ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

2. The occupational test will be open to civil servants only who must be Kenya citizens and in case of:
 - (i) *Occupational Test No. I*
Should be serving Telephone Operators Grade I (job group "F"), with at least two (2) years' service in the grade.

(ii) *Occupational Test No. II*

Should be serving Telephone Operators Grade II (job group "E"), who have been confirmed in their appointment and admitted to the permanent and pensionable establishment and with at least three (3) years' service in that grade.

(iii) Candidates who attempt and fail occupational tests Nos. I and II will not be allowed to take them until after a period of two (2) years from the date they first attempted the tests.

3. In order to pass any of the occupational tests, a candidate is required to pass both the written English (or oral English tests in the case of blind telephone operators) and the practical test at one and the same sitting. No partial passes are allowed.

Incremental credits will be granted to successful candidates who are not civil servants for approved previous experience provided the maximum salary is not exceeded. They will also be eligible for the benefits and privileges enjoyed by civil servants in accordance with existing Government regulations.

Vacancies in the Office of the President:

Principal Human Resource Development Officer (Twenty-seven Posts) (D.P.M.) (Various Ministries/Departments) (No. 4/97)

Requirements for appointment:

Applicants must—

Duties and responsibilities:

Successful candidates will be deployed as provincial sports officer. Duties involve developing sports resources, establishing and maintaining continuous programmes of sports and sporting activities, supervising and co-ordinating activities of other staff, preparing budgets and annual report, training and development of personnel working under him and implementing departmental policies.

Senior Sports Officer (Twenty-nine Posts) (No. 15/97)

Duties and responsibilities:

Duties and responsibilities at this level will involve planning and implementation of cultural projects covering performing and visual arts, Kenyan languages and traditions, cultural education and information; development and maintenance of cultural facilities like cultural centres and art galleries, and preparation of monthly and annual reports. In the district they will be responsible for identification and training of cultural dance troupes and choirs for festival and state functions, administration and accounting of all voted funds or district cultural programmes, proper use and custody of equipment and vehicles assigned to the office and preparation of budget proposals.

*Vacancies in the Ministry of Health:**Senior Enrolled Nurse (Thirty-two Posts) (No. 18/97)*

Requirements for appointment:

Applicants must—

- (a) have served in the grade of information officer III (job group "H" for at least three (3) years; and
- (b) have been confirmed in appointment.

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Duties and responsibilities:

The successful candidates will be based at the district information office, the rural press office or at the department headquarters. Duties include gathering, receiving, verifying, translating and editing news and features from various sources; determining the quality of the news bulletins in relation to original stories fields or received from news agencies and relating its quality to Government policy; and monitoring other radio stations for stories that have not been made available by news agencies. At the district level, they will assist in the co-ordination of inter-departmental publicity campaigns and also in training and supervision of staff. In addition, the officers will represent the ministry in the divisional development committees.

Technical Instructor I (One Post) (Information and Broadcasting) (No. 22/97)

Salary scale.—K£4,092 to 6,066 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Requirements for appointment:

Applicants must have served in the grade of instructor II for a minimum period of three (3) years and demonstrated merit and the required ability to guide and supervise trainee on practical exercises.

Duties and responsibilities:

The technical instructor I will be responsible for carrying out a wide range of technical operation and instructional duties in various areas in both radio/television studios and on location independently. The areas include production studio, transmission desk, ENG sound/video, editing/recording, vision mixing and character generation. In addition, work at this level will include teaching and conducting practical exercises for trainees.

*Vacancies in the Ministry of Home Affairs and National Heritage:**(Chief Probation Officer) (Two Posts) (No. 23/97)*

*Requirements for appointment:**Applicants must—*

- have served satisfactorily in the grade of senior information officer for at least three (3) years;
- have a degree in mass communication or in the social sciences plus a recognized diploma in journalism; and
- have demonstrated both professional and administrative competence.

Duties and responsibilities:

An officer at this level will head a provincial information office or a functional desk at the headquarters, e.g. K.N.A. international desk, K.N.A. local desk, PANA desk, etc. Duties will include handling and management of news; controlling and co-ordinating information services to ensure that Government policy is adhered to; co-ordinating and screening film shows by the Mobile Cinema Unit and identifying training needs of staff. Senior Photogrammetric Assistant (Two Posts) (No. 27/97)

Manpower Development Officer I (Eight Posts) (No. 32/97)
