THE Kenya Shoe and Leather Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Slapper Shoe Industries Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 19th May, 1989 and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The undated Notification of Dispute Form "A", duly signed by the parties, was received by the court on 6th January, 1989, along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. A. O. Owuor started working for the respondents as a casual worker on 10th May, 1985, and his services were terminated at the end of March 1987. The respondents accepted during the hearing that this was not a summary dismissal but a normal termination.

It is also not in dispute that during his two years of service with the respondents, Mr. Owuor was not served with any warning letters in accordance with the warning procedure as laid down in the collective agreement between the parties.

The claimants took up the matter on his behalf with the respondents but the parties failed to reach an agreement and the matter was reported to the Minister for Labour as a trade dispute.

The court has carefully studied all the relevant submissions made by the parties and finds that the grievant had rendered continuous and faithful service to the respondents for a period of two years without a warning letter against him. The respondents have maintained that the grievant was a casual employee. The definition of a casual employee under section 2 of the Employment Act (Cap. 226), laws of Kenya, is as follows:

"An individual the terms of whose engagement provide for his payment at the end of each day and who is not engaged for a longer period than twenty-four hours at a time."

And under section 5 (2) of the same Act, it is stated that the times when wages shall be deemed to be due shall be as follows:

"(a) in the case of a casual employee, at the end of the day"

The grievant in this case received his wages weekly, and in the circumstances, the court rejects the respondents' submission that the grievant was a casual employee.

The respondents have also urged the court to find that the grievant was offered permanent employment but he refused and continued to work as a casual employee. In the absence of any evidence on oath and proper explanation from any witness from the respondents' side on the documentary evidence tendered on their behalf and relied on by them, the court gives the grievant the benefit of the doubt, and accordingly it is satisfied that the respondents' personnel officer used some delaying tactics in giving the grievant the letter of offer of permanent employment for his signature of acceptance. The court finds that the grievant's conviction is not relevant to the issue before the court, and does not therefore wish to delve into its merits or demerits.

For the foregoing reasons, the court agrees to a large extent with the findings of the Ministry of Labour that the grievant suffered wrongful termination of service and feels that three months compensation would be adequate in this dispute and

so awards. In addition, he should be paid his Sh. 601.80, which the respondents have admitted that they are holding on his behalf.

The respondents started their business with a total labour force of 200 employees. They have now increased their work force to a total of 987 employees. This dispute concerns 900 unionizable employees of the respondents.

This dispute arose when the parties were negotiating for the renewal of their latest collective agreement which expired on 31st January, 1988.

After careful consideration of the parties' submission and taking into account the present financial difficulties facing the respondents, the court awards as follows:

House allowance:

The court awards house allowance at a rate of 15 per cent of the basic wage. However, the minimum allowance payable on this item should not be less than Sh. 210 per month.

General wage increase:

The court has decided to award the workers wage increases as follows:

Grade I-IV—8 per cent each year.

Grade V-X—7 per cent each year.

Minimum wages:

The court awards that the respondents' offer on this item should be the new minimum wages subject to revision by the statutory orders.

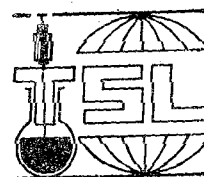

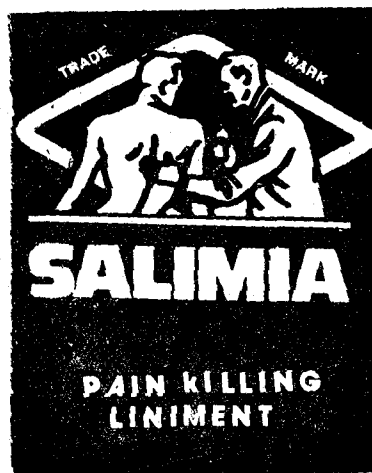
