- (iii) Candidates who attempt and fail occpational tests Nos. I and II will not be allowed to take them until after a period of two (2) years from the date they first attempted the tests.
- (iv) Those senior subordinate staff deployed on telephone operator function, in possession of Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Division IV, may be allowed to sit for the Telephone Occupational Test II, provided that they have completed at least five (5) years' continuous service.

CONDITIONS FOR PASSING THE OCCUPATIONAL TESTS

In order to pass any of the occupational tests a candidate is required to pass both the written English (or oral English test in the case of blind telephone operators) and the practical test at one and the same sitting. No partial passes are allowed.

APPLICATION FORMS

Candidates should complete their application forms (in triplicate) and submit the original and duplicate to the Public Service Commission, through their Permanent Secretaries/heads Service Commission, through their Permanent Secretaries/heads of department. A specimen of the application form is shown as the "Appendix" to this circular letter. The form should be reproduced by each ministry/department as required. Completed forms should be submitted to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, Commission House, Harambee Avenue, P.O. Box 30095, Nairobi, so as to reach him not later than 3rd March, 1995. Permanent Secretaries/heads of department must ensure that the entry forms are: must ensure that the entry forms are:

(a) Filled in correctly in triplicate and one copy remains with

the ministry.

(b) Certified correct in all respects.

(c) Received from eligible candidates only (as stipulated in paragraph 2 (i) to (ii) above).

Submitted to the Commission by the closing date, that is, on or before 3rd March, 1995.

(e) Accompanied by the correct registration fee of KSh. 300 per candidate.

REGISTRATION FEES

Each entry form must be accompanied by a registration fee of KSh. 300 only. This fee will not be refundable under any circumstances, and should be remitted in either Kenya Government cheques or banker's cheques, payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya. Personal cheques, money orders and postal orders will not be accepted.

EXAMINATION CENTRES

Provincial headquarters at Mombasa, Nyeri, Embu, Nairobi, Nakuru, Kakamega, Kisumu and Garissa, will be the examination centres for the written English language examination. Ministries/departments presenting candidates for the tests should specify clearly on the entry forms the appropriate centres at which their candidates should sit the examination. The actual venues at each provincial centre will be notified to the candidates after the closing date for registration.

EXAMINATION STATIONERY

Examination stationery and question papers for the wirtten English language examination will be supplied to the candidates by the provincial education officers-in-charge of provincial centres. Candidates will be required to have their own pens, rulers, pencils and ink. No other items of stationery such as books, magazines, files, etc., will be permitted into the examination room.

Answer Pink Covers Me will be necessary for each candidate to write clearly the name of the examination, subject title, examination index number and the name of the examination centre on the answer pink cover provided.

CERTIFICATES No certificates will be issued to successful candidates but their names will be published in both the Kenya Gazette and in a circular letter addressed to all the Permanent Secretaries/ heads of department.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT Cause No. 37 of 1994

Parties:

Kenya Union of Sugar Plantation Workers and

Sugar Employers Group of F.K.E.

Issue in Disputes:

"Separate wages for unionizable employees in parastatal "B" category status"

THE Kenya Union of Sugar Plantation Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Sugar Employers Group of Federation of Kenya Employers, shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 30th August and 25th October, 1994, respectively. The parties relied on their written and verbal submissions.

3. The notification of dispute form "A" dated 6th April, 1994, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 31st May, 1994, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are composed of six (6) sugar companies, five (5) of which are classified as state corporations and are placed in different categories of state corporations as follows:

- 1. Chemilil Sugar Company Ltd.—category "C".
- 2. Muhoroni Sugar Company Ltd.—category "E".
- 3. Mumias Sugar Company Ltd.—category "B".
- 4. Nzoia Sugar Company Ltd.—category "C".
- 5. South Nyanza Sugar Company Ltd.—category "C".
- 6. Miwani Sugar Company Ltd. (semi private)-category "E".

The sugar industry group employs nearly 13,000 workers. However, this dispute is directed at one of the member sugar company namely Mumias Sugar Company Limited (M.S.C.). The company employs a total labour-force of 4,000 employees out of whom 500 are managers the balance being unionizable employees who are affected by this dispute.

