AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 29th March, 1988, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 26th July, 1988, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and Labour Commissioner.

The grievant in this dispute was employed by the respondents on 1st April, 1981, as a records clerk grade "A" and was put on 3 months probation. The respondents alleged that his work performance was below expectation. After the 3 months probation the respondents who wanted to terminate his services discussed the matter with him and on his own plea, and request for his service not to be terminated, the respondents extended the probation by another 3 months. His services were terminated on 15th September, 1981, on an allegation that he showed no improvement in his work performance.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the court cannot entirely rule out the possibility that the grievant with 15 years experience as a shipping clerk was the victim of his domestic circumstances in which he was involved with his supervisor who was his brother-in-law. It is a matter of history now that the grievant promptly divorced his wife after he was sacked. Under these circumstances the court finds that the grievant's termination was not due to poor performance and so he did suffer a wrongful dismissal.

Under all the circumstances of this dispute, the court awards that the respondents should pay the grievant two months' salary plus house allowance for the wrongful termination he suffered.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial, Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Safeway Meat & Fish Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 24th May, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. At the conclusion of the hearing and in the light of the parties submissions, the court requested the planning and research division to look into the wage categories and other terms and conditions of the respondents' employees. The award could not therefore be ready earlier because the planning and research division report was not available until 11th July, 1989.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 7th October, 1987, and duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 6th December, 1988, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are a sister company to Kenya Cold Storage Limited and based at Westlands in Nairobi. They engage in processing retailing of meat, fish and poultry foodstuffs.

The parties have a valid recognition agreement and their first collective agreement which came into force on 1st May, 1984, for a period of two years, was registered by the Industrial Court as RCA No. 136 of 1984, on 11th June, 1984. The second collective agreement for a further period of two years, effective from 1st May, 1986, was signed on 14th November, 1986, and was registered by the court as RCA No. 302 of 1986 on 17th December, 1986.

The court has thoroughly gone through the wording of clauses 18 and 19 and also the schedule to the collective agreements and finds that there is no ambiguity therein. The court has further perused and verified all the documents and annexures produced in court, together with the claimants' subsequent correspondence after the hearing of this dispute; and finds that, contrary to the claimants' arguments, the employees' wages are well above the basic minimum rates provided for in the collective agreement.

The court wishes to point out to the parties that they should clearly read and understand the contents of the collective agreement and the schedule thereto before signing them as the court cannot later on assist them if they say that certain information were discussed and understood between them although not recorded properly or left out in the agreement. Were the court to allow this type of demand to succeed, it would lead to an impossible situation in the country as far as smooth industrial relations are concerned.

In the aforesaid circumstances, and after careful consideration of all the submissions in this matter, the court finds that the respondents have neither violated clauses 18 and 19 of the collective agreement nor given false information on the schedule thereto.

Accordingly the court rejects the claimants' demand.

THE Kenya Union of Printing, Publishing, Paper Manufacturing and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Nation Newspapers Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 22nd June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 27th June, 1988, and duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 19th December, 1988, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. Mbukha was employed by the respondents as a general worker, or cleaner, on 3rd June, 1980, and he was not confirmed into permanent terms of employment allegedly due to poor performance of work. On 2nd May, 1986, he was suspended for two weeks without pay for having his card punched while he was

not actually on duty. By a letter dated 28th May, 1986, Mr. Mbukha was summarily dismissed with effect from 5th May, 1986 for the said offence, and at the time of his dismissal, as aforesaid, Mr. Mbukha, who was still a general worker, was earning a salary of KSh. 1,148 per month and a house allowance of KSh. 220 per month.

The court notes that Mr. Mbukha worked for the respondents for a period of six years and during this period his work performance was found to be below expectation. The court notes further that the letter of suspension and subsequent summary dismissal of Mr. Mbukha relate only to one incident, and that is, having his card punched while he was actually not on duty. But in their submissions the respondents gave examples of some other earlier instances of Mr. Mbukha's absenteeism, lateness, rudeness and failure to obey lawful instructions for which he was given verbal warnings and written warning letters.

The court has thoroughly examined the various documents presented to it and finds that the warning letters on record were not valid and the court cannot hold them against Mr. Mbukha. In case, the provisions on the warning procedure under the parties collective agreement clearly state, as set out hereinabove, that where an employee commits any act of misconduct he shall be given a written warning letter for each act; and, on the fourth instance, his employment may be terminated. During the hearing the respondents stated that there were two valid warning letters against Mr. Mbukha; but, unfortunately for the respondents, these letters were not made available to the court; and in their absence the court is therefore satisfied that Mr. Mbukha was not served with any proper letters of warning in accordance with the warning procedure as laid in the collective agreement between the parties.

Another very important and relevant point in this dispute is whether or not Mr. Mbukha was given permission by Mr. Bingo on 16th and 17th April, 1986, to go to Pangani Police Station. The claimants have vigorously argued that Mr. Mbukha was given permission by Mr. Bingo, but the respondents vehemently denied the allegation. Mr. Bingo himself said that he did not remember whether or not he gave Mr. Mbukha permission.

Under the circumstances, the court cannot positively find that Mr. Mbukha was absent from his place of work without permission, as claimed by the respondents. There is a big doubt in the court's mind on this point and the court has decided to give Mr. Mbukha the benefit of the doubt.

In view of the foregoing, and after careful consideration of all the submissions on this particular incident, the court endorses, to a large extent, the recommendation of the Ministry of Labour that Mr. Mbukha's summary dismissal should be reduced to normal termination of service; and accordingly the court awards that Mbukha should be paid six months' salary only by way of compensation. He does not deserve anything more than that.

The claimants' demand for reinstatement is therefore rejected.

THE Kenya Union of Entertainment and Music Industry Employees shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Kenya Film Corporation Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 16th June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 8th March, 1989, and duly signed by the parties, was received by the court on 17th April, 1989, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are a parastatal organization incorporated under an Act of Parliament, and are engaged in film and movie business activities.

The court notes that the claimants' demand is based on a document which the parties representatives are alleged to have drafted, typed, and initialled as the collective agreement between the parties. It also is apparent that state corporations have been placed under a legal duty to consult the Government prior to starting any negotiations with unions, and they must also obtain clearance from the Government before implementing the negotiations.

As it is, the court has no hesitation in finding that the so-called collective agreement which the parties drafted, typed and initialled is nothing but a set of agreed proposals which required Government approval prior to implementation. The claimants wanted the respondents to sign and implement the so called collective agreement before such an approval was obtained. All this is clearly and completely out of step with the guidelines which the Office of the President has issued to the state corporations.

The court has very carefully examined the so called collective agreement and finds that the document on which the claimants are relying and asking for it to be implemented is not a collective agreement at all. Had it been a proper agreement and also had it been properly registered by the Industrial Court as required by the provisions of the Trade Disputes Act, then the Industrial Court would not have allowed the respondents to back out of it as the court has ruled in several cases in the past.

After careful consideration of all the submissions, the court therefore finds that the claimants demand is misconceived, and accordingly directs that, subject to the recommendations of the Parastatals Advisory Committee, all the clauses which have been negotiated and agreed upon by the parties should be implemented with effect from 1st July, 1989, and that they should remain in force for a period of two years from the date of implementation.

On the medical scheme, the court endorses the existing practice, pending the Government decision on the matter. However, the court advises the parties that they should try to resolve this issue outside the court, failing which it may be referred to the court as a fresh dispute.
