# THE TRADE DISPUTES ACT (Cap. 234)

COLLECTION OF TRADE UNION DUES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Trade Disputes Act, the Minister for Labour—

  - (v) to make written returns to the Registrar of Trade Unions within one (1) month of making all payments to that trade union and to the organization.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

Cause No. 35 of 1990

Parties:

Kenya Jockey and Betting Workers' Union and

Casino De Paradise

Issue in dispute:

Termination of services of Thandi S. Njogu.

THE Kenya Jockey and Betting Workers' Union shall here-inafter be referred to as the claimants and Casino De Paradise shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 8th and 30th August, 17th September, 18th October, and 12th November, 1990, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. In addition the parties called the following witnesses to give evidence on their behalf:

Claimant:

Thandi S. Njogu.

Respondents:

Sam Mweu Mwanthi, Joseph Wang'ombe Wakere, John Ndonye Musyoka and Francis Xavier Nicholas D'Mello.

#### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A", dated 13th November, 1989, and duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 26th February, 1990, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The grievant was employed by the respondents on 1'st January, 1988, as a croupier, and worked in that capacity until 16th August, 1988, when his services were terminated. At the time of his termination, he was earning a salary of KSh. 1,000 and house allowance of KSh. 450 per month.

The events leading to his termination were that in the evening of 25th July, 1988, the grievant, who was off-duty, went to Hotel Mecca, in Nairobi, at which place employees of the respondents boarded a hired van which took them to the respondents' undertaking for night duty. It is alleged that on the said date at about 7.30 p.m. the grievant obstructed his workmate, Sam Mweu Mwanthi, who was proceeding on duty, from boarding the van, and instructed the driver to drive off, thus causing him to report on duty late at 9. p.m. instead of 8 p.m. It is further alleged that during the investigations of the incident by the respondents the grievant refused to sign a document requiring him to go and see the Personnel Manager, Mr. D'Mello. But when he eventually went to see him, and after he was requested to apologize for his misconduct, he refused and consequently his services were terminated.

The claimants took up the matter with the respondents with a view to reinstating the grievant but no settlement was reached. In consequence, the claimants reported a formal trade dispute to the Minister for Labour and an investigator was appointed whose recommendation was that the grievant should be paid six (6) months' salary as compensation for wrongful termination of services. The claimants accepted the recommendation, but the respondents rejected it as biased, and the matter is now before the court for consideration.

The claimants prayed the court to reinstate the grievant to his job or award compensation in lieu.

The respondents prayed the court to reject the claimants' demands and to uphold their action.

The facts of this case sufficiently appear from the parties' submissions and the evidence tendered in court by the witnesses. The grievant's termination of services arose because he, while off-duty on 25th July, 1988, obstructed his fellow work-mate, Sam Mweu Mwanthi, from boarding the respondents' hired van which was transporting employees to work, thus causing Mr. Mwanthi to report on duty late. Secondly, the grievant is alleged to have refused to sign a document containing written instructions from the Floor Supervisor, Mr. H. Y. Kim, requiring him and Messrs. Wakere and Mwanthi to report to the Personnel Manager, Mr. D'Mello, on 9th August, 1983, regarding the aforestated incident. Thirdly, the grievant is also alleged to have rudely disobeyed a request by the Personnel

Manager, Mr. D'Mello, that he should apologize in writing for his misconduct pertaining to the incident.

On the circumstances surrounding the obstruction, it is on record that Mr. Mwanthi in fact reported on duty late i.e., at 9.30 p.m. instead of 8 p.m. There is also no dispute that he travelled to work by public transport when the hired van left him behind. In his evidence, the grievant admitted that after discussing about the debt for about five minutes, Mr. Mwanthi left for work using public transport, but denied that he was responsible for the later's lateness in reporting on duty.

Mr. Mwanthi explained in his evidence that the grievant blocked him from getting into the van by standing at the door; and as a result he was left behind by the van, and accordingly he was obliged to travel by public transport to work, arriving there late. Mr. Mwanthi's evidence was corroborated by Mr. Wakere who told the court that the grievant blocked the door for Mr. Mwanthi to get into the van, Mr. Mwanthi protested that he would be late for work but the grievant told him that he did not care. The grievant signaffed the driver to drive off which he did, leaving Mr. Mwanthi behind,

No doubt the most telling evidence against the grievant is that of Mr. Wakere who was also off-duty and in his company. Mr. Mwanthi was obliged to be present at his place of work at 8 p.m., but the grievant blocked him from getting into the van, and in the circumstances, Mr. Mwanthi reported on duty at 9.30 p.m. The grievant's behaviour, although outside working hours, clearly amounted to misconduct because he interfered with an employee who was proceeding on duty, thus prejudicing the respondents' operations and interests.

As regards the grievants' refusal to append his signature on a document which required him and his colleagues to go and see the Personnel Manager, Mr. D'Mello, on 9th August, 1988, the court has no reason to doubt the Security Officer's, Mr. Musyoka's, evidence on that point. The grievant's colleagues, Messrs. Mwanthi and Wakere, signed the document dated 6th August, 1988, but he refused to sign it and the security officer noted against his name; "refused to sign"; and, in the circumstances, his refusal or behaviour amounted to insubordination.

Finally, the respondents Personnel Manager, Mr. D'Mello, dealt with this matter on 9th August, 1988; and, arising from the discussion he had with the three (3) employees, he advised Mr. Wakere and the grievant to apologize for their misconduct on 25th July, 1988, in boarding the van while they were off-duty and also obstructing Mr. Mwanthi from boarding it for duty. Mr. Wakere apologized but the grievant rudely stormed out of the office. The personnel manager gave the grievant ample time until 14th August, 1988, to tender his apology, but he persisted in his refusal to apologize. In fact, his rude behaviour to the personnel manager was objectionable not because it was derogatory of any person to act towards another in that way, but because it represented a challenge to his authority bestowed upon him by the respondents. The grievant also showed by his conduct that he was impervious to any instructions and advice from his employer, and to saddle the respondents with this type of employee would be unfair.

All in all and considering the short duration of the grievant's employment with the respondents, the court finds no mitigating circumstances in this case, and it is satisfied that the grievant was not victimized by the respondents for his union activities as alleged by the claimants. The court pins the whole blame in this case on the grievant; and, for the foregoing reasons, the court takes exception to the ministry's findings and recommendation and holds that the respondents' action in terminating the grievant's services on payment of two (2) months' salary was justified, and the court so awards.

The claimants' demands for the grievant's reinstatement or payment of compensation to him are therefore rejected.



Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an apponent for an order for costs if the opposition is uncontested by the applicant.

Where it is stated in the advertisement of the applicant that the mark, upon its registration, is to be limited to certain colours, the colours are, as far as possible, indicated in the accompanying representations of the mark in the usual heraldic manner.






