CAUSE NO. 9 OF 1991

Parties:

Kenya Union of Commercial, Food and Allied Workers
and

Reli Co-operative Savings and Credit Society Ltd.

Issues in dispute:

1. (a) Minimum Wages.
- (b) Annual Increments.
- (c) General Wage Increase.
2. Housing Allowance.

Mr. J. W. Ouko for the claimants.

Messrs. J. M. Nzambu/M. S. Dallah for the respondents.

Place and dates of hearing: Nairobi, 30th May and 27th June, 1991.

AWARD

THE respondents were formed and registered as aforesaid in February, 1976, under the Co-operative Societies Act (Cap. 490) of the laws of Kenya. The society caters for the employees of the Kenya Railways Corporation; and its principal role is to promote thrift among the members through savings from which they could borrow at 1 per cent interest rate. While the unionizable employees of the Kenya Railways Corporation are members of Railway Workers' Union, the respondents' 79 unionizable employees, who fall under grades R5 to R10, and are also members of the society by virtue of their employment, are represented by the claimants' union. However, the affairs of the society are managed under the provisions of the said Co-operative Societies Act and its rules and the society's by-laws by a management committee, who are elected regularly from among its contributing members.

The parties have had dealings with each other since 5th July, 1984, when the respondents accorded the claimants recognition, and the present dispute between them arose in the course of negotiations for a review or revision of their second collective agreement, covering the period 1st January, 1988 to 31st December, 1989. In April, 1990, the claimants submitted to the respondents their proposals for a review or revision of the aforementioned collective agreement, and during their subsequent several J.N.C. meetings held in July and August, 1990, the parties agreed on all the issues except the ones now before the court for consideration.

On 2nd August, 1990, the claimants formally reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour (R. Annexure 1). The dispute was accepted by the minister and M. M. Kezziah (Mrs.) of Industrial Area Labour Office, Nairobi, was appointed to act as a conciliator in accordance with section 6 (2) (a) of the Trade Disputes Act (Cap. 234), of the laws of Kenya. The parties, however, failed to reach a settlement whereupon they signed a certificate of failure of conciliation (C. Annexure C.). Consequently the parties referred the matter to the court under section 14 (7) of the Act by completing, signing and forwarding the Notification of Dispute, Form "A" on 12th November, 1990. The court received the same on 13th February, 1991, together with the statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner in accordance with section 14 (9) (e) of the Act.

On 26th March, 1991, the claimants filed their written submissions on the demands under consideration and the respondents' written reply thereto was received by the court on 16th April, 1991. The dispute was then fixed for hearing on 25th April, 1991, but before the commencement of the hearing, the claimants raised a preliminary objection to the *locus standi* of the respondents' representative. On 2nd May, 1991, the court rejected the claimants' objection and the matter was fixed for hearing on 30th May, 1991.

1. (a) Minimum Wages:

It is perfectly legitimate for the employees to demand that the wages which they are paid are below minimum wage level and should, therefore, be raised in order to bring them to that level. This the claimants have not done in this case. They have not placed upon the record any formula that will tell precisely how much an employee should receive, nor have they placed upon the record any convincing evidence to show as to what influences must be taken into consideration in settling the minimum wage rates. The documentary evidence on record clearly shows that the minimum wages payable to the respondents' employees compare favourably with what is being paid in other SACCOS societies in the country. In the circumstances, and keeping in view the award hereinafter on the general wage increase, we reject this demand as absolutely untenable and unsustainable.

(b) Annual Increments:

The question for consideration on this demand is whether the annual increments are earned or negotiated. Admittedly, these annual increments become due to the employees by virtue of the pay scales on which they are employed. According to the claimants the employees are entitled to the increments through negotiation. On the other hand, the respondents are of the view that the annual increments are earned by the employees on satisfactory performance of their duties and entirely in the discretion of the management.

Clause 30 of the parties' outgoing collective agreement on this demand states:

"Performance and conduct of an employee will be reviewed annually by the society and increment granted, if justified, from the first day of the month in which it falls due."

This clause as formulated and the material on record in our view tilt in favour of the respondents' aforesaid arguments. However, so far as this demand is concerned we think it is high time that the respondents should lay down a wage scale of different categories of their employees so that they may get their annual increments after the expiry of every 12 months without begging for it.

