3. SYLLABI

There is no change to the syllabi given in Appendix "B" to the Personnel Circular No. 6 of 1970.

4. ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

The examination is open to administrative officers in the service, serving either as administrative officers in the provincial administration, assistant secretaries in the ministries or second/third secretaries in the foreign service.

5. EXEMPTIONS

- (a) Candidates who have attempted this examination before and passed in one or more subjects will be exempted from those subjects they passed. They will have to resit only the subjects they failed.

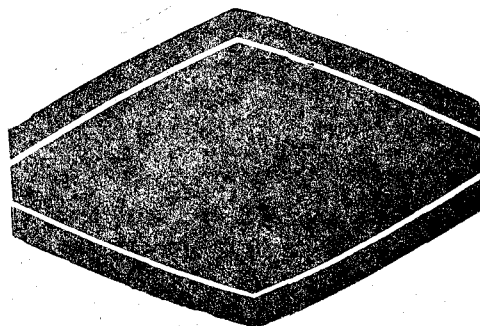

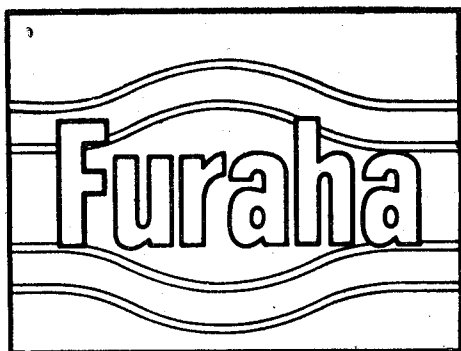

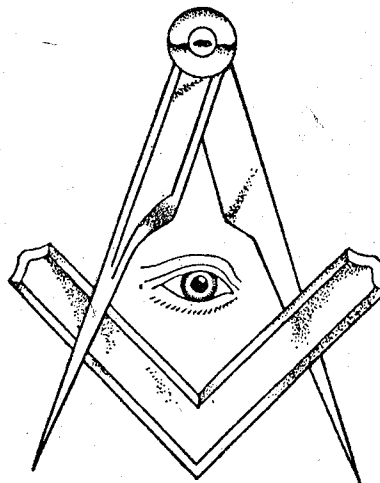
