LOCAL AUTHORITIES TRANSFER FUND ACT, 1998

(No. 8 of 1998)

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES TRANSFER FUND REGULATIONS

(L.N. No. 142 of 1999)

CRITERIA FOR DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS

PURSUANT to regulation 15 of the Local Authorities Transfer Fund Regulations, 1999, the Minister for Finance notifies that for the financial year ending on the 30th June, 2003, funds from the Local Authorities Transfer Fund have been allocated to the Local Authorities in the amounts respectively specified in the First Schedule, on the basis of the criteria set out in the Second Schedule, subject to the following conditions:

1. The amounts allocated to each Local Authority from the service delivery and transitional accounts shall be disbursed as follows:

(a) The first forty-five per cent on the 30th September, 2002:

(b) The next thirty-five per cent on the 30th January, 2003, and

(c) The next twenty per cent, on the 30th April, 2003

on the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) Each local authority shall before 16th June, 2002, submit to the Ministry of Local Government—
 - (aa) annual budget estimates for the 2002/2003 financial year, including estimates for the expenditure of Fund allocations, in accordance with section 212 of the Local Government Act, approved by the Council of the Local Authority: and
 - (bb) information sheets for all capital expenditure projects as specified in Forms IA and IB.

- (ii) Each Local Authority shall in its submission under (I) above demonstrate that—
 - (*aa*) at least fifty per cent of the funds disbursed thereunder shall be spent on capital projects (including maintenance of capital);
 - (bb) not more than sixty per cent of the total budget of the Local Authority shall be spent on personnel; and
 - (cc) all statutory charges due and payable by the Local Authority in the 2002/2003 financial year shall be paid within the year.

2. The amount allocated to each local authority out of the performance account shall be disbursed where the Local Authority complies with condition 1 (i) above and submits to the Ministry of . Local Government—

- (a) the documents specified in subparagraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph 3 by the 30th September, 2002;
- (b) the documents specified in subparagraph (c) of that paragraph by the 31st December, 2002; and
- (c) the documents specified in subparagraphs (d) and (e) of the same paragraph by the 28th February, 2003.
- 3. The documents referred to in paragraph 2 are-
- (a) a statement of revenues, expenditure, cash and bank balances for the 2001/2002 financial year in Form 3 of the Schedule, ready to be duly certified as a true record by an auditor appointed under regulation 25, the submission of which shall entitle the local authority to receive 30% of the performance amount;
- (b) a statement of debtors and creditors and a debt reduction plan as at 30th September, 2002, in Form 4 of the Schedule, together with a brief statement showing—
- (i) the local authority's progress in implementing the previous vear's plans for debt repayment;

- (ii) a certification of actual debt repayments made in the 2002/2003 financial year;
- (iii) an updating of that plan for the following two financial years; and
- (iv) signed agreements between the local authority and the creditors accepting the repayment plan,
- the submission of which shall entitle the local authority to receive 20% of the performance amount.
- (c) an abstract of the accounts of the local authority for the 2000/2001 financial year, the submission of which shall

enticle the local authority to receive 10% of the performance amount.

- (d) a revenue enhancement plan for the 2003/2004 financial year, in Form 5 of the Schedule, showing the means by which the authority intends to enhance its policies and administration of revenues, the submission of which shall entitle the local authority to receive 20% of the performance amount.
- (e) annual service delivery plans for the 2003/2004 financial year and the two subsequent financial years, the submission of which shall entitle the local authority to receive 20% of the performance amount.

SECOND SCHEDULE

CRITERIA FOR ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

1. Allocation of the funds to the Local Authorities was done in the following manner-

(a) a basic minimum lump-sum of shillings one million five hundred thousand;

(b) sixty per cent of the total amount reflected in the First Schedule on the basis of the population of the local authority; and

(c) the remaining share (30.73 per cent) on the basis of the urban population where the Local Authority has a city, municipality or town council.

2. The size of the population considered for purposes of the allocation under 1 (b) above shall be that reflected in the provisional results of the 1999 census.

3. The size of the urban population considered for purposes of the allocation under 1 (c) above shall be that reflected in the results of the 1989 census.
