Issue in dispute:

Non-Implementation of Collective Agreement.

THE Kenya Engineering Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Sihra Engineering Works Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 12th April and 3rd May, 1989, respectively. They relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 26th August, 1987, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 21st December, 1987, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents were members of the Minor Engineering Employers Group of the Federation of Kenya Employers. The claimants entered into a collective agreement with the group in May 1984. The agreement became effective from 1st August, 1984, and it was to remain in force for a period of two years.

This dispute revolves around the implementation of the said collective agreement for the period between 1st August, 1984 up to 31st July, 1986.

The court notes that 10 out of the 18 grievants of this dispute were not paid their proper wages for several months. In addition, they were not given their salary increases as specified in the collective agreement.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the court finds that the aforesaid 10 grievants are entitled to be paid the underpayments for their respective grades, which they suffered as shown above. These are effective from 1st August, 1984, until the dates of the termination of their employment.

Furthermore the ten (10) grievants are entitled to a 10 per cent wage increase for the first year on their wages which they were earning as at 31st July, 1984 and another 10 per cent wage increase on their basic rates with effect from 1st August, 1985. These general increases are in accordance with the provisions of the collective agreement which was not implemented.

These grievants are further entitled to a house allowance as specified in the collective agreement for the first and second year for their respective grades less any house allowance they may have received.

Mr. Gakuya of the Industrial Court will assist the parties in working out the dues to which the grievants are entitled in terms of the aforesaid ruling. All the dues which are likely to be substantial will then be deposited with the Industrial Area Labour Office by the respondents in 10 equal monthly instalment, from where the grievants will collect them. The dues will be deposited after Mr. Gakuya in consultation with the parties has completed the exercise.

Finally the grievants should collect their terminal dues, if they have not already done so, from the Industrial Area Labour Office where the respondents have deposited Sh. 32,287.20.

THE Tailors and Textiles Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Sunrise Textiles and Knitwear Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 30th May, 1989, and they relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The dispute was referred to the court by the Minister for Labour in accordance with section 8 of the Trade Disputes Act. The court received the Minister's reference dated 7th October, 1988 on 19th December, 1988, together with the statutory certificates from the Labour Commissioner.

Joshua Odhiambo was employed by the respondents on 28th September, 1980, and he was dismissed on 29th September, 1984, for allegedly overstaying his leave at home after the burial of his son who had passed away in Nairobi on 27th August, 1984. The claimants took up his case with the respondents but his case was caught up by a lock-out which is now the subject matter of this dispute.

It is obvious that there was a long existing recognition dispute between the parties in this dispute since 1974. The court finds that the issue in dispute before it is to determine whether the forty (40) employees refused to resume work on 17th December, 1984, or whether they were locked-out and are therefore entitled to be paid in respect thereof. This would in turn depend on the justifiability of otherwise of the lock-out itself.

In all the circumstances surrounding this dispute and after serious consideration the court finds that these forty (40) employee were victims of an unfair labour practice. The court further finds that the employees did not refuse to resume work on 17th December, 1984, but were in fact locked-out, and that there was no justification for this lock-out because a return-to-work formula had been concluded between the parties.

Turning to the dismissal of the above-named four (4) employees were victims of an unfair labour practice. The court served with any warning letters prior to their dismissal. The whole idea of warning letters is to convey to an employee in clear and unambiguous terms the management's views of his performance or misbehaviour and to indicate to him the fact that he is being warned to improve performance or to correct or refrain from certain misbehaviour. The important thing is that the employee should know that he has been warned so that if he wants to challenge it he may do so. In the circumstances, the four (4) employees were clearly victimized and have suffered wrongful dismissal.

Having come to the conclusion that the forty (40) employees were locked-out, and that the other four (4) employees were wrongfully dismissed, the court endorses, to a large extent, the Ministry's findings and recommendation and awards as follows:

- Lock-out of forty (40) employees.*—These employees should be paid two months wages each compensation for wrongful dismissal.
- Dismissal of Onyango, Oundo and Oduor.*—Each grievant should be paid wages for the days worked and, in addition, one month's wages each as compensation for wrongful dismissal.
- Dismissal of Joshua Odhiambo.*—He should be paid all his terminal benefits as per the parties' collective agreement, and, in addition, three months salary as compensation for wrongful dismissal.