This dispute arose when the parties were negotiating for renewal of their collective agreement which expired on 30th April, 1993. The parties negotiated and agreed on all other issues except this one now before court.

The claimants submitted that, M.S.C. was on 1st July, 1989, up-graded to category "B" from "C" within the parastatal's categorizations. As a result, the terms and conditions of the entire management staff were revised upwards to match with the new status. The claimants explained that the management staffs' terms and conditions of employment were made better than those of category "C" and salaries alone were adjusted by 47 per cent.

Tre claimants further stressed that the guidelines on state corporations are very clear where a parastatal is up-graded. The guidelines require that unionizable employees benefit from the up-grading through their collective agreements through negotiations. Consequently, on 11th June, 1993, proposals for new salary scales for unionizable employees working for M.S.C. different from other member companies, were forwarded to the respondents. The claimants proposed the following new salary scales.

The claimants submitted that their demand for new salary scales for M.S.C. was turned down by the respondents. The claimants stated that they were offered a production allowance in place of the new salary scales. The claimants stated that the production allowance was not acceptable to them because

it was not in line with the up-grading status.

The claimants submitted that their demand was based on two grounds. Firstly it was the workers ability that had brought about the changes in the M.S.C. status from category "C" to "B". Secondly the procedures followed in other parastatals up-graded in the past is that, unionizable employees terms and conditions are automatically adjusted. The claimants then listed National Cereals and Produce Board, Coffee Board of Kenya and Kenya Ports Authority, respectively, as some of the corporations where salaries for unionizable employees were adjusted upwards upon up-grading.

The claimants insisted that upon up-grading of a state corporation it becomes imperative for both management and unionizable employee's salaries to be adjusted automatically. However, in this case it is only the management salaries which were automatically adjusted. The unionizable employees who are the majority were left out.

The claimants also referred the court to its own award in cause Nos. 2 of 1991 and 75 of 1987, respectively. They argued that in both instances the court had rejected argued that in both instances the court had rejected argued the court of ments advanced by the employers. As a result, the court found merit in the unions demands and proceeded to award the unionizable employees the same percentage offered to the management upon up-grading. They urged the court to reach the same findings in this dispute because the facts in law and material are the same in this dispute as in the earlier ones.

The claimants maintained that production allowance and new salary scales are basically different in several respects. They felt that production allowance is for both the management and unionizable employees. It is an incentive and by its nature it is temporary and depends on continued high production. Above all it is the management that decides what percentage to give. However, once salary scales are given they are there to stay and have direct effect on overtime and other benefits.

The claimants concluded their submissions by stating that the respondents in this matter are discriminating against the unionizable employees. In addition, they are ignoring the factor of ability to pay by holding down M.S.C. to the same level with other member companies.

They prayed the court to award unionizable employees of M.S.C. 47 per cent by way of salary adjustment to "B" status. The same should be effective from 1st July, 1989. In addition they should retain production allowance.

The respondents submitted that they have failed to find which guidelines require that unionizable employees benefit automatically upon re-categorization of any state corporation. They stressed that paragraph 29 of the guidelines on review of salaries and other terms of service for parastatal organiza-tions issued by the Government on 12th July, 1987 is very clear on terms and conditions of unionizable employees. They emphasized that the guidelines require that salaries and other terms for unionizable employees be reviewed in accordance with the parties collective agreement.

The respondents stated that the claimants demands for separate wages for M.S.C. for its higher productivity is adequately covered by the parties collective agreement. They stressed that the parties agreement clause 7 provides payment for production allowance and the clause has been fully implemented. They felt that the claimants should not be allowed to seek for additional payments to their members.

The respondents emphasized that the list of state corporations tabled by the claimants is irrelevant in the present dispute. Firstly they said the state corporations so listed usually negotiate as single entity. Whereas the respondents negotiate as an industry. As a result, it is not possible to single out a member within an industry or a group and demand to have separate negotiations. They felt that the claimants demand for a separate negotiations with M.S.C. is a wild demand and unsustainable.

