4. Each application should be accompanied by a statement indicating:

- (a) The amount of capital it is proposed to spend on the project.
- (b) The amount of actual capital available for development with banker's letter or other evidence of financial status in support.
- (c) The manner in which it is proposed to raise the balance required for development, if any.
- (d) Full details of both residential and/or commercial properties owned by the applicant in township.
- (e) Individual applicants to indicate numbers of their identity cards.
- (f) In case of companies, names of directors to be included.

5. The successful allottee of a plot shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within thirty (30) days of notification that his/her application has been successful, the stand premium and proportion of the annual rent together with conveyancing fees, stamp duty, registration fees, contributions in lieu of rates, roads and drains charges and survey fees. In default of payment within the specified time, the Commissioner of Lands may cancel the allocation and the applicant shall have no claim to the plot.

General Conditions

The grant will be made under the provisions of the Government Lands Act/Trust Land Act, and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap. 281), or the Registered Land Act (Cap. 300), as the case may be.

2. The grant will be issued in the name of the allottee as given in the letters of application and will be subject to special conditions set out below.

3. The term of the grant will be for ninety-nine (99) years from the first day of the month following the issue of the letter of allotment.

Special Conditions

No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the local authority. The Commissioner of Lands shall not give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily.

2. The lessee shall within six (6) calendar months of the actual registration of the lease submit in triplicate to the local authority and the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the buildings and system of drainage for the disposal of sewage, surface and sullage water) drawings, elevations and specifications of the buildings the lessee proposes to erect on the land and shall, within twenty-four (24) months of the actual registration of the lease, complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage

system in conformity with such plans, drawings, elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner of Lands:

Provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in or implied by Government Lands Act (Chapter 280) if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of the President to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term hereby created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the Commissioner in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained.

3. The lessee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land

4. Should the lessee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he is unable to complete the building within the period aforesaid the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the lessee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given—

(a) within twelve (12) months, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the lessee fifty (50) per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land;

(b) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the Commissioner of Lands shall refund the lessee twenty-five (25) per centum of the said stand premium; or

(c) in the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period, no refund shall be made.

5. The land and buildings shall only be used for the purposes shown in the schedule.

6. The buildings shall not cover more than 75 per centum of the land if used for shops and/or offices only on such area of the lands may be laid down by the local authority in its by-laws, and that not more than 50 per centum of the area of the land if used for combined purposes of shops, offices and flats or such lesser area as may be laid down by the local authority in its by-laws.

7. The land shall not be used for the purposes of any trade or business which the Commissioner of Lands considers to be dangerous or offensive.

8. The lessee shall not subdivide the land without the prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands.

9. The lessee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sum as the Commissioner of Lands may estimate to be proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land shall on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportion cost either pay (within seven (7) days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid.

10. The lessee shall, from time-to-time, pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner of Lands may assess.

11. The lessee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge duties or part thereof except with the prior consent in writing of the President. No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until special condition No. 2 has been performed.

12. Should the Commissioner of Lands at any time require the said roads to be constructed to a higher standard, the grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands, on demand, such proportion of the cost of such construction as the Commissioner of Lands may assess.

13. The grantee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever descriptions as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any Government or local authority upon the land or the buildings erected thereon, including any contribution or other sum paid by the President of the Republic of Kenya in lieu thereof.

14. The President of the Republic of Kenya or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground and the grantee shall not erect any buildings in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of mains or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains.

15. The Commissioner of Lands reserves the right to revise the annual ground rent payable hereunder at the expiration of every ten (10) years of the term. Such rental will be at a rate to be determined by the Commissioner of Lands of the unimproved value of the land as at the end of every tenth (10th) year of the term.

CAUSE NO. 16 OF 1993

Issue in dispute:

Recognition Agreement.

AWARD

The Notification of Dispute, Form "A" hereof under section 14 (7) of the Trade Disputes Act, Cap. 234, Laws of Kenya, and dated 27th October, 1992, was received by the court on 3rd March, 1993. It was accompanied by the usual statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner, pursuant to section 14 (9) (e) of the said Act. The matter was listed for mention on 24th March, 1993, when the parties were directed to submit their written statements on or before 2nd and 26th April, 1993, respectively, and the case was fixed for hearing on 21st May, 1993. The claimant belatedly filed their memorandum on 14th April, 1993, to which the respondents submitted their replying statement on 10th May, 1993 and on 21st May, 1993, the matter was postponed to 28th May, 1993, for hearing, and final submissions were made on 3rd June, 1993. The claimants are a lawfully registered trade union, representing employees in the tourist industry i.e. photographic and camping safaris, game drive, etc. The respondents is a limited liability company engaged in tourism business, and the claimants are admittedly the right and appropriate union to represent their employees.

