NOTICE OF ELECTION OF MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 42A of the Constitution of Kenya, section 13 subsection (3) (b) of the National Assembly and Presidential Elections (Act and regulations 8 (3) and 14 of the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections Regulations, 1992, the Electoral Commission gives notice that:

- (a) An election is to be held of a member to serve in the National Assembly for the Kisauni Constituency.
- (b) Each political party wishing to participate in the election must finalize the nomination of its candidate on or before Friday, 3rd December, 1993.
- (c) The day for the nomination for the parliamentary election will be Monday, 6th December, 1993, and nomination papers may be delivered by candidates to the returning officer between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and one o'clock in the afternoon on Monday, 6th December, 1993.

(d) If the parliamentary election is contested the poll will take place on Wednesday, 22nd December, 1993.