The respondents went on to submit that M.S.C. is a parastatal organization which must be guided by guidelines issued from time to time by the Government. As a result, it cannot take any action which is in conflict with those guidelines. They felt that the claimants have no option but to seek better terms for their members through negotiations under the incentive clause in the parties collective agreement.

The respondents urged the court to find that the claimants demand for separate wages for unionizable employees in para-"B" status is not in line with the provisions of statal category the guidelines. In addition, the demand is contrary to the Government's policy and industrial practice in the country. They prayed the court to reject the claimants demand totally.

This dispute has been prompted by the up-grading of the respondents member Mumias Sugar Company Ltd. (M.S.C.) from category "C" status to category "B" with effect from 1st July,

There is no dispute that as a result of the up-grading the nonunionizable employees of M.S.C. received salary increases with an increase in other benefits as well. The unionizable employees, however, received salary increases and other benefits strictly in line with the collective agreement negotiated between the claimants and the Sugar Employers Group of F.K.E. This collective agreement is effective from 10th May, 1993 and is to run for two years from that date until 30th April, 1995.

The claimants had put forward an additional demand for a further increase in wages to be given separately for Mumias Sugar Company. This is recorded in an agreement to disagree signed by the parties on 11th June, 1993 in the following terms:

"At their J.I.C. meeting held on 11th June, 1993 at the F.K.E. headquarters, Wanjiri House, Nairobi, (the parties above were not able to agree on item 34 (b) i.e. schedule "B" (Parastatals Category "B") as submitted by the union in its proposal in respect of the revision of the parties collective agreement.

Whereas the parties have agreed to the revision of the C.B.A. and agreed on a wage increase of 40 per cent and 28 per cent for the lower and upper groups respectively for the two years, the union demands that in addition a further increase on wages be made separately for Mumias Sugar Company on the basis of its higher productivity. The provisions of the Trade Dispute Act will be involved in item 34 (b)."

This was followed by another J.I.C. meeting on 13th July, 1993 where under minute 4/1994: "Incorporation of the allowances with salaries both parties agreed to reach an acceptable per cent increase (taking into account the allowance currently paid) and load it to the already negotiated wages."

Another meeting took place on 28th July, 1993 (following a strike by the employees of Mumias Sugar Company) where Mr. Konditi of F.K.E. pointed out that the matter was touching on the increase of wages but Mumias Sugar Company had not sought authority from the Parastatals Advisory Committee to discuss it with the claimants. Prior to this, however, on 19th July, 1993, the parties had reached an agreement with the assistance of the provincial labour officer in the following terms. This agreement is signed by Mr. Omanga for the claimants, Mr. Brown for M.S.C. and Mr. Lumbugu the P.L.O.

- It was agreed at a J.I.C. meeting on Tuesday, 13th July, 1993, that Mumias Sugar Company being in category "B", its unionizable employees shall be paid a category "B" wage scale to be included in the new C.B.A. signed on 11th June, 1993.
- 2. So far we have reached a minimum wage (M.I.) of KSh. 1.831.34, for year one and KSh. 2,215.08, for year two, and a maximum (M9), of KSh. 6,028.54, for year one and KSh. 6,901.79, for year two.
- It was agreed that the F.K.E. will continue negotiations with the K.U.S.P.W. to improve on these figures, provided that the workers resume duties with immediate effect.
- 4. It is further agreed that there will be no victimization of unionizable staff by management, or vice versa, following todays events (19th July, 1993).

F.K.E.'s stand on behalf of respondents reflected an about turn on their part as they had indicated their willingness to load an extra salary increase for Mumias Sugar Company employees.

The Government rejected a separate wages schedule for category "B" sugar company for its unionizable employees and instead suggested that M.S.C. may use clause 7 in the C.B.A. when seeking to deal with the situation.

To make matters worse for the respondents their personnel and training manager is reported to have said as per a report in *habari Musco* of June, 1991, that the management and the claimants branch officials had agreed in principle that the new salary scales be at par with those paid to other employees working in category "B" parastatals in the country.