In November, 1990, 10 unionizable employees, or 90 per cent of the respondents' total labour force, joined the claimants' union by signing a check-off to enable the respondents to deduct union dues. The respondents complied with the check-off, vide Annexure "A", of the claimants' submissions but consequently refused to sign the recognition agreement thereof. Under the circumstances, the claimants reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour in accordance with the provisions of the Trade Disputes Act. The minister appointed Miss L. C. Koech of Industrial Area Labour Office to act as an investigator, and on 27th August, 1992, the minister released his report to the parties in which he recommended that the management should accord formal recognition to the union with immediate effect.

The respondents rejected the minister's report on the ground that it was not backed up by sound legal arguments, and the matter is now before the court for determination and adjudication.

In their short submission, the claimants urged the court to impress upon the respondents to respect the I.L.O. Conventions and section 80 of the Kenya Constitution. They submitted that their members in the respondents' concern wished to associate with others as stated hereinabove, and for this reason they will not condone any threats of termination of services against their members. The claimants, therefore, prayed the court to award them recognition.

The respondents resisted the claimants' demand on the ground that the union does not command the membership of a simple majority of their employees; and as such it cannot be considered to possess a representative character. They, however, conceded that in November, 1990, the claimants presented to them a signed check-off list of twelve (12) of their employees who had joined their union, wherein the unionized employees authorized them to deduct union dues from their wages and remit the same to the claimants, Appendix II.

The respondents complied with it vide Annexure "IA" of the claimants' submission. But, after the first deduction was made, eight (8) out of the twelve (12) members protested to the management that they did not want their wages to be deducted. It appeared that they did not understand what they were doing when they signed the check-off list. They, therefore, told the management to stop deducting the union dues and resigned from the claimants' union, Appendix 2. As a result, the union membership dropped to less than 51 per cent; and, in the circumstances, the respondents declined to accord recognition to the claimants.

The respondents submitted that they appreciate the employees' constitutional right to join a trade union and associate with other employees in the promotion of their interests, but

denied that the employees were stopped, hindered or threatened from joining the claimants' union. They stated that it was not possible for them to recognize the claimants because the latter had failed to recruit a simple majority of the employees into their union membership as most of them had resigned therefrom. The respondents denied the claimants' allegation that the employees were forced to resign from their union; and averred that if that was the case the claimants would have protested that the management was violating the employees' rights to associate by harassing them for joining the union.

The respondents argued that currently there are eight (8) unionizable employees in their establishment. They said that out of twelve (12) employees who were initially in the check-off list, six (6) are out of employment; and there are only two (2) genuine union members in their concern. These two (2) are not enough for the court to order recognition, and the only alternative open to the claimants is to recruit a fresh simple majority of the employees before seeking for recognition. Otherwise any order for recognition made by the court will not serve any purpose as the claimants do not command the required simple majority of their employees.

The respondents, therefore, prayed the court to reject the claimants' demand.

Admittedly, the claimants are the right union to represent the employees in the respondents' undertaking, and the only question for determination is whether the claimants had recruited a simple majority of the respondents' employees to entitle them to recognition. As at 7th November, 1990, the claimants' membership was more than simple majority, and Appendix I of the respondents' submission shows this position. The check-off was complied with by the respondents accordingly, Annexure "A" of the claimants' submission.

But the respondents averred that most of their employees who had joined the claimants' union have since resigned and left, and the current membership stands at two (2) out of eight (8) unionizable employees, which is far below the required simple majority rule of 51 per cent. The claimants have, however, produced to the court copies of the letters dated 13th February and 27th May, 1991, addressed to Mr. M. L. Boley in which they lodged a complaint against interference leading to mass resignations of their members in the respondents' concern. The respondents did not deny the accusations. That being the case, the respondents cannot, therefore, turn round and say that the claimants should have "raised an alarm that the employer is violating the employees' rights to associate by harassing them for joining the union and that they should recruit a fresh simple majority of the employees before they are accorded recognition".

Section 5 (2) of the Trade Disputes Act (Cap. 234), lays down that an employer shall recognize a trade union if it fulfils the following conditions, namely—

- (a) that the trade union has in its membership a simple majority of employees eligible by virtue of the union's constitution to join that particular union in a particular undertaking or a group of undertakings; and
- (b) that there is no rival trade union claiming to represent such employees.

In consideration of this dispute as a whole, including the investigator's report and the check-off list, the court has no hesitation in finding that this is a case of unfair labour practice by the respondents. In November, 1990, the claimants had recruited a simple majority of the unionizable employees into their union whose check-off was complied with by the respondents, and there is no rival union claiming representation. It is, therefore, futile for the respondents to contend that the claimants should obtain a fresh simple majority of the employees before they are accorded recognition. The alleged subsequent mass resignations of the employees is of no consequence to the legitimacy of the claimants to represent the employees of the respondents' undertaking or concern as the respondents were guilty of unfair labour practice.

In view of the foregoing discussion, we award the demand for recognition and direct that the parties must sign a recognition agreement between them within two months from the date of this award. We order accordingly.