In the result, this demand stands rejected for the moment, but the parties are, however, advised to review the matter further at their own level.

(c) General Wage Increase:

The written submissions and verbal arguments put in by the parties on this demand are voluminous but most of them are absolutely irrelevant.

After protracted J.N.C. meetings held on 24th July and 1st August, 1990, the parties failed to reach a settlement on this demand, and their respective positions were as follows:

Claimants' demand:

Grade R10—25 per cent for the two year period, or 12.5 per cent each year.

Grade R5—17 per cent for the two year period, or 8.5 per cent each year.

Respondents offer:

13 per cent for the two year period, or 6.5 per cent each year.

8 per cent for the two year period, or 4 per cent each year.

It is important to bear in mind that increase in wages depends on the rise in the cost of living and the financial position of the employer in bearing the burden. On the one hand, the demands of social justice and the claims of national economy require that attempts should be made to secure to the employees a fair share of the national income which they help to produce; and, on the other hand, care has to be taken that the attempt at a fair distribution does not tend to dry up the source of the national income itself. Thus, in considering increase in wages numerous complex factors, some of which are economic and some spring from social philosophy, have to be borne in mind, and serious consideration should also be given to the ability of the employer to pay.

The P.R.D. report shows that under the wage guidelines the employees are entitled to a general wage increase of 10.6 per cent each year. This would raise the unionizable employees' current annual wage bill of Sh. 1,950,565.00 to Sh. 2,156,349.60. The claimants' average demand of 42 per cent for the two year period, or 21 per cent each year, would hike the annual wage bill to Sh. 2,360,183.60 against the respondents' average offer of 21 per cent for the two years, or 10.5 per cent each year, which will bring the annual wage bill to Sh. 2,155,374.30. In our opinion the differences pertaining to the general wage increase under the wages guidelines on the one hand *vis-a-vis* the claimants' demand and the respondents' offer on the other hand are of negligible consequences.

On critical consideration of all the facts pertaining to this issue, and keeping in view wages guideline (vi), we have reached the conclusion that it will be proper for us to modify the respondents' offer in favour of the unionizable employees and award as follows:

Middle Income Group (Grades R10 to R7) —17 per cent for the two year period, or 8.5 per cent each year.

Upper Income Group (Grades R6 and R5) —12 per cent for the two years, or 6 per cent each year.

2. Housing Allowance:

The current rates of monthly house allowance payable to all the respondents' unionizable employees are as hereunder:

Grade R.10—Sh. 1,000.

Grade R.9—Sh. 1,200.
 Grade R.8—Sh. 1,400.
 Grade R.7—Sh. 1,600.
 Grade R.6—Sh. 1,800.
 Grade R.5—Sh. 2,000.

The claimants demanded an improvement on these rates as follows:

Grade R.10—Sh. 2,000.
 Grade R.9—Sh. 2,200.
 Grade R.8—Sh. 2,400.
 Grade R.7—Sh. 2,600.
 Grade R.6—Sh. 2,800.
 Grade R.5—Sh. 3,000.

However, during negotiations at their own level the claimants backed down on their demand to Sh. 400 for each grade or 40 per cent increase against the respondents' offer of Sh. 100 or 10 per cent increase all round, to be evenly applied during the two year period. The parties maintained their respective positions as above at the conciliation level.

Both parties have acknowledged the scarcity of affordable accommodation and exorbitant rents in Nairobi and other urban centres; and, for this reason, the claimants have maintained that the respondents should raise their unionizable employees' house allowance as above to enable them dress decently and live in healthy environment.

The claimants, therefore, prayed the court to award them more than the respondents' offer of Sh. 100 on this issue.

On the other hand, the respondents submitted that the claimants' demand was unrealistic, untenable and in contravention of the provisions of wages guidelines because the housing allowance rates currently enjoyed by their employees were extremely high and as such they should not be reviewed upwards for to do so would be contrary to wages guideline (iv). They cited cause No. 7 of 1978 between the Dockworkers' Union and Kenya Cargo Handling Services Ltd. in support of their case, and pointed out that the courts' hands were tied by the wages guidelines. In the circumstances, and keeping in view the need to exercise frugality in their spending, the respondents prayed the court to adopt their offer on this issue and reject the claimants' demand.

