



Applications must be sent so as to reach the county clerk not later than noon, on 1st February, 1995, and the applicants must enclose with their applications either a banker's cheque, money order or postal order for KSh. 1,000 made payable to the Commissioner of Lands as deposit which will be dealt with as follows:
 - (a) Credited to a successful applicant.
 - (b) Refunded to an unsuccessful applicant.
 - (c) Forfeited if a successful applicant fails to pay within thirty (30) days of the offer of a plot, and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto.
- 4. Each application should be accompanied by a statement indicating:
 - (a) The amount of capital it is proposed to spend on the project.
 - (b) The amount of actual capital available for development with banker's letter or other evidence of financial status in support.

General Conditions

- 3. The lessee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.
- 4. Should the lessee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he is unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid, the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the lessee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given—

- (a) within twelve (12) months, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the lessee fifty (50) per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land; or

The lessee shall pay rates, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever description as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any Government or local authority upon the land or buildings erected thereon including any contributions or other sum paid by the President of the Republic of Kenya in lieu thereof.

15. The President of the Republic of Kenya or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground and the grantee shall not erect any buildings in such way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments for main or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains.
