THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 23 of 1988

Parties:

Kenya Petroleum Oil Workers Union.

and

Shell Chemicals Company of East Africa Limited

Issue in dispute:

Dismissal of Phinus Duncan Kalenya.

THE Kenya Petroleum Oil Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Shell Chemicals Company of East Africa Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 18th April and 13th June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The claimants also called Mr. P. D. Kalenya to give evidence on oath.

AWARD

The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 30th March, 1987, and duly signed by the parties, was received by the court on 10th April, 1988, along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The court notes that from the time he was employed on 1st February, 1979, until December 1983, Mr. Kalenya's work performance with the respondents was satisfactory. However, on 12th June, 1984, he was served with a final letter of warning for failing to account for some payment which he had received from customers in December 1983; but, in view of his past good work performance and dedication to duty the respondents gave Mr. Kalenya one last chance. In February 1985, Mr. Kalenya was suspended pending investigation following a serious complaint on his conduct. He was advised that a decision on the matter would be communicated to him as soon as possible. The upshort was his summary dismissal on 9th April, 1985, for gross negligence in preparing invoices and supplying the respondents' products to customers against fake or forged L.P.Os.

It is not in dispute that the respondents have suffered a loss of over Sh. 70,000 as a result of Mr. Kalenya's alleged negligence in supplying products on 14th and 22nd January, 1985, against fake or forged orders, which were purportedly issued by Messrs. Vershi Devshi (K) Ltd. This is very unfortunate and regrettable.

In his evidence on oath, Mr. Kalenya told the court that he followed the standing procedure and instructions when he processed the two orders given to him. He strongly objected that he prepared invoice No. 30608 against the cancelled L.P.O. No. 26227. He informed the court that the said L.P.O. was a substitute for the right one he saw and processed. Unfortunately for the respondents, they neither called any witness nor produced any document to contradict Mr. Kalenya's version regarding the laid down instructions and procedure in processing customers' orders. The respondents entirely relied on their written submission and verbal arguments. This leaves Mr. Kalenya's account of the two incidents unchallenged. In the absence of any document or evidence on oath and proper explanation from a witness from the respondents' side on the laid down procedure of supplying products against customers' orders on which they relied, the court cannot, with certainty, find that Mr. Kalenya was the main or only culprit in the respondents suffering such a big loss, amounting to over Sh. 70,000.

The court wishes to point out that, when employees are entrusted into positions of responsibility, particularly in areas where financial transactions are involved, it is only but fair that they should be properly groomed for their new responsibilities and under close supervision. Mr. Kalenya's past performance, which led to his suspension, was enough to satisfy the respondents that his performance was below expectation and as such close and constant supervision was necessary on his work. The senior officials to Mr. Kalenya should have been wary of the requirement and their lapse in this matter contributed to the loss which the respondents suffered. Surely, the whole purpose of the senior officials initiating Mr. Kalenya's work was to prevent such enormous mistakes being made by him. After all, the respondents had devised this procedure in order to prevent or stop errors of such magnitude, and if the superiors were doing their job diligently and properly they would have spotted these mistakes in time and prevented the respondents incurring such a big loss. In this dispute, if Mr. Kalenya's work performance had steadily deteriorated, as the respondents claimed, then he should have been strictly warned about his poor performance. The court finds that there is in

fact only a final letter of warning which was issued to Mr. Kalenya and which led to his dismissal. He had not received the required number of warnings in accordance with the warning procedure as laid down in the parties collective agreement. In the circumstances, the court finds that the respondents have committed a breach of the provisions of the warning procedure in the collective agreement between the parties.

The court would like to point out to the parties that the warning procedure as specified in the collective agreement between them has got to be strictly adhered to. The court expects employers to point out the shortcomings of the employees in their performance through warning letters and the industrial practice in this country demands that they do so.

The court wishes to clarify the position regarding employers' right of taking action against an employee where the employee is alleged to have committed a criminal offence. It is not the Industrial Court's function to try employees and find whether on not they have committed a criminal offence. A criminal offence is an offence against the State and is a matter outside the jurisdiction of the Industrial Court. The court is merely concerned with matters of employer/employee relationship in accordance with the provisions of the Trade Disputes Act, and in view of the very clear legal provisions regarding the Industrial Court jurisdiction, the court has decided not to make any finding on the criminal aspects of the incidents which led to the summary dismissal of Mr. Kalenya. It is up to the respondents, if they so feel, to draw the attention of the relevant authorities to the alleged offence on the part of Mr. Kalenya.

The court must place it on record that, in his evidence in court, and especially during cross-examination, Mr. Kalenya admitted having prepared the invoices against the fake or forged orders, but denied that he was a party to the conspiracy to defraud the respondents. The court has therefore no hesitation in coming to the conclusion that Mr. Kalenya was involved in the conspiracy, but hastens to add that he was not alone as the respondents in fact admitted during their submission that Mr. Kalenya was "one of those involved in the conspiracy to defraud the respondents."

