THE PRESIDENTIAL AND PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS REGULATIONS, 1992

NOTICE OF ELECTION OF MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 42A of the Constitution of Kenya, section 13 subsection (3) (b) of the National Assembly and Presidential Elections Act and regulations 8 (3) and 14 of the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections Regulations, 1992, the Electoral Commission gives notice that:

- An election is to be held of a member to serve in the National Assembly for the Lugari Constituency.
- Each political party wishing to participate in the election must finalize the nomination of its candidate on or before Friday, 11th February, 1994.
- The day for the nomination for the parliamentary election will be Tuesday, 15th February, 1994, and nomination papers may be delivered by candidates to the returning officer between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and one o'clock in the afternoon on Tuesday, 15th February, 1994.

(d) If the parliamentary election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 3rd March, 1994.

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1992

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 42A of the Constitution of Kenya, section 57 of the Local Government Act and rule 12 (3) and (c) of the Local Government Elections Rules, the Electoral Commission gives notice that:

(a) An election is to be held to determine the councillors to serve in the electoral areas set out in the schedule hereunder.

(b) Each political party wishing to participate in the election must finalize the nomination of its candidates on or before Friday, 11th February, 1994.
