Parties:

Taillors and Textilles Workers Union

and

Fine Knit (K) Ltd.

Issue in Dispute:

"The company flaithed to pay the arriears of wages from 1st August, 1986, to Thomas Nyakeyo, Jane Adhiambo, Hadson Lucasie and Joseph Shikuku."

THE Taillors and Textille Workers Unition shall hereimafter be referred to as the claimants and Ken Knit (K) Ltd. shall hereimafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairrobi on 25th September, 1989, and they relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A", dated 5th August, 1988, and duly signed by the partiles, was received by the court on 14th December, 1988, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are a limited fiability company and a member of the Garment Manufacturers Group of Federation of Kenya Employers (F.K.E.).

The respiondents are covered by a valid recognition agreement and several collective agreements between the claimants and Garment Manufacturers Group of F.K.E. The parent dispute arose out of the implementation of the group's 1986/88 collective agreement which was signed by the parties on 21st October, 1987, but title same was retrospectively effective from 1st August, 1986. The agreement was registered by the Industrial Court on 26th November, 1987, as RCA. No. 309 of 1987.

The four grievants were engaged by the respondents as daily casual employees for six (6) months, between 1st August, 1986 and 31st January, 1987; but on 1st February, 1987, they were engaged on regular and permanent terms of employment. The claimants demanded arrears of wages to the grievants for the aforesaid period, but the respondents resisted.

Consequently the matter was reported to the Minister for Labour as a trade dispute; but, there was no investigation carried out by an official of the Ministry, and as such there is no report from the Ministry.

The court mottes that the grievants' contractual terms of service were of daily nature and they were paid on daily basis. In other words, the contract ceased and the wages were paid at the end of each day.

The claimants now demand that allthough the grievants were on casual terms of employment aforesaid for a peniod of six (6) months, they were entitled to arrears arising from the group's collective agreement which was registered by the industrial court on 26th November, 1987, but retrospectively effective from 1st August, 1986. On the other hand, the respondents have countered this demand by arguing that the grievants were not entitled to any arrears arising from the collective agreement because they were not on permannit terms of employment at the material time.

The count would tike to echo its observation at page 7 in Cause No. 28 of 1989 bewteen the claimants and interfashions Garments Manufacturers Ltd. where it stated as follows:

"if any party is to be blound by, or is to claim the benefit of, a collective agreement, he must show some legal basis for it."

In this dispute, the grievants were absorbed by the respondents into permanent terms of employment on 1st February, 1987, and they were paid their arrears arising from the collective agreement with effect from that date. Since the grievants were employed on casual terms between 1st August, 1986, and 31st January, 1987, any benefits accruing from the collective agreement could not therefore form part of their individual contracts of employment because they were not covered by it.

After serious consideration of all the written and verbal submissions by the parties, the court has no hesitation in coming to the conclusion that the claimants' demand must fail. Although the effective date of the collective agreement was retrospective to 1st August, 1986, the fact remains that the grievants were on daily casual terms of employment, and the terms of the collective agreement did not apply to them.

Accordingly, the arrears to the grievants for the period 1st August, 1986, to 31st January, 1987, are not payable and the claimants' demand is therefore rejected.

Cause No. 41 of 1989

Parties:

Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers

and

Moi Girls High School (Eldoret)

Issue in dispute:

Dismissal of William Wesonga and Juma Ambia.

THE Kenya Union of Domestic, Hotels, Educational Institutions, Hospitals and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Moi Girls High School shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 7th September, 1989, and relied on their verbal and written submissions. In addition, the respondents called the following witness to give evidence on oath:

Mrs. Helen Chepkoech Cheramboss

The claimants did not call any witness to give evidence on their behalf,

AWARD

3. The dispute was referred to the court by the Minister for Labour under powers conferred upon him by section 8 of the Trade Disputes Act. The court received the Minister's reference dated 25th May, 1989, on 2nd June, 1989, together with the statutory certificates from himself and the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are a school institution under the auspices of the Ministry of Education.

Mr. Wesonga was initially employed by the respondents as a groundsman on 1st May, 1981, at a salary of KSh. 440 per month. He rose through the ranks to the position of a headman (nyapara) of the school; and, at the time of termination of service on 10th October, 1983, he was receiving a monthly salary of KSh. 1,070.

Mr. Ambia was engaged by the respondents as a groundsman on 1st October, 1980, at a monthly salary of KSh. 900. His services were also terminated by the respondents on 10th October, 1983.

The circumstances which led to Mr. Wesonga's termination of service occurred in mid-July, 1983, when the school authorities received a report that some school property were stolen, and yet the grievant, who was in possession of the store keys and also in charge of the goods therein, had not reported the matter. Consequently some investigations and a search at the grievant's house at school and his home were instituted and some school property—for example, mattresses, beds, bed sheets, including kitchenware—were recovered when the grievant was questioned about these items, he had no explanation to give. He was arrested and charged with the offence of stealing by servant contrary to section 281 of the Penal Code. However, he was subsequently discharged under section 87 (a) of the Penal Code, pending further investigations.

Similarly, the events that led to Mr. Ambia's termination of service also occured in July 1983. The respondents have alleged that on 18th July, 1983, they discovered that the school's new lawn mower, worth KSh. 24,000, was missing, and their investigations revealed that the grievant was the last person who had the lawn mower. He was seen by the first grievant changing oil from it. He was also seen in the morning of the same day, that is 18th July, 1983, coming from the outside of the school compound through the fence. His trousers were wet with dew, and when he was asked to explain why he was coming from outside the school compound in the morning and yet he was housed in the school compound, he could not offer any explanation. He was suspected of having stolen the lawn mower and the matter was reported to the police, who picked him up; but, after some interrogation, he was later released.

