CORRIGENDUM

It should be noted that two of the polling stations, as published in the *Daily Nation* and the *Standard* of 8th June, 2005 for the elections for the Coffee Research Foundation Co-operative sector zones 1 and 2, have been corrected as follows:

Zone 1 Kiamu Town—St. Peter and Paul Catholic Church Hall and not St James A.C.K. Cathedral Hall.

Zone 2 Chuka Town—Chuka play ground (next to the D.C.'s Office) and not the Electoral Commission Hall.
