APPOINTMENT OF IMPORT/EXPORT QUALITY CONTROL COMMITTEE FOR AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES

IT IS notified for general information that the Minister for Agriculture, Livestock Development and Marketing, has appointed an import/export quality control committee for agricultural commodities.

The committee shall consist of the following members—

Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock Development and Marketing—(*Chairman*).

Director of Agriculture.

Director of Veterinary Services.

Director of Livestock Production.

Director of Kenya Agricultural Research Institute.

Director of Medical Services.

Director of Kenya Bureau of Standards.

Secretary, Pest Control Products Board.

Director of Research, Ministry of Research, Technical Training and Technology.

The committee shall ensure—

(a) that the requirements of the Acts specified in the schedule hereto and all subsidiary legislation made thereunder are complied with in respect of export and import of agricultural commodities such as plants, seeds, cereals, livestock and their products and agricultural inputs including fertilizers, agro-chemicals, vaccines, drugs, sera and acaricides;

(b) that the inspectors appointed under those Acts perform their functions in accordance with requirements of those Acts.

The following inspectors or analysts appointed under the Acts specified in the schedule shall perform such functions as are assigned to them under those Acts:

Importers and exporters of agricultural commodities under the Acts specified in the schedule will be required to supply samples before shipment, and on arrival at the point of exit or entry those commodities will be verified by the inspectors before off-loading or loading.

These arrangements are meant to ensure that the country exports high quality produce and at the same time guarantee that products imported into the country are free from pests and diseases and that the foodstuffs are fit for both human and livestock consumption. The above requirements are additional to the statutory requirement of obtaining a clean letter or finding on items of agricultural commodities to be imported.