The P.R.D. report on this issue clearly shows that the claimants' demand of Sh. 400 or 40 per cent would raise the employees' current house allowance of Sh. 1,070,600 to Sh. 1,445,310, whereas the respondents' offer of Sh. 100 or 10 per cent would hike it to Sh. 1,166,954. However, in accordance with the provisions of the wages guidelines, the employees are entitled to compensation on this item of 10.55 per cent for the period under consideration. It will, therefore, be noted that the respondents' offer herein is on equal footing with the wages guidelines entitlement; and, in the circumstances, we find that the claimants' demand is on a higher side and unreasonable. However, we feel, on serious consideration of the parties' submissions and the P.R.D. report, and also taking into account the acute shortage of decent accommodation in Nairobi, that an improvement by Sh. 50 on the respondents' aforementioned offer will meet the dictates of social justice. Accordingly, we award that the current house allowance for all grades of the respondents' unionizable employees be increased across the board by Sh. 150 per month.

The parties have already agreed that the effective date of their current collective agreement and this award is 1st January, 1990. We accordingly award as above.

GAZETTE NOTICE No. 4897

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 17 OF 1991

Parties:

Transport and Allied Workers' Union (K)
 and
 Kenya Bus Services (Mombasa) Limited

Issues in dispute:

Dismissal of Kenneth Kea Katana.

THE Transport and Allied Workers Union (K) shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Kenya Bus Services (Mombasa) Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 22nd July, 1991, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. In addition the following witnesses were called to give evidence on oath.

The claimants—K. K. Katana.

The respondents—Johnson Major.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 12th June, 1990, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 18th March, 1991, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Kenneth Kea Katana was employed by the respondents on 1st November, 1979, as a bus driver. At the time of his dismissal on 19th August, 1986, he was earning Sh. 1,474 plus Sh. 550 housing allowance p.m. He was dismissed after having served the respondents for six (6) years and nearly 10 months.

The circumstances which led to the grievant's dismissal happened on 16th July, 1986. It is alleged that at the material time at Kinango/Lunga Lunga Road he drove bus No. 45 carelessly at a high speed. As a result, he caused an accident in which passengers were injured and the bus was extensively damaged.

The claimants submitted that, they took up the matter with the respondents but no settlement was reached. The claimants then on 12th June, 1989, reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour. Thereafter an investigation was carried out by the ministry and on 13th September, 1990, the findings and recommendations were released to the parties.

The ministry's findings were that the charges of drunkenness and careless driving had not been proved to warrant the grievant's dismissal.

The respondents decision to dismiss Mr. Katana was found to have been hasty and wrongful.

The ministry recommended that Mr. Katana be reinstated back to his former job without loss of benefits.

The decision was turned down by the respondents and the matter is now before the court for further consideration.

The claimants summed up their submissions, by urging the court to uphold the ministry's findings and recommendation. In addition, they prayed the court that the grievant be paid all his salary to the tune of Sh. 118,700 for the period he has been out of employment (59 months) without justifiable cause.

The respondents urged the court to find that there was justification in dismissing the grievant summarily and in rejecting the ministry's recommendation as it was biased. They prayed the court to uphold their action.

The court ordered appropriate investigations to be made when the grievant on oath stated that the criminal case against him on the charge of driving a motor vehicle under influence of drink had been disposed of and he had been acquitted against the respondents' allegation that a warrant of arrest had been issued against the grievant and the case was still pending.

Subsequent to the inquiries as ordered by the court the respondents confirmed that the grievant had been acquitted and that the information they had received from the police was not accurate.

This clears this important point in favour of the grievant but then the allegation of having driven fleet No. 45 at a high speed and in a careless manner causing extensive damage to the bus still remains.

The tachograph produced by the respondent's witness proves that the grievant did drive the vehicle at a high speed. This witness also stated that the bus had fallen on its side and the front axle, spring levers and the front part were all damaged with the result that the bus was scrapped as repairing it was not economically feasible.

Under the aforesaid circumstances the court cannot entertain any claim for compensation for the grievant in this case.

At best the grievant is entitled to a normal termination as against a summary dismissal and the court awards that the grievant's dismissal should be reduced to normal termination.

