THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

Cause No. 75 of 1990

Parties:

Railway Workers' Union (K)

and

Kenya Railways Corporation

Issue in dispute:

Refusal by the Kenya Railways to pay salary to Absalom Orito for the period he was compelled to stay away from employment, i.e. from 12th February, 1982 until 24th February, 1985, the date he was reinstated to duty.

AWARD

In this case the demand by the claimants is that the respondents be ordered by the court to pay the grievant his salary from 12th February, 1982, when he was acquitted of the charge against him by the court of appeal, to 25th February, 1985, when he was reinstated in service.

On going through the parties' lengthy written submissions and verbal arguments, we note that they have set out facts which are wholly irrelevant to the issue involved in this case, particularly those pertaining to the criminal case against the grievant and his conduct, to which we need not to refer any further hereinafter. We may also add at this juncture that we will only go by the issue contained in the no.ification of dispute form "A" and we will not tread on any other grounds which are not covered thereunder, even though they existed.

Briefly, the facts which have a bearing and necessary for the decision of the court are that the grievant joined the services of the then East African Railways and Harbours Administration as an assistant yard foreman trainee Div. FII, on 3rd June, 1963. On 30th November, 1963, he was promoted to yard foreman, grade NB VB; and on a successful and satisfactory completion of a guards' course from 2nd September, 1968, to 28th February, 1969, he was placed on guard grade RB VB. On 1st June, 1969, the grievant was promoted to guard grade NB VA.

On 6th November, 1978, the grievant, who was the guard of train No. M40 from Kitale to Eldoret, was dismissed from the services of the respondents, with the loss of all benefits and privileges, consequent upon his conviction and sentence, with two (2) others, by a Kitale Resident Magistrate to five (5) years' imprisonment and two (2) strokes of the cane each for stealing 102 bags of coffee, valued at KSh. 153,000 at Soy Station on 2nd December, 1976, on the Kitale-Eldoret track.

The grievant appealed to the high court against the lower court's conviction and sentence, but his appeal was dismissed. He lodged a second appeal to the court of appeal which ended in his acquittal on 4th February, 1982; and, at his request on the basis of his acquittal as afforestated and representation made by the claimants on his behalf through protracted numerous correspondence, the grievant was eventually reinstated in service with effect from 25th February, 1985, and has since been promoted to other rank of guard grade RB III.

After his acquittal and reinstatement as stated hereinabove, the claimants, on behalf of the grievant, demanded that the respondents should pay him his salary for the whole period he was compelled to stay away for no fault of his own; but the respondents countered that the question of salary payment to the grievant did not arise, because he did not do any work for them to warrant it. In the circumstances, and in accordance with section 4 of the Trade Disputes Act (Cap. 234), Laws of Kenya, the claimants reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour, and Mr. S. T. Nyambari of Industrial Area Labour Office, Nairobi, was appointed under section 7 of the Act to act as an investigator. The conciliation proceedings which followed ended in a deadlock; and on 1st February, 1990, the Minister for Labour recommended that the grievant should enjoy his full employment benefits for the whole period that he stayed out of employment. The claimants accepted the recommendation, but the respondents rejected it. In consequence the parties forwarded to the court on 19th February, 1990, the Notification of Dispute, Form "A", in accordance with section 14 (7) of the Act. The court received the same, accompanied by the statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner under section 14 (9) (e) thereof, on 25th July, 1990, and the matter is now before the court for consideration.

It is not disputed that the criminal case against the grievant which ended in his acquittal in the court of appeal on 4th February, 1982, formed the basis of his dismissal from the respondents' service and subsequent reinstacement on 25th February, 1985, i.e. after a period of three (3) years, Accordingly, the question of his criminality hardly arises for consideration in this case because the matter had been disposed of by a competent court of law. The main contention for the calmants is that the respondents violated staff regulation G. 9 (c) and (f) in dismissing the grievant on the very same matter which was the subject-matter of an appeal against the trial court's decision instead of waiting for the outcome of the appeal before taking any disciplinary action against him. On the contrary, the respondents maintained that they were not aware of the grievant's appeal against the lower court's decision, and in terms of staff regulation G. 9 (h) they dismissed him. They assented further that if the grievant had informed them of his pending appeal they would obviously have suspended him instead of dismissing him, and the question of the delay of his reinstatement in service would not have arisen.

