- (d) To report on measures necessary to deal firmly with this menace.

(e) To examine any other matters which the Probe Committee considers relevant.

THE PRESIDENTIAL AND PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS REGULATIONS, 1992

POLLING AREAS AND POLLING STATIONS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 6 (1) of the Presidential and Parliamentary Elections Regulations, the Electoral Commission gives notice for the purpose of the forthcoming elections to the National Assembly and 22 local authority councils that—

- (a) the constituencies appearing in capital letters in the first column are respectively divided into the polling areas named in the second column;
- (b) the polling areas are each assigned polling stations with distinguishing letters and numbers specified in the third column;
- (c) each polling area has the place or places specified in the fourth column as place or places at which the polling station or polling stations for such polling area shall be established.
