Parties:

Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers
and
Kenya Bankers (Employers) Association

Issue in Dispute:

Revision of wages for 1994/95.

The Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Kenya Bankers (Employers) Association shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 5th and 7th July, 1994, respectively. They relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

The notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 3rd June, 1994, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 6th June, 1994, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents consist of twenty-three (23) member banks and have a collective agreement with the claimants.

The following are the members of the respondents:

This dispute affects nearly 12,000 unionizable employees in the banking industry out of a total of 13,700, the balance being members of the management staff.

This dispute arose in March, 1994, when the parties were revising the wages clause in their collective agreement for the period 1st March, 1994, upto 28th February, 1995. The parties held several meetings but they failed to reach an agreement. The dispute was then reported to the Minister for Labour and Manpower Development by the respondents and a conciliator was appointed to assist the parties in reaching a settlement.

However, before the conciliation process was effected, the claimants requested that the parties be given a chance to try to settle the matter amicably at their own level. As a result, the parties reopened negotiations on 27th and 30th May, 1994, respectively. The re-negotiations were followed by a one day strike in the banks on 2nd June, 1994. Thereafter, a conciliation meeting was held on 3rd June, 1994, at which the parties recorded a deadlock. They agreed to refer the matter to the court for arbitration.

The claimants submitted that their demand in terms of salaries percentage increase of 70 per cent across the board is based on two factors. Firstly, the cost of living rise during 1993. Secondly, the workers entitlement under the wages guidelines. The claimants further submitted that all the respondents member banks

are able to meet their demand of 70 per cent because the banks have continued to make huge profits. The claimants cited the following banks and their profits for the 1993 financial year.

The claimants further stated that although they are basing their demand on the wages guidelines limitations, the member banks have not created new job opportunities as envisaged under the same wages guidelines. On the contrary, the claimants stated that some banks have initiated early retirement scheme without making equivalent replacements.

The claimants finally accused the respondents for giving the management staff wage increases ranging from 35 per cent to 300 per cent. As a result the respondents have continued to widen the gap between the unionizable employees and the management staff. The claimants felt that the respondents offer on general wage increase was not in conformity with the wages guidelines and the overall wage policy in the country.

The claimants concluded their submission by stating that they have put forward before the court a well proved case in which an award of 70 per cent is justified.

The respondents submitted that their general wage increase offer of an average of 33.75 per cent is based on the cost of living rise during 1993, and the same is within the wages guidelines. They stated that in the last four years consecutively, annual general wage increases granted to the claimants members have been higher than those permitted by the wages guidelines. The respondents further submitted that not all member banks as alleged by the claimants made huge profits in the year 1993, and cited Standard Chartered Bank as an example. They dismissed the 1994 projected profit margins figures given by the claimants for their member banks as mere speculations. The respondents stated that profits realized by the banks are shared on one hand between the Government and shareholders in form of taxes and dividends. On the other hand, the employees are given bonuses. The claimants, however, are asking for more than their share of earned profits. The respondents submitted that in conformity with the wages guidelines objectives of creating new job opportunities, their member banks have increased the number of unionizable employees for the last four years. They estimated that their employment growth was at a rate of about 12 per cent for the period 1990, up to 1993. The respondents stressed that the early retirement schemes implemented lately by their members is a matter between an individual employee and his employer, and there is nothing the claimants could do about it. The respondents submitted that the member banks management staff salary scales and other benefits enjoyed are not the concern of the claimants in accordance with the parties recognition agreement. They further stated that the claimants cannot properly interpret management's salary scale (even if they knew the scales) because the claimants do not know the basis on which those scales are fixed.

The respondents submitted that their unionizable employees enjoy other benefits besides the salaries earned. They named some of the benefits enjoyed by the claimants members as follows—

- service increments;
- leave allowances; and
- overtime payments.

The respondents concluded their case by stating that their offer of 33.5 per cent and 34 per cent general wage increases was reasonable. They prayed the court to award in terms of the offer made by them.

The court would like to emphasize that its awards in economic disputes have a major impact on the national economy and that such awards cannot be expected to be isolated and restricted to the particular industry involved in the dispute.

The court has also got to be careful that its awards do not lead to contraction of employment opportunities as the biggest challenge which our country is facing at present is to provide jobs for the ever rising number of job seekers with various levels of education.

The court, however, cannot be oblivious to the compelled necessities of the times the most pertinent being the high

inflation that has hit the country in the last couple of years, and which has seriously eroded the workers' purchasing power.

Under section 14, subsection 10 of the Trade Disputes Act, it is provided:

"In the exercise of its powers under this Act, the Industrial Court shall be bound by any guidelines or other directives relating to wage and salary levels and other terms and conditions of employment that may be issued from time to time to the court by the Minister for the time being responsible for finance".