The court has now before it the claimants demand for an additional 45 per cent salary increase to be loaded in the group's agreement for M.S.C. employees only to reflect their up-grading to category "B". They want this to be back dated to 1st July, 1989.

The respondents main planks for vigorously opposing this demand is based on section 29 of the Government advisory to all parastatals dated 12th July, 1987, which section reads as follows:

Unionizable staff of state corporations on the other hand will continue to have their salaries and other terms of service determined through collective agreements but it is stressed that state corporations must seek specific guidance from the

Inspectorate of State Corporations prior to starting any negotiations with unions on review of salaries and other terms of service. The exercise should commence three months before the expiry of existing agreements.

The respondents maintain there is no automatic up-grading for unionizable employees and it has to be negotiated and this has already been done in the C.B.A. currently in force. Moreover, the claimants are bound by the recognition agreement in which it is clearly stated that the claimants will not undertake negotiations with an individual member of the group.

The respondents stressed that the only way in which M.S.C. employees could be compensated somewhat higher than other members of the group was under clause 7 of the C.B.A. on incentives and the respondents had in fact acted under this clause with the result that M.S.C. employees exceeded the C.B.A. rates for the various grades by KSh. 300 per month to KSh. 629.80 per month and for clerks, checkers and teachers by KSh. 361.10 to KSh. 511.10 per month.

The court notes that although there has been a decline in sugar production M.S.C. has not withdrawn or suspended production allowance. Further M.S.C. is the only company in the group which has been giving production allowances and bonuses to its employees.

The court is aware that in 1993, production allowance was increased from 10 per cent to 17.7 per cent with effect from 1st May, 1993, for the middle grade and from 6 per cent to 10.2 per cent for the upper grade again with effect from 1st May, 1993.

The court has now to decide how to come to a satisfactory and fair solution for both the parties. The court has to take into account very important development that have taken place in the sugar industry.

To begin with the free importation of sugar has resulted in big stocks piling up at M.S.C. with the factory working at 50 per cent capacity. Then there is the Government's intention to privatize the sugar industry and also that it is the intention of the Government to put all sugar companies in category "C". A Bill to that effect has already been published.

The court has carefully considered the M.S.C. employees expectations or up-grading of their employer but the court has to tamper their expectations by chanelling them in the right direction and also with their future job security and the economic plight of the sugar industry as a whole and its future.

The court is constrained to mention that the workers expections were further reinforced by the aforesaid two agreements during J.I.C. meetings and the report in *Habari Musco* until the intervention of F.K.E. in negotiations.

The court must severely criticize the M.S.C. management for these because they should have known how to go about their negotiations with unionizable employees in accordance with section 29 of the advisory to the parastatals issued by the Government. They were clearly acting outside the procedures specified.

In this dispute before the court M.S.C. is part of a group of employers who are subject to valid recognition and collective agreements between the group and the claimants and so long as they are members of the group they are bound by these agreements.

On the other hand the court is satisfied that M.S.C. unionizable employees deserve extra remuneration after the upgrading of M.S.C. to category "B".

In view of the special circumstances of this dispute although the court is not prepared to load this extra remuneration for the M.S.C. employees on the salaries specified for the group unionizable employees. The court has come to the conclusion that clause 7 of the collective agreement should be used for this purpose.

After taking into consideration the percentage allowance already being paid to M.S.C. employees as production allowance the court awards that this allowance should be further increased by 20 per cent with effect from the 1st of the month following the court award. The court further rules that the respondents shall not unilaterally withdraw this production allowance.



 - (iv) in the event that the Technical Assistance Agreement terminates;
 - (v) in the event that there occurs any such change in the capital ownership and/or the management control of licensee as, in the sole discretion and opinion of licensor, may adversely affect the performance of this agreement.
- (r) Licensor may terminate this agreement by giving written notice to licensee in case licensee shall have been in a breach or default and such breach or default shall not have been cured within sixty (60) days after receipt of notice specifying the nature of such breach or default.