The respondents stated that in view of the foregoing incidents, they lost trust and faith in the grievants. The grievants were therefore suspended from duty on 5th August, 1983, and their services were eventually terminated on 10th October, 1983, after finance committee of the school board of governors which met on 5th October, 1983, had deliberated on the matter and recommended as follows:

Min: 54/83 Discipline of Board's Employees

The headmistress informed the members that Mr. William Wesonga's case had to be withdrawn under section 87 A of CPC. Investigations were going on to establish and

get clear evidence about the case and particularly identify of school property. Meanwhile Mr. Wesonga has been on suspension.

The members recommended Mr. Wesonga's termination of service on grounds of unsatisfactory performance on his duties. He should be given three months' salary in lieu of notice immediately.

Similarly, Mr. Ambia who was suspected to have stolen the lawn mower engine and whose case has dragged on without progress in the police, should receive his one month's salary in lieu of notice and have his services terminated immediately."

The matter was reported to the full board meeting of the school which was held on 9th July, 1984, and it was minuted as hereunder:

Min. 49/84: The report from the chairman of the finance committee was read and the following points were raised and discussed:

- (a) Discipline of Board Employees—(William Wesonga and Juma Ambia).
- It was brought to the notice of the members that the union (KUDHEIHA) was keenly following up the case of the two employees whose services were terminated last year. The chairman expressed his concern that the union should be trying to protect even obvious wrong doers who did not serve the interests of the school. He undertook to talk to the national secretary about this case.

The claimants took up the matter with the respondents but no agreement was reached, and a trade dispute was reported to the Ministry of Labour. The usual pre-industrial court investigation was undertaken by the Ministry and consequently the Chief Industrial Relations Officer's findings and recommendations were as follows:

FINDINGS

Mr. Wesonga.—He had a clean record of service over the years he had worked with the school. His dedication saw him rise through the ranks to the position of a headman at the time his services were terminated.

The position of a headman was demanding as it entailed the supervision of other workmen as well as keeping of the key to the store. It was a position of trust.

However, this trust was betrayed when, after a spate of thefts and losses, Mr. Wesonga himself was found to be keeping some school property in his own house without prior permission from his bosses. The board rightly lost confidence in him since he was participating in what he was supposed to prevent.

Mr. Ambia.—He had a clean record of service until the disappearance of the lawn mower. Although the police released him, the fact that Mr. Ambia was the one last seen with it coupled with Mr. Ambia's suspicious movements thereabout, one is inclined to believe that Mr. Ambia had a hand in the disappearance of the engine.

RECOMMENDATION:

Mr. William Wesonga.—After careful consideration of the submissions, it is recommended that Mr. Wesonga should collect his salary for the three months in lieu of notice offered by the management.

Mr. Ambia.—After careful consideration of the submissions, it is recommended that the management's offer of one month's pay in lieu of notice should stand.

The Ministry's decision was acceptable to the respondents, but the claimants rejected it, and the matter is now before the court for consideration.

The court has carefully analysed the submissions put forward by the parties and notes that the grievants had worked for the respondents fairly satisfactorily for a period of 22 years and 3 years respectively. The two grievants were also placed in responsible positions in the school establishment, and they were duty-bound to take care of the school property entrusted to them. The first grievant pilferred the school property for which he was arrested and charged, although he was later released under section 87 (a) of the Penal Code. The second grievant, who was in charge of the school lawn mowers conveniently lost a new lawn mower, worth KSh. 24,000. Under these circumstances, the respondents lost faith and confidence in them and their services were accordingly terminated.

The grievants owed the respondents a duty of fidelity to give faithful and honest service, and a breach of this duty by the grievants justified the respondents in terminating their services

as persons who were incompetent of faithfully discharging their duties.

The court was impressed with Mrs. Cheramboss' demeanor when she gave evidence on oath on behalf of the respondents, and it finds that she was telling the truth in this matter.

During the hearing, the claimants strongly argued that the first grievant was innocent because the charge against him was withdrawn and items found in his possession were returned to him

Similarly, they also contended that the second grievant was not even charged with any offence before a Court of Law. On this score, the court would like to once again clarify that it is not the Industrial Court's function to determine whether a person has committed a criminal offence or not. The court is purely concerned with matters of employer/employee relationship and whether or not the conduct of an employee under certain circumstances warrants the termination of his services.

Admittently, the grievants had clean records all along and they were not served with any warning letters; but considering all the circumstances of their dishonest conduct and work performance, the court finds that the respondents' action in losing faith and trust in them and terminating their services as they did was justified and did not amount to unfair labour practice.

Taking all the foregoing into consideration, the court endorses the Ministry's recommendation that the grievants should be paid three months and one month salary respectively in lieu of notice. In addition the court feels that the grievants should be paid all their terminal entitlements, for example, leave due, if any.

The court has given a serious thought to the first grievant's 22 years of service to the respondents; and, purely on compassionate grounds, the court feels that the respondents, in addition to his aforementioned terminal dues, should pay the grievant a sum equivalent to four months salary and the court so awards.

The second grievant is not entitled to anything more.

The court has anxiously considered the question of the grievants' reinstatement, but taking into account the surrounding circumstances of this dispute, the court has decided not to award their reinstatement.
