The Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Cadbury Kenya Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

The parties were heard in Nairobi on 25th May, 7th and 12th July, 1993, respectively. The parties relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

The Notification of Dispute, Form "A" dated 10th September, 1992 duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 25th February, 1993 together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents engage in the manufacture of cocoa and sugar based food products. They employ a total labour force of 204 permanent employees. In addition they engage an average of 30 casuals daily. However, this dispute affects 153 unionisable employees.

The dispute arose as a result of the parties' attempt to renew their latest collective agreement. The agreement that is being revised was effective from 1st October, 1989 for a duration of two years expiring on 30th October, 1991.

After a series of preliminary joint negotiating meetings at their own level which ended in disagreement, the claimants reported a trade dispute over eleven issues now before the court.

The court received this dispute on 25th February, 1993 and the issues are to form part of the collective agreement between the parties which is to be effective from 1st November, 1991 and is to run for two years from that date. It is due to expire on 30th October, 1993 when the claimants will have another opportunity to seek its revision.

In this dispute, the relevant period to establish the movement in the cost of living indices is from November, 1989 to October, 1991.

After careful consideration of all the submissions and taking into account the report prepared by the planning and research division and the wages guidelines the court makes the following award on each item.

Termination of employment:

The claimants demand on this item is rejected.

Termination of service by death:

The court awards that the respondents should pay a sum of KSh. 5,000 towards the funeral expenses of an employee who dies while in employment.

The other provisions on this item remain as before.

Annual leave:

The claimants demand for an enhanced annual leave is rejected.

Leave travelling allowance:

This allowance is increased to KSh.800 per employee per year.

Meal allowance:

This allowance is increased to KSh.25 per day.

Night shift allowance:

The court awards a night shift allowance of KSh.2.30 per hour.

Standby and disturbance allowance:

These allowances are increased to KSh.14 per hour.

Medical reimbursement scheme:

The court finds that the present clause in the parties collective agreement is of no use to the unionisable employees. The court fails to understand why

the parties had negotiated a medical clause that finally ended up benefiting management staff only.

The court awards that an employee and his wife and four children of under 18 years registered with the respondents should be entitled to KSh. 4,000 reimbursement per year on production of receipts from any of the approved hospitals.

Once the respondents clinic is fully operational this clause will be open to revision. This part of the award will be effective from 1st August, 1993.

Basic minimum wages

This item is adequetely taken care of by the latest statutory minimums established under the general wages order.

General wage increase:

The court awards a general wage increase of 18 per cent for the first year and another 18 per cent for the second year—the second increase is to be worked out after the first year's 18 per cent increase has been added on to the workers wages.

House allowance:

This allowance is increased to KSh. 700 for the first year and to KSh. 800 for the second year.

Casuals:

The court directs the parties to apply their minds seriously to this question during the next round of negotiations as the court feels that they have not thoroughly discussed this matter.

For the time being the court makes no award on this item.

Award

The first issue in this dipute stems from the parties' collective agreement for the period 1990/91 which was duly registered by this court on 27th March, 1991 as R.C.A. No. 66 of 1991. The claimants complained that the respondents wrongfully and incorrectly implemented the clauses on basic minimum wages and general wage increase arising from the court award and the interpretation thereon in cause No. 55 of 1989 which were announced on 15th January, 1990 and 13th October, 1992, respectively. They contended that where an employee's basic pay is below the basic minimum it should first be raised to the new basic minimum, after which the employee should be given the general wage increase.

In rejecting the demand, the respondents argued that in the parties' past collective agreements an employee has always been given a general wage increase on the basic pay earned last by him/her before the increase was due to him/her, and if the resultant figure fell below the new basic pay, then he/she would be elevated to the basic minimum.

The second issue arose when the claimants demanded that the two employees (hereinafter called "the grievants") who, at their own initiative, sat the Government Trade Test and qualified should have been automatically up-graded and be paid wages commensurate to their respective new grades as stipulated in various legal notices issued by the Government from time to time. The respondents rejected the demand on the ground that the acquisition of a higher grade did not entitle one to an automatic promotion, but the grievants were informed that they would be considered first if vacancies arose in the higher grades.

The parties met at their own level with a view to resolving the matter, but no compromise was reached. Consequently, the claimants reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour under section 4 of the Trade Disputes Act, Cap.234, Laws of Kenya (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"). The Minister took cognizance of the dispute and appointed Mr. G. M. Muema of Mombasa Labour Office to act as the conciliator, but the conciliation proceedings which were held on 26th June, 1991 and 24th June and 15th July, 1992 failed. On 6th April, 1993, the parties raised and signed a Notification of Dispute, Form "A" under section 14 (7) of the Act, referring the matter to this court for adjudication and determination. The notification of dispute, accompanied by the statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner under section 14 (9) (e) of the Act, were received by the court on 28th July, 1993. The claimants submitted their memorandum on 30th August, 1993, to which the respondents filed their reply statement on 27th September, 1993. When the dispute came up for hearing on 26th October, 1993, the representative for the claimants applied for adjournment because issue No.2 had been omitted in the notification of dispute. There being no objection by Mr. Kosgei, the learned counsel for the respondents, the application was granted for the parties to file an amended notification of dispute. The amended notification of dispute, dated 26th October, 1993, was received by the court on 10th February, 1994, under cover of a letter dated 7th instant from the Labour Commissioner. The case was then fixed for hearing on 20th April, 1994.

