THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

CAUSE No. 47 OF 1985

Parties:

Kenya Engineering Workers Union

Minor Engineering Group of F.K.E.

Issue in dispute:

Wrongful and non-implementation of the general wages clause of the collective agreement and the minimum wages

THE Kenya Engineering Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Minor Engineering Group of F.K.E. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 17th September, 1985, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The notification of dispute form "A" dated 25th February, 1985, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 27th May, 1985, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The parties entered into a collective agreement covering almost over 2,000 workers employed by the respondents' members regarding their terms and conditions of employment. This agreement was signed in May, 1983, but was effective from 1st August, 1982, for a period of 24 months.

In part I of this agreement minimum wages and general wage increments are set out. Monthly minimum wage at the lowest starts from KSh. 600 per month and goes up to KSh. 1,155 per month and the clerical staff starts at KSh. 720 and goes up to KSh. 821 per month. In addition to these monthly minimum wages exclusive of housing elements there is the following clause on general wage increase.

"From 1st August, 1982.—The employees who were in the service of the employers as at 31st July, 1982 will receive a general wage increase of 12 per cent on top of what they are earning.

From 1st August, 1983.—The employees who will be in the service of the employers as at 31st July, 1983 will receive a general wage increase of 12 per cent to cover the next succeeding twelve months. The increase will be based on basic rates excluding housing elements".

The claimants and the respondents are not agreed on the interpretation of the above clause which they themselves negotiated, worded and signed. The claimants' interpretation is that every employee was to be brought up to the new monthly minimum wage and thereafter he was to be granted 12 per cent wage increase for the first year and 12 per cent for the second year but if an employee was already earning above KSh. 600 then the wage increase were to be on what he was earning over and above KSh. 600 or the basic minimum for his grade.

The respondents contend that they were to give a wage increase to existing employees on top of what they were earning as at 31st July, 1982. For those who did not reach the new minimums after they received the wage increase they were also to receive the difference between what they get and the new minimum wages. They stressed the words "receive a general wage increase of 12 per cent on top of what they are earning" and submitted that this meant what they were earning as at 31st July, 1982.

The claimants stated that out of the 37 members of the respondents' group, 22 had implemented the collective agreement in accordance with their interpretation and the remaining 15 have according to them wrongly implemented it. They asked the court to order these 15 employers to implement the agreement properly and grant all their employees the arrears due to them.

The court has carefully studied the submissions made by both the parties and has also noted that in the previous collective agreement between the parties which was effective from 1st August, 1980, for a period of two years, the following clause appeared under the heading of general wage increase in addition to the consolidated monthly wages which were also set out:

"B (i) From 1st August, 1980.—The employees who were in the service of the employers as at 31st July, 1980, will either receive a general wage increase of 11 per cent or be brought to the new minimum (whichever gives higher increase).

From 1st August, 1981.—The employees who will be in the service of the employers as at 31st July, 1981, will receive a general wage increase of 10 per cent to cover the next succeeding twelve months."

The court must point out that the wording of the general wage increase clauses in the 1980/82 agreement and the 1982/84 agreement are radically different. In the former agreement it is clearly stated that the employees will either receive a general wage increase of 11 per cent or be brought to the new minimum (whichever gives higher increase). In the agreement in dispute these words do not appear and instead the parties have just stated that the employees in the service as at 31st July, 1982, will receive a general wage increase of 12 per cent on top of what they are earning. The court wonders that if the employers' interpretation is to be accepted then why did the parties not leave the previous wording of the collective agreement in the 1982/84 collective agreement as it was. The court is inclined to go along with the claimants' interpretation because it would be wrong for any employee to be below the new specified minimum wage in the collective agreement and in the absence of the words that if an employee after getting the wage increase is still below the new minimum then he will be brought up to the new minimum the court rules that the proper way to implement the collective agreement is to bring up those employees who are below the minimum to the new and then on top of that they should be given the general wage increase. Those who were above the new minimums were to get the general wage increase on their salaries as they existed.

The court directs the 15 members of the respondents' group who have implemented this collective agreement wrongly to rectify the mistake and to pay all their employees their proper agreers with effect from 1st August, 1982. This will bring them imaline with the other 22 members of the group who implemented the agreement properly.

In view of the considerable burden that is likely to be placed these 15 employers in paying arrears to their employees with effect from 1st August, 1982, the court directs that such arrears should be paid in twelve equal monthly instalments commencing from the end of January, 1986.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

CAUSE No. 62 of 1985

Parties:

Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions Hospitals and Allied Workers

and

Green View Lodge Ltd.

Issue in dispute:

Wrongful dismissal of J. M. Mbinda.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Green View Lodge Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 18th November, 1985, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence on oath:

Claimants.-J. M. Mbinda.