It is true that very often employers stay action pending the decision of a criminal trial and that is fair, but we cannot say that the principles of natural justice require that an employer at that wait for the decision of the criminal court before taking a disciplinary action against an employee. However, where the case is of a grave nature or involves questions of law and fact which are not simple, it would be advisable for the employer to wait the decision of the trial court so that the defence of the employee in the criminal case may not be prejudiced. In this case the grievant was convicted and sentenced as aforestated by the resident magistrate's court at Kitale, and on the basis of that decision the respondents dismissed him from service as it was not in their knowledge then and thereafter that he had lodged an appeal against the lower count's decision. In the circumstances and on the facts of this case on record, there was in our opinion, no failure of matural justice, and we find no force behind the contention of the claimants that the dismissal of the grievant by the respondents during the pendency of his appeal was illegal and not maintainable.

There is another important aspect of this case. It is clear that when the grievant was acquitted of the charge on appeal the was reinstated in service by the respondents after a period of three (3) years but was not paid his wages for the period he was reinstated in service by the respondents after a period victiout pay. The claimants contended that, despite an exchange of numerous correspondence between the parties on the grievant's reinstatement, the respondents deliberately delayed neir decision on the matter and for this reason they are liable o pay the grievant his dues for the period he was kept out of work. The respondents explained that, on receipt of the claimants' letters in which they appealed for the grievant's einstatement the same were replied to regularly. After all, hey had to exhaust all the departmental inquiries on the ratter before his reinstatement. Hence the delay for three (3) ears. The explanation of the inordinate delay that the rescondents have given appears to us a bit old and wholly un-tatisfactory. The grievants' reinstatement was undoubtedly elated for it was made after considerable lapse of three (3) rears since his acquittal, and there is no convincing explanaion from the respondents for this delay. In the interest of adustrial peace, it is very necessary that cordial atmosphere hould prevail between labour and management, and that isputes, if any, should be brought up and disposed of quickly. If any party sleeps over the matter, the law will presume that his stand has no force. It is a maxim of law that it helps the vigilant and not the indolent. It is also the maxim of law that laches practically destroy the right. We do not, herefore, think in the circumstances that the respondents' lelay in reinstating the grievant within a reasonable period after his acquittal by the court of appeal can be condoned and they are not entitled to any indulgence.

For the foregoing reasons and after carefully weighing all aspects of this dispute, we are of the opinion that the respondents should not, however, be penalized to pay full back wages and benefits from the time the grievant was acquitted on appeal. Accordingly, we are satisfied that the dictates of justice and equity demand that the respondents should pay the grievant twelve (12) months' salary for the long delay in reinstating him to his job. We award accordingly.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 6 OF 1991

Parties:

Transport & Allied Workers Union

and

Kenya Bus Services Ltd. (Nairobi and Mombasa)

Issue in dispute:

Violation of clause 4:1:3—overtime.

Dates of hearing: 19th and 20th June, 1991.

AWARD

This dispute arose from the court award in cause No. 59 of 1983, which was delivered on 10th September, 1984. The issue before the court then was the interpretation of article 4:1:2 of the parties' collective agreement in force at the time which read as follows:

"4:1:2 An employee required to work by the company on his rostered rest day or gazetted public holiday will be paid double time i.e. time plus time."

We set out herein in extensio the court's findings and award thereof:

The court finds it established that the method of calculating overtime payments prior to April 1982 had been in operation for over ten (10) years and the workers had naturally got used to fairly high monthly earnings especially when they worked on rest days or public holidays. This the respondents did although the overtime clause read exactly as it reads today.

The court finds that the collective agreement clause on overtime is quite clear and the respondents having interpreted it and implemented it in a manner which benefited the workers somewhat more it should be taken to mean that the respondents intended to remunerate workers in such a manner. The respondents having done so over ten (10) years are clearly in the wrong in changing that system unilaterally and had it not been for industrial relations machinery having been set up in the country they would have faced very serious industrial unrest by depriving the workers the benefits that they had enjoyed for over ten (10) years. This practice has been in operation for such a long time that it can be deemed to be part and parcel of the relevant clause in the collective agreement.