The court would like to impose upon the respondents that it has no intention of restricting their right to hire and fire; but unless they adhere to accepted labour practices, industrial harmony between themselves on the one hand, and the claimants and the employees on the other would be difficult to achieve and maintain.

Finally, the court strongly recommends to the parties that they should sign a collective bargaining agreement without further delay. This would greatly help to restore harmonious industrial relations between them, which, unfortunately, are at present in the lowest ebb.

Ruling

THE Industrial Court received a collective agreement between the aforesaid two respondents from the Minister of Labour for registration in accordance with part III section 11 (3) of the Trade Disputes (Amendment) Act, 1980.

The said collective agreement was signed on 12th August, 1988, and the Minister had found no reason to object to the registration of the agreement.

The court invited the two parties to the collective agreement (who are the two respondents in this application) to attend the court on 18th October, 1988, for consideration of the registration of the collective agreement.

On 18th October, 1988 both the respondents appeared before the court and the collective agreement between them was registered under RCA No. 286/88 and certificate of registration was duly issued.

On 21st October, 1988, the applicants wrote to the court strongly objecting to the registration of the said collective agreement mainly on the ground that the majority of the employees of the members of the first respondents had resigned from the membership of the second respondents and had joined the applicants. They further alleged that the two respondents had secretly and hurriedly negotiated and concluded the collective agreement and submitted it for registration. They pointed out that three disputes, namely Cause Nos. 19, 20 and 21 of 1988, between them and Unga Ltd., Unga Maize Millers Ltd., and Unga Feeds Ltd., on the issue of the applicants' recognition by the three employers were part-heard and pending before the Industrial Court and as such the court should not have registered the collective agreement until Cause Nos. 19, 20 and 21 of 1988 were resolved.

The court invited all the parties concerned to appear before it on 23rd November, 1988, to consider the aforesaid objection raised by the applicants in their letter of 21st October, 1988, to the court.

The parties appeared before the court and the court ruled that the preliminary point regarding the applicants' status and whether or not they can move the court to set aside the registration of the collective agreement should be heard and disposed of first.

The applicants have argued that the said three causes and this collective agreement that has been registered by the court are related matters in accordance with the provisions of section 14 (9) (c) of the Trade Disputes Act. They also maintained that they have 51 per cent of the workers affected as their members.

The applicants have raised some interesting legal points but unfortunately none of them shows that they are entitled to be heard on a matter on which at present they are complete outsiders. The collective agreement is between the two respondents who have enjoyed an industrial relationship going back some 20 years or more and there is in existence a recognition agreement between them. Whether this recognition agreement is valid or not is a different matter and is not relevant to the present application. This point will be gone into in Cause Nos. 19, 20 and 21 of 1988.

The court has carefully gone into every legal argument that has been put forward in this application by all the parties concerned and has come to the conclusion that the applicants have no status as yet to raise any objections to the registration of the aforesaid collective agreement. Until such time as the relationship between the two respondents is cancelled, respondents No. 2 continue to be the official representatives of the employees working for the members of respondents

No. 1. This is in line with the established industrial relations system and practice that has developed in Kenya over the years.

It should also be borne in mind that the applicants may or may not win the Cause Nos. 19, 20 and 21 of 1988—it is all very uncertain at present and it will be sometime before they are finalized and the court's decision announced.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the court finds that the applicants have no status to have any say on the aforesaid collective agreement and their application must fail as it is totally misconceived.

Wrongful dismissal of Morris Odiwa.

THE Tailors and Textiles Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Life Clothing Factory shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 9th June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 18th August, 1988, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 6th January, 1989, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are members of the Garment Making Mass Production Group of Federation of Kenya Employers and are engaged in the garment making business. They have a labour force of about 70 employees.

Morris Odiwa was employed by the respondents on 1st September, 1985, as a mass production machinist. Mr. Odiwa was dismissed on 9th December, 1986, after having served the respondents for a period of about one (1) year and three (3) months. He was dismissed on allegations of carelessness in his work, negligence on duty and absenteeism. At the time of his dismissal, he was the claimants' assistant shopsteward.

The court notes that Mr. Odiwa was in the respondents' employment for a period of about one-and-a-half years only. During this period the respondents alleged that the grievant received several verbal warnings and one relevant written warning letter on 17th November, 1986.

