ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

The requirements for clerical officers (civil servants only) to qualify for sitting the Proficiency Examination are as follows:

- (i) Entry to examination will be restricted to clerical officers immediately on joining the service or thereafter. However, holders of Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education or its equivalent will also be eligible to enroll for the examination.

CONDITIONS FOR OBTAINING A PASS

A candidate will be awarded a full pass when he or she passes all the three papers of the examination without any restrictions on the number of attempts they should make before clearing any of the failed papers to get the full pass.

A partial pass will be awarded to a candidate whenever he/she passes any of the papers of the proficiency examination, instead of being required to pass at least two (2) papers at one sitting to be allowed a referral.

EXAMINATION REGISTRATION FEES

Every candidate entering this examination will be required to pay a registration fee of KSh. 600 only, for the whole examination. The registration fee which is *non-refundable* will be payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, P.O. Box 30095, Nairobi, in banker's cheques only. Note that Government cheques, personal cheques, money/postal order or cash will not be accepted.

ENTRY FORMS

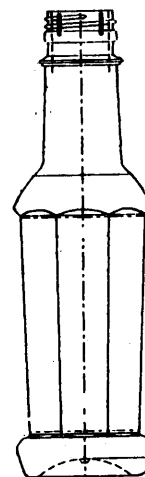

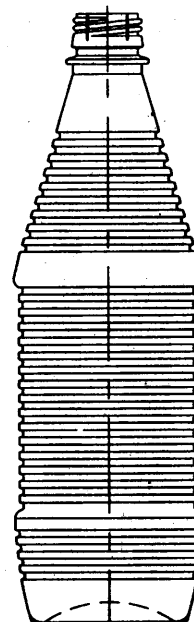

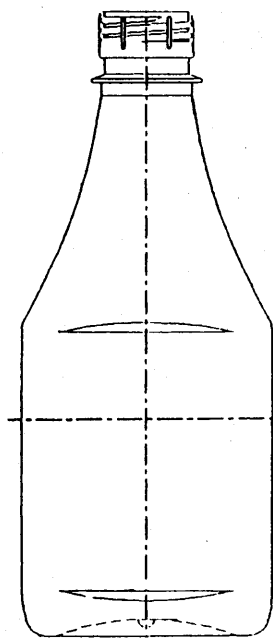