The court has applied its mind very carefully to this dispute and finds that the claimants have a good case in that the respondents were wrong in bringing about changes from April 1982, without embarking upon negotiations with the claimants. The court accordingly directs that the respondents should revert back to the system of overtime payment which they had adopted for over ten (10) years with effect from April 1982, when changed it and remunerate the workers affected according to the old system.

The court further directs that they should continue with the old method of overtime payment until such time as they negotiate this issue with the claimants which will then be incorporated in the next collective agreement.

The respondents stated that they have, for the past six (6) years, calculated overtime payments for work performed on a gazetted public holiday based on the parties' 1985/86 and subsequent collective agreements until the issue was negotiated and the clause, i.e. Article 4:1:2—amended in terms of the court award as under:

4:1:3. An employee required to work by the company on a gazetted public holiday shall be paid double time plus a half, i.e. time plus time plus a half.

The parties met at their own level in July and August, 1989, with a view to settling the matter, but no amicable settlement was reached and the claimants reported a trade dipute to the Minister for Labour in accordance with section 4 (1) of the Trade Disputes Act (Cap. 234), of the Laws of Kenya (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"). M. M. Gitao (Mrs.) of Nairobi Provincial Labour Office, was appointed to act as a conciliator, but the conciliation proceedings which followed ended in a failure and a certificate to this effect was signed by the parties on 6th November, 1990. Consequently, on 9th November, 1990, the parties forwarded to the court the Notification of Disputes Form "A", in accordance with section 14 (7) of the Act, and the court received the same, together with the statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner under section 14 (9) (e) of the Act, on 7th February, 1991. The matter is now before the court for consideration.

The claimants argued that the correct method of calculating overtime payment on gazetted public holiday is double time plus a half in addition to the basic hourly rate.

On the issue of "make-up system", the claimants stated that, contrary to the award in cause No. 59 of 1983, the respondents, Nairobi branch, unilaterally reverted to it in 1985, but it was not until July/August, 1989, when their attention was drawn to the respondents' violation of the clause. In October, 1989, the respondents' Mombasa branch also adopted the same wrong method in calculating gazetted public honday overtime payment.

The claimants, therefore, prayed the court to reject the respondents' stand and award that the parties revert back to the system of overtime payment which was obtaining and applicable prior to April, 1982.

In rebuttal, the respondents submitted that their method of calculating gazetted public holiday overtime payment was correct, and they have been using the same method since 1985/86 collective agreement. They denied that they have either violated the clause under consideration or contravened the court award in clause No. 59 of 1983, by miscalculating the gazetted public holiday overtime payment. In support of their contention the respondents cited Legal Notice No. 8 of 1988, in respect of Protective Security Services and cause No. 40 of 1979, between the Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers and E. A. Power & Lighting Co. Ltd., in which public holidays formed part of the days worked during the month.

The respondents denied further that they are applying the "make-up system" in calculating the gazetted public holidays overtime payments of the employees.

Accordingly, the respondents prayed the court that the claimants' case should be rejected in total.

The question for our consideration here is what is the true interpretation or meaning of the language which the parties to this dispute have employed in sub-clause 4:1:3 of their collective agreement. In construing a sub-clause, such as we have here, effort should be made not to interpret it in isola-tion, but in the context of the entire clause so as to make a consistent whole. The correct rule is that if any construction of a sub-clause does not fit in with the rest of the clause, it must be rejected and that construction has to be looked into which would apply to all parts of the entire clause equally. The courts are entitled, when constructing any provision found in an argeement, to consider other parts of a clause which throws light upon the intention of the parties and may serve to show that the particular sub-clause ought not to be construed as it would be if considered alone and apart from the rest of the clause. In other words, each part of the clause must expound every other part. In interpreting sub-clause 4:1:3, of the parties' collective agreement, the entire clause 4 on "overtime" must, therefore, have full play; and it should not be readily concluded that a particular provision is either redundant or repugnant with another. Attempt should be made to reconcile the various provisions unless it is not possible to do so, and want of skill in drafting a provision should not affect the correct interpretation of it.

It is stated in Mitra's Legal & Commercial Dictionary, 4th edition, that overtime:

"... relates to time worked and paid for at a premium rates beyond the standard period of work for which the basic wage is paid."