1. Refusal by management to restructure the salaries of unionizable employees following re-categorization of the bank from category E to C.
2. Salaries.
3. House Allowance.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial, Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Kenya Post Office Savings Bank Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 3rd, 4th and 23rd July, 1991, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. Previously the dispute had been fixed for hearing on 14th May, 1991, but the claimants failed to submit their memorandum as arranged.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 24th October, 1990, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 7th February, 1991, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents were established by an Act of Parliament (Cap. 501), in 1978 and started to operate with a work-force of 22 employees. The parties entered into a recognition agreement in 1982. Since then the parties have negotiated and concluded four collective agreements.

The present dispute arose when the parties embarked on negotiations with a view to reviewing their last two years collective agreement which was effective from 1st January, 1989 expiring on 31st December, 1990. The next collective agreement is to be for the period January, 1990 to 31st December, 1991. The parties agreed on all the issues, except the ones now before the court.

The respondents currently have a total labour force of 755 employees out of whom 576 are unionizable employees and are affected by this dispute.

Issue No. 1

Refusal by the management to restructure the salaries of unionizable employees following re-categorization of the bank 35 per cent

The claimants prayed the court to award the following percentage increases to their members in respect of re-categorization:

Scale	
9	26 per cent
10	35 per cent
11	42 per cent
12	41 per cent

The respondents stated that categorization of state corporations is dealt with in circular No. 1/87 from the Office of the President Ref. No. OP. 9/21/2A/Vol. 31/85 paragraphs 3, 7 and 29 respectively. They contended that the circular allowed salaries and other terms and conditions of employment reviews for non-unionizable employees only. While those of unionizable employees will continue to be determined through collective agreements every two years.

They urged the court to reject the claimants demand as it has no merit.

Issue No. 2:

Salaries.

The parties position on this item is as follows:

The employees entitlement as per the wages guidelines stipulations, for the period under review, 1988/1989 is an average of 14.8 per cent per year.

They prayed the court to award as demanded as their prayer is in line with cost of living indices.

The respondents urged the court to uphold their offer of 12 per cent wage increase each year.

Issue No. 3

House Allowance (Increase)

The claimants prayed the court to find their demands as reasonable and so award in their favour.

The respondents felt that the current entitlement of house allowance is adequate and should not be reviewed for the time being.

They prayed the court to find that the present rates are reasonable and uphold the same.

The court has given careful consideration to the parties written and verbal submissions, and the planning and research division's report in making its award on the following terms:

Refusal by management to restructure the salaries of unionizable employees following re-categorization of the bank from category "E" to "C".

The court has carefully considered the submissions made by the parties on this issue and finds that circular No. 1/87 issued by the Office of the President Ref. No. OP. 9/21/2A/Vol. 31/85) paragraph 29 is quite clear on re-categorization of state corporations. Paragraph 29 therein states as follows:

"Unionizable staff of state corporations, on the other hand will continue to have their salaries and other terms of service determined through collective agreement..."

In view of the above the court reaffirms and uphold the Government policy issued on 12th July, 1987, that whether or not a state corporation is reclassified, unionizable employees' salaries and other terms of service will still continue to be determined through collective agreements.

The claimants' demand on this issue is thus to be pursued within the collective bargaining process.

2. Salaries

The court requested the Planning and Research Division (P.R.D.) of the ministry to carry out investigations due to the fact that, some of the issues in dispute were affected by the wages guidelines. A comprehensive analysis was carried out by the P.R.D. which the court has considered in depth among other presentations. The parties also commented on the report.

The court noted that, the claimants have demanded a wage increase of an average of 13.5 per cent for the first year and a similar increase of 13.5 per cent for the second year respectively. This demand was in addition to their original demand of 38.0 per cent on average in respect of re-categorization issue stated hereinabove. All in all, the claimants demands add up to a total wage increase of 65.0 per cent for the two year duration of the agreement.

The respondents have, however, offered an increase of 12.0 per cent for the first year and a similar increase of 12.0 per cent for the second year or a total of 24.0 per cent for the two year period. The respondents in making this offer of 12.0 per cent had assumed that the workers under the wage guidelines were entitled to 9.8 per cent each year. The respondents felt that the

additional 2.2 per cent each year or a total of 4.4 per cent was to be considered as re-categorization element. The respondents were wrong in their calculation in arriving at workers' entitlement under the wage guidelines. This is clearly established by the P.R.D. report.