Respondents:

P. M. Kathima. G. Kimari.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 28th February, 1985, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 14th June, 1985, together with statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The background of this case is that J. Munguti Mbinda had worked for the respondents for a period of 15 years before he was dismissed on 11th July, 1983. He was first employed as a gardener and subsequently worked in various areas of operations of the respondents. He was working as a barman at the time he was dismissed and his salary was KSh. 803.30. The claimants argued strongly that the dismissal of Mr. Mbinda was not warranted as the allegations made against him by the respondents were not proved.

The claimants further told the court that Mr. Mbinda was accused of the following:

- (a) Having filled the beer left-overs into bottles.
- (b) Having taken hard cash from the cash box.

The claimants informed the court that Mr. Mbinda refuted these allegations but the respondents did not consider his explanations and was verbally and indefinitely suspended from duty. The claimants went ahead to tell the court that various joint meetings held by the works committee could not solve this problem and that this matter dragged on for nearly two and half months. The claimants further stated that the suspension was lifted after the matter was communicated to the Managing Director, Peter Mwicha Kathima, who decided to give Mr. Mbinda another chance to continue with employment on condition that he be demoted to a waiter and be warned. The claimants went further to say that Mr. Mbinda having resumed work wrote a letter to the respondents dated 5th July, 1983, refuting the warning letter served on him by the respondents dated 28th June, 1983, and requesting to be paid for the days he had been out of employment for nearly two and half months.

The claimants further stated that as a result of Mr. Mbinda's letter dated 5th July, 1983, the respondents changed their minds and decided to dismiss him. The claimants further told the court that warning letters are refutable as per their collective agreement and therefore Mr. Mbinda was entitled to do so. On top of that Mr. Mbinda had been suspended verbally by the respondents and therefore he was still their employee and the claimants could see no any reason why the respondents could not pay him for the days he was out on verbal suspension. The claimants challenged the allegations against their member by saying that it was true that he filled beers into bottles but not left overs as per the respondents submissions. The beers he filled into the bottles were those the customers had refused to drink arguing that they were "flat beers". The claimants said that Mr. Mbinda had to do that because such beers are counted as part of the stock instead of shortage. The claimants went further to say that Mr. Mbinda had removed KSh. 100 hard cash from respondents cash box which sum was equivalent to the beers that his friends had bought him in the course of his duties and he was unable to drink them. Lastly the claimants told the court that the findings by the Ministry of Labour were in favour of their member and requested the court to uphold the Ministry of Labour's findings and to award their member maximum compensation for his wrongful dismissal.

The respondents strongly opposed the claimants demands by telling the court that Mr. Mbinda was caught red handed committing the two offences, i.e. filling left over beers into bottles and taking KSh. 100 from the cash box. When he was committing all these offences the manager, shopsteward and other staff were watching. The respondents further told the court that Mr. Mbinda was never suspended verbally by the respondents, but having been caught red handed he deserted, therefore, he was not entitled to any payment for the period. The respondents further told the court that the offences committed by Mr. Mbinda were viewed very seriously by the respondents especially filling left over beers into the bottles with an intention of serving them to the customers the following day and said that the practice left a lot to be desired as it is likely to spread diseases and ruin the business of the respondents. The respondents told the court that prior to this incident customers had complained that most of the beers served to them were flat and the respondents attributed this problem to the practices of Mr. Mbinda. The respondents went further to tell the court that despite the fact that Mr. Mbinda had been forgiven by the director on humanitarian grounds subject to being warned and transferred to another section he was still claiming to be innocent and was not repentant. Therefore, in conclusion the respondents requested the court to reject the claimants demands and to uphold the respondents decision that Mr. Mbinda remains dismissed. The court after careful consideration of both written and verbal submissions and the evidence adduced, is convinced that Mr. Mbinda had committed a very serious offence. The court also notes that he was caught red-handed by the management, the shopsteward and other members of staff. The court finds the respondents witnesses to be most reliable. The court is of the opinion that if the respondents had a stuck to their original intention to dismiss Mr. Mbinda without pardoning him, Mr. Mbinda would have had no case. But the fact remains that Mr. Mbinda had been forgiven by the respondents and told to resume work.

The court also has taken into account the fact that Mr. Mbinda had worked for the respondents for 15 years. The court is not convinced that Mr. Mbinda was at any time properly suspended therefore the respondents should pay him for the period he was under the so called suspension.

The court notes that Mr. Mbinda's attitude after having been given a chance to continue in employment after he had committed an extremely grave offence was unjustified. Under the circumstances the respondents were justified to terminate his employment. The court awards that Mr. Mbinda should suffer a normal termination with effect from 11th July, 1983, and that he should be paid for the period he was under suspension and all his benefits as laid down in the parties collective agreement.

 - (c) Forfeited if a successful applicant fails to pay within thirty (30) days of the offer of a plot, and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto.
- 4. Each application should be accompanied by a statement indicating:
 - (a) The amount of capital it is proposed to spend on the project.
 - (b) The amount of actual capital available for development with banker's letter or other evidence of financial status in support.
