 thus reflecting a deficit of about KSh. 60,000. The respondents failed to understand why the claimants have misconstrued their share towards these outgoings to mean house rental. They were fully aware that a consolidated

wage had a housing element in it. This, was the parties understanding at the meeting of June, 1981. It was in this spirit that when the last negotiations came up, the respondents agreed to substantially increase housing allowance and deleted the word "subsidy" and insterted "house allowance" instead.

However, with effect from 1st April, 1983, the parties reached an agreement to amend clause 27 on housing to read as follows:

"Housing"

Besides basic wages/salaries, all employees on permanent terms of service will be entitled to a house allowance as follows:

Grade	House allowance (KSh.)
1	530.00 per month
2	490.00 per month
3	460.00 per month
4	375.00 per month
5	355.00 per month
6	310.00 per month
7	300.00 per month
8	290.00 per month
Rural	80.00 per month

It was agreed further that:

"If housed appropriate deductions will be made"

The above supplementary agreement was signed by both the parties on 1st July, 1983.

Before the registration of the above supplementary agreement, the parties as usual were invited by the court to attend and express their views for or against the registration of the said agreement but no objection to the registration was recorded and the court accordingly proceeded with the registration under RCA. No. 144 of 1981 and the parties were subsequently accordingly notified.

The court has observed that, at a joint negotiations meeting of 28th June, 1983, attended by both parties representatives the issue of housing was raised under item 5 and the minute reads as follows:

"5 Housing

The Union wanted to know the administration of house allowance for members of staff housed by the company in view of the improved house allowance. After a brief exchange of views from both sides it was suggested and agreed that a sub-committee be appointed to look into the matter and to come up with recommendations on or before the registration of the agreement. Members selected to form this sub-committee were Messrs. Njuguna and Muriithi representing management and Messrs. Kogo, E. Diodio and B. Kabiru representing the Union".

Indeed, both the claimants and the respondents agreed to the foregoing plan of action and were by the above agreement bound to wait for the committee's decision and recommendations before paying new house allowance and effecting appropriate rent deductions to those employees who are housed.

The court would now like to analyse the reasons behind this dispute. The court has noted that when the negotiations broke down because of the respondents' failure to wait for the outcome of the sub-committee's report, the respondents went ahead and made rental deductions as previously but refused to pay new house allowance as was agreed to those workers who are housed. The court further observed that those who had house allowance paid to them had the same allowances withdrawn physically on the pay day from their pay packets, or, deducted from the following month's pay in the case of those paid by cheques. The respondents claimed that the house allowance paid to the affected employees was as a result of a computer error which had to be rectified following a circular letter to the claimants explaining the reasons for their action.

The court finds it very difficult to believe that such an enlightened and educated management like the respondents' made an error in programming their computer to pay full house allowance to their housed employees as well which they call computer error.

The court can find no ambiguity in the collective agreement in the housing clause. It is clearly worded and it is very easy to understand what the parties meant. It was that all employees on permanent terms will be entitled to the house allowance appropriate to their grades and that appropriate deductions will be made in respect of those who are housed.

Prior to this agreement those who were housed had to pay KSh. 180 for double room and KSh. 90 for single room accommodation.

The parties took a step in the right direction when a meeting was held between the shopstewards and the management on

10th August, 1983, which was called to discuss the appropriate rent which should be charged to the employees housed at B.A.T. village and other company houses. The chief shopsteward and his colleague attended this meeting where the following conclusion was arrived at:

- (a) Since the two parties could not agree the matter was deferred to allow further consultations.
- (b) It was agreed that deductions of rent shall continue until a decision is made. If it is agreed to scrap them off then they will be paid retrospectively with effect from 1st April, 1983.
- (c) A circular should be put to explain that rent deductions shall continue until the issue is resolved.

The calimants disowned the above conclusion on the ground that the shopstewards approach was not strictly to safeguard the interest of the workers as both of them were soon after the said meeting promoted to managerial positions. The respondents vigorously challenged this assertion and maintained that the shopstewards adopted a realistic attitude.

The court finds that the respondents are committed wittingly or unwittingly through carelessness on the part of their negotiators to giving a house allowance to all their employees including those who are housed as they are not excluded. This is further reinforced by the sentence "if housed appropriate deductions will be made."

The position then emerges that housed employees are to be paid house allowance but appropriate deductions have to be made. The parties have not stated that the old charges of KSh. 180 for double room and KSh. 90 for single room will continue. They simply stated; if housed appropriate deductions will be made. It is obvious that the old deductions were cancelled and replaced by the words "appropriate deductions will be made."

The respondents are certainly in the wrong by not paying the housed employees the agreed new house allowances and continuing to deduct the old charges of KSh. 180 for double room and KSh. 90 for single room. At the same time the claimants stand is not consistent with the quite clear and simple interpretation of this disputed clause. They are entitled to be paid house allowance but at the same time appropriate deductions will be made from their entitlement. They can't claim house allowance and maintain that old charges should continue. The whole clause stands together and both parts of the clause have to be implemented together.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards that the respondents should refund to all their housed employees the deductions which they have made from the effective date of the agreement as they ceased to be effective from the date of the new agreement. The court further rules that the parties should immediately embark on negotiations to determine what are the appropriate deductions to be made and once that is done then clause 27 on housing should be implemented in respect of those employees who are housed. In the meantime the respondents should withhold paying the agreed house allowance to the employees who are housed. Once the parties have agreed on the appropriate deductions to be made, then the housed employees should be paid the agreed house allowance. Both the payment of agreed house allowance and appropriate deductions will be with effect from the date of the collective agreement. It is now up to the parties to finalize this matter at a very early date.



- (3) Bill Supplement contains Bills which are for introduction in the National Assembly.
- (4) Act Supplement contains Acts passed by the National Assembly.

All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of an A4 sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible and contain a minimum of alterations.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

EXTRACT FROM THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION D-Kenya Gazette

"D.14.(1) Communications for the Kenya Gazette should reach the Government Printer not later than 12 noon, on Tuesday of the week that publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the Gazette.

(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward Gazette notices to the Government Printer when ready."

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect.