The P.R.D. findings are that the claimants would be entitled to an average wage increase of about 14.8 per cent each year or a total of 29.6 per cent under the wages guidelines. The court notes that both the claimants' demand and the respondents' offer were short of the wages guidelines entitlement by 2.6 per cent and 5.6 per cent respectively. In view of this, the court finds that the parties during their negotiations had not applied their minds properly to the requirements of the wages guidelines and the guidelines issued by the Office of the President contained in their letter Ref. No. OP. 9/21/2A/ISC/IX/47 of 9th September, 1990. The said letter advised that "...issues relating to re-categorization may be brought to bear on collective negotiations as bargaining points in favour of unionizable staff ...

After taking into consideration all the parties written and verbal submissions, including the P.R.D. report in this issue and the guidelines from the Office of the President, the court has decided to improve on the respondents' offer of 12.0 per cent is well under the wages guidelines.

The court keeping in mind the issue of re-categorization and guidelines contained in the letter from the Office of the President Ref. No. OP. 9/21/2A/ISC/IX/147 of 9th February, 1990, and the wages guidelines generally awards a total wage increase of 18 per cent for the second year respectively to all unionizable employees.

3. House Allowance (Increase)

The court having given due and serious consideration to all the submissions by the parties on this issue and keeping in mind the wages guidelines stipulation (IV) and re-categorization the court awards housing allowance increases as follows:

(a) Non-accountable House Allowance

- (i) scale 9-10 KSh. 1,500 p.m.
- (ii) scale 11-12 KSh. 1,250 p.m.

(b) Owner Occupied House Allowance

- (i) scale 9-10 KSh. 4,000 p.m.
- (ii) scale 11-12 KSh. 3,500 p.m.

In order for the power industry to meet the increasing demand of electricity by the economy, power generation, transmission, transformation and distribution facilities have to be continuously expanded. This expansion, which is capital intensive, is financed mainly through foreign loans. The local financial contribution is provided by The Kenya Power and Lighting Company Limited (K.P.L.C.). Thus debt servicing of foreign loans and raising counterpart local funds represent the major expenditure for the industry's operations. According to the current rate of electricity consumption, it is necessary to develop the following projects:

- 60 megawatt and 55 megawatt geothermal power projects.
- 150 megawatt stand-by generating plant.
- Sundu-Miriu hydro-power project.
- Kiambere to Nairobi 220 kilovolt transmission line.
- Nairobi to Mombasa 220 kilovolt transmission line.
- Reinforcement of transformation and distribution sub-stations.
- Rural electrification.

These are estimated to cost KSh. 48 billion, of which the current local currency component is projected to be KSh. 12 billion over the next four years. Besides this development programme, the industry is expected to service its running debts, estimated at KSh. 13 billion over the same period.

The rising debt service burden and the cost of implementation of the projects, is attributable mainly to the appreciation of the hard currencies, in which the industry has borrowed and finances the projects, against the Kenya shilling.

In consultation with the Government, the applicant continues to explore ways and means of diversifying sources of development capital with a view to moderating price increases in future.

The object of and reasons for the application are, therefore, to achieve an overall increase in revenue which is necessary to sustain the implementation of the expansion programme, debt servicing and systems operation and maintenance of the power industry.

The effect of the Minister's approval of our application will be a combined increase in fixed, demand and energy charges ranging from ten (10) to twenty (20) per cent on all categories of consumers. Details of the proposed tariff structure are contained in the proposed "Methods of Charge (K.P.L.C.) By-laws, 1991 (No. 2)". These have been deposited at the offices of the licensee and are open to public inspection during normal office hours without payment. Copies of the proposed by-laws may be purchased at the offices of the licensee at a price of KSh. 5 per copy.

Any public or local authority, company, person or body of persons desirous of making any representation on or objection to the application must do so by letter addressed to the Minister for Energy and marked on the envelope "Electric Power Act", on or before the expiration of fourteen (14) days from the date of the application and must forward a copy of such representation or objection to the applicant.