The court has seriously considered the question of Mr. Kalenya's reinstatement, and, taking into account all the circumstances of this dispute, it has decided that it will not be in the best interest of the parties to reinstate him.

Finally, it is apparent from the record made available to the court that Mr. Kalenya was an employee of the respondents, not of the Crop Protection Chemicals Limited as claimed by the respondents.

After due consideration of the whole report of the Ministry's investigator and the submissions of the parties and the evidence tendered on behalf of the respondents, the court has come to the conclusion that Mr. Kalenya's summary dismissal should be reduced to normal termination, and in consequence he should be paid six months' salary by way of compensation and the court so awards. Mr. Kalenya is not entitled to any other benefits.

Issues in dispute:

- 1. Reduction of monthly salaries of Mrs. Sarah Ponga and Mr. Kagiri.
- 2. Refusal by the management to refund KSh. 3,000 to each Sarah Ponga and Joseph Kagiri deducted from their wages.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Bamburi Beach Hotel shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 26th June, 1989, and relieft on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 1st August, 1988, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 17th October, 1988, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Mrs. Sarah Ponga and Mr. Joseph Kagiri were employed by the respondents on 1st November, 1979 and 15th May, 1977, respectively. Sarah was appointed as an Assistant House keeper at a salary of KSh. 714 plus housing allowance of KSh. 120 per month. Mr. Kagiri was engaged as a junior clerk at a salary of KSh. 450 per month. He was also provided with free accommodation.

The circumstances that led to this dispute occurred in November 1980. It is alleged that bedsheets were missing from the hotel and that the grievants were responsible for it. Sarah and Kagiri had then served the respondents for 1 year and $3\frac{1}{2}$ years respectively.

The court notes that at the conciliation level at the Ministry of Labour in March 1988, the claimants were claiming for each of the grievants a sum of K.Sh. 22,575.65 making a total of K.Sh. 45,151,30.

In this dispute a very important point is at stake which is that should the grievants be allowed to back out of a settlement which the claimants' branch secretary, Mombasa, had arrived at with the respondents way back on 3rd April, 1982 in the presence of Mr. J. Havelock—Secretary, Kenya Hotelkeepers Association. The then branch secretary is now a national official at the headquarters in Nairobi. The minutes of the meeting read as follows:

Present:

Mr. J. Havelock-Secretary.

Mr. J. A. N. Omolo-Branch Secretary.

K.U.D.H.E.I.H.A.W.

Mr. S. Gavaghan—General Manager, Bamburi Beach Hotel.

Harrison Mwachofi-Past Shopsteward.

Mr. Gavaghan outlined the case to Mr. Havelock. Mr. Havelock then asked Mr. Omolo whether he was prepared to reach a compromise. Mr. Omolo said that he was prepared to agree to half half.

Mr. Havelock then suggested that although Mrs. Ponga and Mr. Kagiri had repaid slightly more that half of the amount in question no refunds should be made but there would be no more deductions as of today's date. Mr. Omolo agreed to this but requested that Mrs. Ponga should once more be allowed her meals on duty and staff transport. This was agreed to by Mr. Gavaghan.

Mr. Havelock said that the matter had been mutually agreed the case should be closed and that there should be no claims for back pay, back meals or back transport. This was agreed by Mr. Omolo.

It is obvious that the grievants are now backing out of the agreement. If this was allowed it would make any type of negotiations between the employers and the duly accredited trade union officials on behalf of the workers not only extremely difficult but meaningless and the disputes will never reach any finality at the parties level. This would be most undesirable and the court cannot allow it. The presumption is that the union official acting on behalf of the grievants and with their full instructions and knowledge clinched a deal with the respondents taking fully into account the circumstances surrounding the dispute.

The matter is now between the grievants and the branch official. As far as the respondents are concerned the matter is settled. The claimants' demands are accordingly rejected.

Parties:

Tailors and Textiles Workers' Union.

Chic Fashions Limited.

Issues in dispute:

- 1. Wrongful dismissal of Mr. George Milton Otiono.
- 2. Housing allowance for workers when they were on leave.

THE Tailors and Textiles Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Chic Fashions Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 27th June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. During the hearing of this matter, the parties noted and agreed that the grievant was paid KSh. 617.85 as his entitlements, representing six days leave, four days sick leave and wages for clothes stiched.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 15th September, 1988, and duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 19th December, 1988, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner, and, in the case of Mr. George M. Otieno, an additional certificate signed by the Minister for Labour.

The respondents are engaged in garment making business, and they have a total work force of 57 employees, 40 of whom are employed on permanent basis and 17 are casual workers.