Although the respondents issued the first warning letter against Mr. Odiwa, albeit for low production, the respondents did not issue the second and third warning letters against him. They attempted to make out a case that the grievant was summarily dismissed for gross misconduct, to wit, carelessness, negligence and absenteeism, under section 17 of the Employment Act, Cap. 226. Hence the warning machinery was unnecessary in this dispute.

The court is of the view that in order to justify a summary dismissal it has to be shown that the conduct complained of is such as to show the grievant to have disregarded the essential conditions of the contract of service. In other

words, one act of misconduct can justify dismissal only if it is of a nature which goes to show in effect that the grievant is repudiating the contract or one of its essential conditions. It must connote a deliberate flouting of the essential contractual conditions. This is not the case in this dispute.

After serious consideration of the parties' submissions, the court finds that Mr. Odiwa did not adhere strictly to the instructions given to him. It is as a result of this that he damaged 97 pieces of collar. He was, however, given a chance to repair the damaged pieces of collar and he managed to repair 89 pieces of collar out of the total 97 pieces of collar. The court therefore feels that with a bit of patience and care, Mr. Odiwa could have avoided damaging the remaining 8 pieces of collar.

Considering the minimal number of the pieces of collar damaged, and taking into account the effort made by Mr. Odiwa in repairing a large number thereof, the court finds it just and equitable that the summary dismissal should be reduced to a normal termination of service, and endorsed the Ministry's recommendation that Mr. Odiwa be paid two months compensation and the court so awards. This would meet the ends of justice in this dispute.

The claimants' demand for all terminal benefits and 12 months compensation, or reinstatement with reasonable compensation are rejected.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Githunguri High School shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 12th June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions and documentary evidence.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 19th December, 1985, and duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 6th January, 1989, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. Kamuyu was employed by the respondents as a watchman on 1st May, 1974. He was dismissed on 22nd November, 1982, after having served the respondents for just over eight (8) years. Mr. Kamuyu was dismissed on allegations of negligence on duty.

The court notes that soon after the termination of the grievant's services with the respondents, the headmistress communicated the matter to him on 22nd November, 1982, and also invited him to go and collect his final dues, which included "November salary up to 21st November, 1982".

The court is convinced that the reconciliation meeting of 17th November, 1983, at which meeting the claimants and the respondents were represented, was meant to ratify the resolutions of various schools in the area but not to make recommendations.

In the light of the foregoing, the court finds, on the balance of probabilities, that Mr. Kamuyu is entitled to 21 days salary for the month of November 1982, but not salary for one year as demanded by the claimants.

The court therefore awards and directs that the grievant be paid the following terminal dues:

- (a) Three months salary in lieu of notice.
- (b) Uncollected salary for October 1982.
- (c) Twenty-one days salary for November 1982.
- (d) Five days pay for his remaining leave.

The claimants' demand for compensation is rejected.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 5th October, 1988, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 9th February, 1989, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The parties to this dispute negotiated their first collective agreement in 1980 which covered a period of two (2) years up to 31st December, 1982. During negotiations for the second collective agreement, the respondents agreed to adopt an agreement which the claimants had negotiated with the Ministry of Higher Education which agreement is reviewed regularly with respect to salary scales. Later, the respondents discovered that they were unable to implement the said agreement due to their financial constraints. The respondents informed the claimants of their intention to terminate their agreement with the claimants but the claimants refused the proposal and reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour over it and now the matter is before the court.

After careful consideration of the parties submissions before it, the court notes that the respondents' revenue at present is dwindling due to the introduction of 8-4-4 education system which has a lot of new compulsory requirements with financial implications. Due to these problems facing the respondents, the court awards that the respondents should not be forced to implement the agreement between the claimants and the Ministry of Higher Education and directs that the parties negotiate a separate collective agreement which will cover the period 1st July, 1988 to 30th June, 1990. The court further awards that the respondents pay the difference between the increments they have given and those in the collective agreement between claimants and the Ministry of Higher Education up to 30th June, 1988.

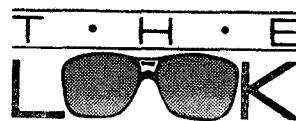

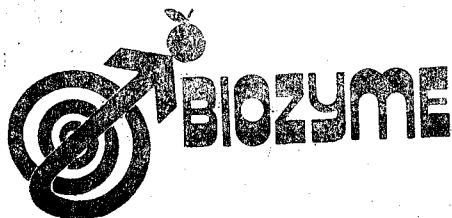
