AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 25th April, 1988, and duly signed by the parties, was received by the court, together with the necessary statutory certificates from the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The court is fully convinced, on the balance of probabilities and the evidence on record, that the grievants played a leading and prominent role in inciting the workers to go on an illegal strike. It is irrelevant whether the grievants were union members or not, but they had no right to organize a wild-cat strike without following the laid down grievance machinery as provided for in the collective agreement between the parties. The court therefore finds that the grievants committed gross misconduct.

However, on the other hand, both these employees have rendered fairly long service to the respondents without any serious warning letters or shortcomings in their work and the court has come to the conclusion that summary dismissal of the grievants is rather too harsh. But in view of the fact that the relationship between the grievants and the respondents' management has completely broken down and has reached a point of no return, the court considers that there can be no reconciliation between them and in the circumstances it will not be in the parties interests to reinstate them to their jobs. What these two employees deserved is a normal termination and the court has decided to reduce their summary dismissal for gross misconduct to a normal termination and awards them only six months' salary each by way of compensation for the wrongful dismissal that they have suffered.

Lastly, the court does not wish to make any comment on the alleged strained relationship between the parties other than to state that they should accept to co-exist and foster friendly industrial atmosphere for the well-being of the employees, managements and the enterprise.

Between 1977 and late 1983, Mr. Ochieng's work performance was satisfactory, except on 14th June, 1979, when he received a warning letter for absenting himself from his place of work in the morning of that day without any lawful cause or permission. The events that led to his termination started in late 1983. It is alleged that during the latter part of 1983 Mr. Ochieng's performance started to deteriorate owing to what appeared to be a psychological rather than a medical problem. From his attendance record for the period between October 1983, and May 1985, he absented himself from duty for 225 days without permission or lawful excuse. On 18th February, 1985, eight bags of pyrethrum belonging to the respondents were burned and as a result of which police were called and Mr. Ochieng' and five other suspects were apprehended. The other suspects were released for lack of evidence, but the grievant was charged in Criminal Case No. 212 of 1985 in the Resident Magistrate Court at Nakuru for wilfully and unlawfully setting fire to 18 bags of five pyrethrum marcs and one beret timber, the property of the respondents. He was subsequently acquitted for lack of evidence.

On 4th June, 1985, the grievant was paid his terminal benefits of Sh. 13,898. In the circumstances and purely on compassionate grounds the court feels that the respondents, in addition to the terminal benefits which he has already received, should pay the grievant the aforementioned sum equivalent to six months wages. The grievant should consider himself lucky for he did not deserve it.

This amount should be deposited with the District Labour Officer, Nakuru, for payment to him.

The claimants' demand for his reinstatement and/or compensation are rejected.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signature must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

EXTRACT FROM THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION D—

Kenya Gazette

"D 41. (1) Communications for the *Kenya Gazette* should reach the Government Printer not later than 9 a.m., on Friday of the week before publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the *Gazette*.

(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward *Gazette* notices to the Government Printer when ready."
