Appointment of a Chairman of the Public Service Commission of Kenya

THE TRADE DISPUTES ACT

(Cap. 234)

COLLECTION OF UNION DUES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Trade Disputes Act, the Minister for Labour and Manpower Development—

- (a) revokes the order published under Gazette Notice No. 1088 of 1991; and
- (b) orders every employer who employs not less than five (5) employees of the Kenya Game, Hunting and Safaris Workers' Union-
 - (i) to deduct every month the sums specified in the schedule in respect of trade union dues from wages of his employees who are members of that trade union:
 - (ii) to pay, within ten (10) days of that date of deduction the total sums under items 1, 2 and 3 of the schedule by crossed cheque made payable to the Kenya Game, Hunting and Safaris Workers' Union into that union's account No. 40088 at the Bank of India, Kenyatta Avenue, Nairobi;

- (iii) to pay, within ten (10) days of the date of deduction the total sums deducted under item 4 of the schedule, by crossed cheque made payable to the Central Organization of Trade Unions (Kenya) into that organization's account No. 229-741-204 at the Kenya Commercial Bank Limited, Moi Avenue Branch. P.O. Box 48400, Nairobi;
- (iv) to notify that trade union and the organization in writing and within one (1) month of payment;
- (v) to make written returns to the registration Trade Unions and to the organization.

SCHEDULE

1. The sum of twenty (20) shillings as entrance fee upon admission into membership.

2. Monthly subscription of 2 per cent of every employee's basic salary subject to a minimum of thirty five (35) shillings per month and a maximum of fifty (50) shillings per month.

3. The sum of fifty (50) shillings from wages of every employee both seasonal and monthly employees per month.