Mr. George Milton Otieno.

Mr. Otieno was employed by the respondents on 26th February, 1986, as a piece worker mechanist, and he was summarily dismissed for alleged gross misconduct on 11th May, 1987, after serving the respondents for about one year and three months only.

The court notes that the grievant was employed by the respondents as a mechanist on a piece work basis; and, up to the time of his dismissal on 11th May, 1987, it is alleged that he had been verbally warned several times for refusal to work and absenteeism. During the hearing of this dispute no written warning letter to the grievant was produced by the respondents to support his summary dismissal; and, under the circumstances, the court finds that the respondents committed a breach of clause 14 of the parties collective agreement.

The court also notes that the respondents did not call any witness to explain what transpired on the 11th May, 1987 when the grievant is alleged to have engaged in an argument with the supervisor over the walkman, and as such the court cannot positively find that the grievant was either rude or misbehaved to the respondents.

After serious consideration of all the submissions in this dispute, the court has therefore come to the conclusion that the grievant's summary dismissal should be reduced to normal termination, and accordingly the court awards him three months salary by way of compensation for the wrongful dismissal that he has suffered.

The claimants' demand for the grievant's reinstatement or payment of his terminal benefits plus six months salary as compensation are rejected.

The court notes that the parties are in complete agreement that the two provisions relating to house and leave allowances are catered for in their collective agreement, and that these provisions are distinct from each other. The operation of one clause does not therefore render nugatory the other clause. It is also common knowledge that when an employee proceeds on his annual leave, he leaves behind in his house in Nairobi either some members of his family and/or personal effects or properties; and under the circumstances, it would be absurd to expect him, when he reports on duty after his leave, to undergo through the distressing experience of looking for an afternative accommodation, which is almost impossible to get.

The court finds the respondents' refusal to pay their employees house allowance when they proceeded on annual leave a breach of the relevant provisions of the parties collective agreement, and out of step and a complete departure from the accepted practice prevailing in the country. Accordingly, the count endorses the recommendation of the Ministry of Labour, and

awards that all the employees who have been denied their house allowances when they proceeded on their annual leave should be paid immediately.

Issues in dispute:

Unlawful declaration of redundancy for 42 employees.

THE Kenya Engineering Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Corrugated Sheets Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 15th June, 1989 and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. This dispute was referred to the court by the Minister for Labour in accordance with section 8 of the Trade Disputes Act. The court received the Minister's reference dated 5th January, 1989 on 6th January, 1989, together with the statutory certificates from himself and the Labour Commissioner.

This dispute concerns the alleged redundancy of 42 employees of the respondents. The grievants were engaged on varied dates between 1976 and June 1982.

The grievants list is as follows:

D. Nzuki; P. Opika; J. Kiru; F. Kamuyu; K. Kabenge; M. Mwongela; J. Baraza; W. Obiah; M. Kithika; J. Arose; L. Charo; J. Nyanje; V. Nyawa; A. Ooko; J. Wakori; R. Juma; P. Ndika; F. Moka; M. Nyamai; P. Mwasola; A. Mulewa; T. Tsuma; E. Omondi; J. Mutia; J. Abuba; R. Mulwa; H. Simiyu; M. Charo; J. Owuor; C. Nzai; K. Katana; K. Mwanzia; M. Ojwang'; M. Kithio; R. Ouma; J. Mwanzi; G. Osanya; K. Chome; M. Muthami; C. Chea; J. Dume; J. Musili.

The court notes that the 42 listed employees in this dispute had walked out of their jobs on 14th August, 1985. Thereafter, 21 of the grievants resumed their former jobs unconditionally. Out of these 21 grievants, 9 have since then left employment and unfortunately one died, leaving 11 still in respondents' employment.

In view of the above reasons the court finds that this dispute concerns only 22 grievants and not 42 as originally reported.

The court now wishes to turn to the case of the remaining 22 grievants. The claimants had pursued the case of the 22 grievants and a settlement was recommended by the Provincial Labour Office on 7th September, 1985 which, however, did not come up to the expectations of the claimants. The workers are on record for having signed for 21 days leave pay and some pay in lieu of notice. The court can find no conclusive evidence, however, that this matter was finally settled at that stage. The court must therefore consider this matter on its merits and make an award.

It is not disputed that the workers abstained from work as put forward by the respondents but then there was a good reason for them to do so in that after the Labour Commissioner's circular, referring to employment of casuals, the respondents wanted to pay the employees daily instead of weekly—so they demonstrated.

The court cannot get away from the fact that the respondents kept these workers as casuals notwithstanding that there was regular work for them month after month, year after year. The respondents brought about their termination of employment.

