- Any person guilty of an offence under this resolution shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding KSh. 2,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months or to both fine and imprisonment as provided by section 257 of the Local Government Act.

- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.