I now proceed to consider the rival contentions raised by the parties in support of their respective positions on the two issues seriatim and award accordingly.

1. Wrongful implementation of the collective agreement basic minimum and general wage increase clause for 1990/91 collective agreement

In support of their demand on this issue, the claimants based their claim on the 12 per cent wage increase on the two grades, "A" and "B", which was awarded to the employees by this court in cause No. 55 of 1989, as shown by their formula which is reproduced below:

"Grade "A" 12 per cent of KSh.739.20 for the first year should have made him earn KSh. 88.70 + 739.20 = 827.90. Then the following year this employee should have received a further 12 per cent of his salary of KSh.827.90 which should have brought him KSh.99.45 + 827.90 = a second year new salary or minimum of KSh.927.35 per month.

Grade "B" 12 per cent of the minimum of KSh. 958.50 first year could earn him KSh. 115 + 958.50 = KSh. 1073.50. Then the following year this employee should have received a further 12 per cent calculated at the new salary of the above KSh. 1073.50 which comes out to be KSh. 128.80 + KSh. 1073.50 = 1102.30."

They submitted in the alternative that if any Government legal notices have since been issued showing higher rates of pay than those provided hereinabove, then the same should be adopted in the circumstances.

The claimants, therefore, prayed the court to uphold the above formula for the parties' 1990/91 and 1992/93 collective agreements.

The position of the respondents is that the case at hand has no connection whatsoever with cause No. 55 of 1989, and the claimants' attempt to link the two cases is unfortunate and misleading.

They gave a brief resume of the issue under consideration in cause No. 55 of 1989, and averred that the principle involved in that particular case is not universal on the interpretation of collective agreements. In any case, they proceeded to implement the award in respect of the parties' collective agreement for the period 1987/88 as directed by the court and the affected employees in grades "A" and "B" were paid their accrued arrears.

The respondents submitted that their interpretation is in conformity with the conventional and universally accepted mode of implementation of collective agreements, whereas the claimants' interpretation is peculiar and would lead to percentage increments far beyond the percentages agreed upon by the parties, they cited and relied on the following decision in cause No. 75 of 1992:

Kenya Engineering Workers' Union versus Friendship Containers:

that the first year wage increase should be added on the workers' wages as at 31st July, 1990 provided that no employee should get a wage less than the agreed basic minimum monthly wage for his grade.

The respondents therefore, urged that the best evidence of what the parties agreed upon is the collective agreement itself and not extraneous matters, and prayed the court to reject the demand.

On careful reading of the claimants' submission on this issue, I am of the opinion that their demand amounts to a review of the award in cause No. 55 of 1989. That award and interpretation arising therefrom are clear and unambiguous, and I see no reason for reviewing the matter. Furthermore, the parties' collective agreements for the period 1990/91 and 1992/93, which are affected by this demand, have since been concluded and duly registered by this court as R.C.A. Nos. 66 of 1991 and 233 of 1993, respectively. These collective agreements stood and bound the parties, and accordingly

this demand is not competent. However, for the guidance of the parties in future, I agree with the interpretation of the claimants that the proper way to implement a collective agreement is to bring up those employees whose wages are below the basic minimum to the new basic minimum, after which they should be given the general wage increase. I order accordingly.

2. Underpayment of wages for Trade Test Certificate grades II and III for Mr. L. Chondo and Mr. G. Odhiambo

The claimants' submission on this issue is as stated at the outset of this award and have prayed the court to retrospectively up-grade the grievants and be paid accrued wages commensurate to their respective higher grades. In a nutshell, the respondents submitted that the grievants were employed on 1st January, 1987, and 1st January, 1989, as a helper in the electrical section and a fitter trade test grade III, respectively. Consequently, the grievants attempted at their own initiative and qualified in Government Trade Test, grades III and II, respectively, after which they approached the respondents for automatic promotion to higher grades, but their request was turned down on the ground that the acquisition of a higher grade did not entitle them to automatic promotions.

The respondents averred that they have all along complied with the legal requirements regarding the grievants' salaries and other legitimate entitlements in accordance with their qualifications on record, and have, in the circumstances, prayed the court to reject the demand as untenable.

I do not think that it will be wise to require an employer to up-grade or promote employees simply on the ground of only qualifications. Up-grading has to be deserved by an employee by his/her application to duty, good conduct, aptitude and qualification for discharging the duties of the higher post. It also depends upon the availability of a vacancy in that higher grade and the discretion of the management, in the absence of any evidence of victimization and unfair labour practice. Merely because the grievants passed the Government trade test did not, therefore, entitle them to the higher grades prayed for.

Accordingly, I reject the demand as unmaintainable.

- (3) Bill Supplement contains Bills which are for introduction in the National Assembly.
- (4) Act Supplement contains Acts passed by the National Assembly.

All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of an A4 sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible and contain minimum alterations.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signature must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signatory in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

Extract from the Code of Regulations, Section D-Kenya Gazette

- "D 41. (1) Communications for the Kenya Gazette should reach the Government Printer not later than 9 a.m., on Priday of the week before publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the Gazette.
- (2) Ministries will be required to pay for the Kenya Gazette and to meet the cost of advertising in it.
- (3) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward Gazette notices to the Government Printer in time."

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect.