In view of this the court awards that the respondents should pay the 22 grievants who did not resume work an additional one month's pay, This is to be calculated on the basis of their earnings in July 1985. The amount due to each one of them should be deposited at the Mombasa Labour Office from where the grievants can collect their dues.

Issue in dispute:

Dissmissal of Mr. Mathias Wainaina Mburu.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the St. Mary's School shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 26th June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. In addition Fr. F. Caffrey was called by the respondents to testify on oath.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 2nd August, 1988, and duly signed by the parties, was received by the court on 10th January, 1989, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The circumstances leading to the grievant's summary dismissal are that in October 1984, he was asked by the respondents to take his annual leave which had fallen due and also to vacate his school quarters before proceeding on leave. The grievant was reluctant to obey the instructions and requested that his leave be postponed. The request was acceded to by the respondents, and in the circumstances, the respondents alleged, the grievant had an opportunity to remove certain items from the school, particularly his house and took them to his home before he proceeded on his annual leave. Consequently on 1st November, 1984, the grievant took his one month's annual leave and resumed his duties on 1st December, 1984.

After carefully analysing the parties submissions and the evidence adduced on behalf of the respondents, the court notes that the grievant abused his position of trust and his long employment relationship with the respondents by misappropriating school property for his own personal gain. The grievant, without the knowledge of the respondents, made furniture and other items from the school timber and sold them to his fellow employees and other people. There was also irrefutable evidence regarding the car battery which was recovered from the grievant; and, although there was no evidence directly against him, the grievant was a prime suspect in the disappearance of Fr. Caffrey's welding machine.

The court was impressed with the evidence of Fr. Caffrey and it finds that he was telling the truth in this matter. The court, to say the least, is astonished that the grievant, who for a period of twenty-four years had worked for the respondents, could perpetrate such a scheme reeking with dishonesty.

The grievant owed to the respondents a duty of fidelity. This duty to give faithful and honest service comprehends honesty, trust and general fair dealing, and a breach of this confidential relationship was on the face of it incompatible and inconsistent with his duty.

In the circumstances and for the foregoing reasons, the court finds that the grievant deserved summary dismissal; and his services were therefore properly terminated by the respondents with full justification.

- 1. Minimum wages.
- 2. Medical Scheme.
- 3. Acting allowance.
- 4. Annual leave.
- 5. Leave travelling allowance.
- 6. Housing allowance.
- 7. Tools allowance.
- 8. General wage increase.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Avery (K) Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 19th and 30th June, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 5th October, 1988, and duly signed by the parties, was received by the court on 7th March, 1989, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

After thorough consideration of the parties' submissions and the report by the Planning and Research Division (P.R.D.), the court awards as follows on each item.

Minimum wages:

The court has decided to slightly improve on the respondents' offer of 7.5 per cent each year for the two years period by raising it to 8.5 per cent each year, and the court so awards.

Medical scheme:

There is no morit in the claimants' demand under this issue and it is accordingly rejected.

Acting allowance:

- (a) The court accepts the claimants' demand that an employee who is required to act on a higher grade than his/her substantive post should be paid an acting allowance which is equivalent to the difference between his/her salary and the minimum rate for the higher grade. The court further accepts and awards that an acting employee is entitled to a letter of acting appointment and would qualify for the allowance when he/she has acted in that capacity for a period of two consecutive weeks.
- (b) The court sees no ment in accepting the claimants' demand of duty allowance as this would render meaningless the purpose of acting allowance. The court has therefore decided to reject this demand.

Annual allowance:

The court has decided to reject this demand for the time being, but, advises the parties to examine this issue more carefully during their next round of negotiations.

Leave travelling allowance:

In view of the current exorbitant cost of travelling, the court awards that the present leave travelling allowance of KSh. 500 be increased to Sh. 600 payable to the employees once a year when proceeding on annual leave.

Housing allowance:

Under this item the claimants have demanded 25 per cent for the two years against the respondents' offer of 7.5 per cent increase on their existing rates and 18 per cent of the basic wage for the new employees for a similar period of two years. Having given due and serious consideration to all the submissions by the parties on this item, and keeping in mind wage guidelines stipulations (ii) and (iv), and the courts' award on the general wage increases in this dispute, the court finds that the respondents offer under this item is reasonable and the court so awards.

Tools allowance:

The court has no desire in varying the existing arrangements under this issue and accordingly the claimants' demand is rejected.

General wage increases: *

The court notes that the respondents have offered 7.5 per cent wage increase each year for all grades of employees against the claimants' demands of 20 per cent, 15 and 12½ per cent wage increase each year for the aforesaid categories respectively. After careful consideration the court has decided to hike the respondents' offer of 7.5 per cent on the employees existing wage increases, to 8.5 per cent wage increases each year for all the grades and the court so awards.