The claimants referred to the guidelines issued by the Minister for Finance on 16th June, 1994, but the respondents relied on the previous guidelines which were issued on 7th April, 1993.

The cause of action so to say in this dispute arose in February/March this year when the new guidelines had not been issued and the court finds that the April, 1993 guidelines apply to this dispute.

The court is required to ensure that increases in wages and salaries do not exceed the rate of income growth in the economy as a whole so as to reduce income disparities through employment creation.

Guidelines (iv) and (iv) (a) read as follows:

- (iv) The workers' wages should not normally be eroded by price increases. Compensation for price increases other than those caused by taxation should be based on the rise in the Nairobi Wage Earners' Price Index from the time of most recent revision of wages and salaries.
- (iv) (a) Compensation for the rise in the cost of living for all income groups should not be more than three-quarters of the rise in the cost of living, as calculated in the Nairobi Consumer Prices Index. The percentage of compensation should decline progressively as applied to the higher paid employee groups.

The court would like to refer to what the parties themselves agreed at their own level during the past four years. The workers were granted wage increases in excess of the permissible limit in the guidelines.

In the year 1993/94, the wage increases were as follows:

Job category.—Section heads, check clerks, clerical staffs and copy typist, 27 per cent (under the guidelines the permissible limit was 15.3 per cent).

Job category.—Technical and subordinate staff, 29 per cent (under the guidelines the permissible limit was 18.4 per cent).

It is clear that the parties have set a trend whereby workers get wages in excess of the permissible limit under the guidelines.

This time there is a serious disagreement between the parties on the rise in the cost of living during the material time.

The respondents computation of cost of living is as follows:

Income group	Cost of living
Lower	47.4 per cent
Middle	43.1 per cent
Upper	49.5 per cent
AVERAGE	46.7 per cent

Three-quarters of the average rise in the cost of living is 35 per cent.

In view of the high payroll costs, the respondents have offered 33.5 per cent increase for section heads and others, and 34 per cent for technical and subordinate staff.

The claimants on the other hand have relied on the statistics provided by the P.R.D. of the Ministry of Labour and Manpower Development which show that the average of the total applicable compensation percentage for the lower, middle and upper income groups is 72.8 per cent from 1st March, 1993, to February, 1994.

Here, the court would like to point out that this figure includes percentage for house allowance which is not in dispute in this case. This leaves the following figures.

The point to note here is that most of the unionizable bank employees are in the middle and upper income group.

Leaving this for a moment, the court would like to observe the level of employment in the respondents member banks to assess how many new jobs were created in this sector during last year. The P.R.D. report reveals that:

- (a) 7 banks recorded unionizable staff increases.
(b) 9 banks recorded unionizable staff decreases.
(c) 5 banks maintained same levels of unionizable staff.
(d) Overall the banks workforce is shown to have remained the same level between 1992 and 1994.

The court has noted the respondents vigorous plea that as a group they have created 12 per cent new jobs.

It is also a fact that bonuses are paid to banks employees and that Standard Chartered Bank despite profit level having declined, paid their employees bonuses at the rate of 25 per cent. Of course, the bonuses are paid on the basis of the employees salaries and the management staff get a bigger share although the management staff of Standard Chartered Bank did not get any bonus last year.

There is also a dispute on the number of months that have been taken into account while working out the cost of living rise in the previous year. The respondents maintain that the P.R.D. figure are based on a 13 months period while the Chief Economist P.R.D., reiterated that his approach based on the period March, 1993, to end of February, 1994 was the correct one.

The court has always relied upon and has been guided by the P.R.D. analysis in all economic disputes.

After careful consideration and evaluation of the parties submissions, and the important factors set out hereinabove in this award, the court awards the following wage increase:

Job category.—Section heads, check clerks, clerical staff and copy typist, 44 per cent.

Job category.—Technician and subordinate staff, 45 per cent.

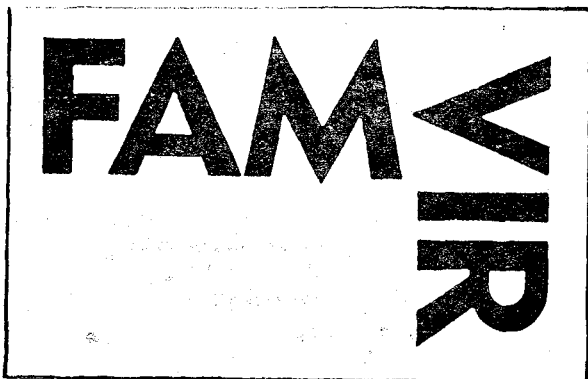

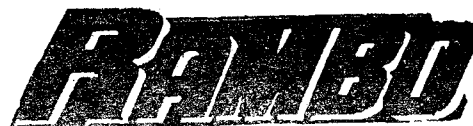
