THE Kenya Chemical and Allied Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and East African Oxygen Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 15th February, 1989 and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The dispute could not be heard earlier as the parties delayed the submission of their memos by nearly a year.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" undated duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 15th March, 1988, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. D. Kidake was employed by the respondents on 30th September, 1957, as a general worker, he subsequently rose through the ranks and in 1963 attained the status of a supervisor at the customer service section. His services were terminated on 8th January, 1986, after serving the respondents for nearly 29 years.

The events which led to the grievant's dismissal span over a period starting from November 1980.

Mr. Kidake was dismissed on allegations of continued absence from duty and misuse of a telephone meant for "Emergency Incoming Calls."

The court notes that Mr. Kidake worked for the respondents from 1957 up to end of 1979 with a clean record. During these years he earned himself salary merit increases, promotions and several service awards. However, since 1980 Mr. Kidake got into the drinking habit which unfortunately got the better part of him and the result was absenteeism and poor performance of work. The court further notes that the respondents demoted and subsequently dismissed the grievant although his salary was not reduced.

This is a very sad case where a worker having worked satisfactorily for 24 years ruined himself because of alcoholism. His long service during which he earned several promotions is the only factor in his favour in this dispute. The court finds that the respondents were justified in getting rid of a worker like Mr. Kidake who had become more of a liability.

Purely on compassionate grounds the court feels that the respondents in addition to the normal termination which should be given to Mr. Kidake, should pay him full provident fund benefits including their own contribution and an ex-gratia payment of three (3) months salary.

The court would like the claimants to make sure that Mr. Kidake's family comprising of a wife and seven children will benefit from this award.

The parties were heard in Nairobi on 16th February, 1989 and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The hearing was delayed as the claimants failed to submit their memo until 16th November, 1988.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 14th December, 1987, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 12th April, 1988, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Peter Mwaura was employed by the respondents on 1st April, 1966, as a trainee mechanic. He subsequently rose through the ranks until he attained the status of a supervisor in 1980.

Mr. Mwaura was dismissed in January 1984, after serving the respondents for 17½ years. He was dismissed on an allegation of deserting duty and for refusing to occupy company house allocated to him without valid reasons.

The court has carefully studied all the relevant submissions made by the parties and finds that although technically there was desertion on the part of the grievant when he was demoted to a general worker this was under circumstances which are understandable the important one being that the claimants had taken up the matter on his behalf and also the grievant felt hurt after 17 years of service to be made a general hand. He could not swallow this humiliation. The court really wonders if it was exactly what the respondents wanted the grievant to do that is rather than dismiss him they treated him in such a manner that he either resigned or deserted his employment.

The court must say that it is impressed with the findings of the Ministry of Labour which is well balanced and consistent with the facts of this dispute and the Ministry's recommendation is not an unreasonable one either under the circumstances and the court has decided to uphold it. The grievant has in a way suffered wrongful dismissal.

The court accordingly awards that the grievant should get normal termination with full benefits and in addition he should be paid four months salary by way of compensation for the loss of his job.
