**ELECTIONS REGULATIONS, 1992** NOTICE OF ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 42a of the Constitution of Kenya, section 13 subsection (3) (b) of the National Assembly and Presidential Elections Act and Regu-lations 8 (3) and 14 of the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections Regulations, 1992, the Electoral Commission gives notice that :

- (a) An election is to be held of members to serve in the National Assembly for Bonchari and Migori constituencies.
- (b) Each political party wishing to participate in the election must finalize the nomination of its candidates on or before 26th April, 1993.

(c) The day for the nomination for the parliamentary election will be the 28th April, 1993, and nomination papers may be delivered by candidates to the returning officer between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and one o'clock in the afternoon on the 28th April, 1993.

(d) If the parliamentary election is contested the poll will take place on the 20th May, 1993.

1. The attention of candidates and persons subscribing nomi-nation papers is drawn to the provisions of part IV of the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections Regulations.