In a Dictionary of Economics and Commerce, 6th Edition, by J. L. Hanson, overtime means:

"additional time worked in excess of the number of hours laid down as the normal working week for an industry."

Derek French & Heather Seward in the Dictionary of Management, states that overtime is:

"time worked in excess of normal hours."

It is therefore, an accepted principle that the ratio of the time rate for overtime to a basic or standard rate is often paid at higher rate, e.g., time and a quarter, time and a half, double time, double time and a half, etc., over and above the rate for normal hours. Many workers support claims for a shorter working week, not because of a wish for more leisure, but in order to enable more overtime to be worked and a higher rate of pay to be obtained. Under sub-clause 4:1:3; an employee is allowed a complete rest on his rest day or a gazetted public holiday without having to worry about his wages for that day. If the employee is required to work by the company on any of those rest days, the underlying idea under the said overtime clause in general, or, sub-clause 4:1:3 in particular, would be to help the employee and not to deprive him of his wages and thereby to reduce his income.

Under clause 1 of the parties' collective agreement, the maximum hours of work spread over six (6) days a week are fixed at 45 hours.

Any employee who is asked to work beyond these hours would obviously be working overtime and respondents in fairness would be expected to pay him compensation for such overtime work. We would interpret "overtime" in sub-clause 4:1:3, reproduced herein above to mean the number of hours actually worked by an employee over and above the normal working hours as provided under clause 1 in the parties' collective agreement, and every employee, who has put in overtime over and above the said normal working hours, would be entitled to overtime payment calculated on the total overtime hours worked by him times the number of days that he has worked.

In the circumstances, we have reached the conclusion that the claimants have made out a case in support of their demand as supported by the P.R.D. report at page 3 thereof. The plea by the respondents that one part of the overtime allowance on a rest day or a gazetted public holiday is merged in the basic wage is not sustainable because such an ad hoc addition,

if allowed, would lead to a disturbance in the structure of the basic monthly wages. The authorities cited by the respondents in support of their contention do not, therefore, help them in any way.

The demand as framed is in the nature of a declatory issue, and the order of the court in such a case is only a declaration. Accordingly, we are of the opinion that some relief should be given to the employees who have worked beyond normal working hours; and in the result we direct that the affected employees be paid overtime for the work they have performed on rest days and gazetted public holidays, and the demand is accepted and awarded to this extent.

- 3. The lessee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.
- 4. Should the lessee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he/she is unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid, the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the lessee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given—

- (a) within twelve (12) months of the actual registration of the lease, the Commissioner of Lands, shall refund to the lessee 50 per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land;
- (b) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund the lessee 20 per cent of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made.
- 5. The land and buildings shall only be used for one private dwelling house.
- 6. The buildings shall not cover more than 50 per cent of the area of the plot.
- 7. The grantee shall not subdivide the land without prior written consent of the Commissioner of Lands.
- 8. The grantee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the possession of the land or any part thereof or any building thereon except with prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands. No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until special condition No. 2 has been performed.
- 9. The grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands, on demand, such sum as the Commissioner of Lands may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall, on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost, either pay (within seven (7) days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid.
- 10. The grantee shall, from time to time, pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner of Lands may assess.
- 11. Should the Commissioner of Lands at any time require the said roads to be constructed to a higher standard, the grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands, on demand, such proportion of the cost of such construction as the Commissioner of Lands may assess.
- 12. The grantee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever descriptions as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any Government or local authority upon the land or the buildings erected thereon, including any contribution or other sum paid by the President of the Republic of Kenya in licu thereof.

13. The President of the Republic of Kenya or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground and the grantee shall not erect any building in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of mains or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains.

14. The Commissioner of Lands reserves the right to revise the annual ground rent payable hereunder after the expiration of every ten (10) years of the term granted. Such rental shall be at a rate to be determined by the Commissioner of Lands of the unimproved value of the land as at the end of every tenth (10th) year of the term.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signature must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

EXTRACT FROM THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION D-

"D 41. (1) Communications for the Kenya Gazette should reach the Government Printer not later than 9 a.m., on Friday of the week before publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the Gazette.

(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward Gazette notices to the Government Printer when ready."
