PURSUANT to regulation 21 of the Environmental (Impact Assessment and Audit) Regulations, the National Environment Management Authority (NEMA) has received an environmental impact assessment study report for the proposed development of Oltome Mara Camp at Koyaki Ranch.

The proposed project will be located in the Koyaki Group Ranches on Plot L.R. No.Cismara/Koyaki/Dagururueti/2495, Lemek Sub-location, Talek Location in Mara Division of Narok District. The camp will be situated along River Telek at approximately two (2) kilometers from Lemek trading centre and one point five (1.5) kilometers before the Fig Tree Camp. The area to be used for the camp site measures about 5 acres.

The objective of the project is to develop and operate a semi-permanent tented camp to host Christian tourists visiting Kenya for religious missions. The project anticipates the following impacts and mitigation measures:

*Possible Impacts**Mitigation measures*

1. Health, occupational safety and fire hazards
- (a) Use of appropriate construction equipment and garments.
- (b) Professional ethics of the contractors and training of casual workers.
- (c) Training on safety measures.
- (d) Provide fire fighting equipment and first aid kits.
- (e) Fence off the construction site and gate-keeping to control visitors.
- (f) Place notices on the road side about on-going construction.

*Possible Impacts**Mitigation measures*

- (g) Practice noise and dust reduction measures.
- (h) Abide by construction and building laws, regulations and professional ethics.
- (i) Health and safety measures especially for food and beverage management.
2. Destruction of the physical environment: Soil erosion and loss of biodiversity
- (a) No cutting of trees and shrubs will occur.
- (b) Create paths within the camp site and along nature walk paths to avoid trampling of grass.
- (c) No introduction of new vegetation species in the camp area.
3. Pollution of River Telek
- (a) Ensure deposit of waste water into river does not take place.
- (b) Use of septic tanks, soap pits to handle all waste water from the camp.
4. Oil spillage, gas leakages and power generator maintenance
- (a) Avoid spillage of petroleum products during delivery and dispensing by use of hand-pump and funnel.
- (b) Maintenance of all oil installations.
- (c) Leaking pipes and drums should be replaced.
- (d) Bunding of storage area so as to contain any oil spillage.
- (e) Empty tanks and old pumps must be disposed appropriately preferably by dealers.
- (f) Inspect gas cylinders and ensure no leakages occur.
5. Increase in solid and liquid waste
- (a) Minimize generation of solid waste.
- (b) Collection and sorting of solid waste for recycle.
- (c) Construct appropriate solid waste management structure including solid waste separation and waste store, dumping pit.
- (d) Incinerate.
- (e) Conduct regular inspection to identify any inappropriate practices or lacking facilities.
- (f) Construct septic tanks and soak pits.
- (g) Regular inspections for drains, pipes and manhole to avoid blockage and leakages.
- (h) Installation of a grease trap especially for kitchen waste.
6. Wild animals
- (a) Fencing the plot.
- (b) Limit new developments in the area.

Issue in Dispute:

"Redundancy payments and service benefits/gratuity payments".

AWARD

On 15th January, 2003 the Minister for Labour referred this dispute to the court for consideration and determination pursuant to the powers vested in him by section 14(a)(f) of the Trade Disputes Act Cap. 234 Laws of Kenya. The reference together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister and the Labour Commissioner were received by the court on 4th February, 2003.

The dispute was heard on 28th June, 2004, 24th September, 2004, 4th April, 2005 and 16th May, 2005.

The union in its written submission traces the genesis of this dispute to September-December, 2001 when the Respondent sent its employees on leave in turns due to its plans to relocate its factory. The employees were instructed to report back on 7th January, 2002 which reporting date was rescheduled to 15th January, 2002 and again to 20th January, 2002. The Respondent claimed that it was unable to maintain the supply of electricity to the factory due to lack of support from its bankers.

During this time the Respondent delayed paying the employees' salaries for December, 2001 and January 2002 and the union lodged a complaint at the Nairobi Provincial Labour office. The discussion between the union and the Respondent resulted in a memorandum of understanding dated 6th February, 2002 between the parties which is reproduced below:

"MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT SIGNED BETWEEN THE
UNION AND THE MANAGEMENT ON THE WORKERS
GRIEVANCES"

In a meeting held in the P.L.O.'s office today the 6/2/2002, the above parties have agreed as follows:

1. The management undertakes to inform the worker on the company's position and the fate of the workers on 23/2/2002.

2. The workers will continue being in the payroll of the employer.

In the memorandum the Respondent affirmed that the employees would continue to be in the payroll until 28th February, 2002 when their fate would be known.

On 18th February, 2002 the Respondent declared 148 employees redundant which act prompted the union to report a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour.

In the circumstances the Respondent urged the court to dismiss the union's claim and award the grievant only the admitted sum of KSh. 272,875.

We have fully considered the parties written and oral submissions presented to the court.

It is not in dispute that the Respondent declared all its employees redundant in February 2002. Our duty herein is to determine the following:

- (a) if in effecting the redundancy the Respondent complied with the law and the parties Collective Bargaining Agreement on redundancy.
- (b) if the grievants are entitled to be paid retirement benefits in addition to the redundancy benefits.

Any employer is entitled to invoke the redundancy law and procedures in response to adverse economic conditions. An employer may invoke them to:

- (i) reduce operational costs through staff rationalization
- (ii) to wind up or close down a business that has ceased to be economically viable.

Redundancy is governed by section 16A of the Employment Act Cap. 226 Laws of Kenya which stipulates as follows:

"(1) A contract of service shall not be terminated on account of redundancy unless the following conditions have been complied with—

- (a) the union of which the employee is a member and the Labour Officer in charge of the area where the employee is employed shall be notified of the reasons for, and the extent of, the intended redundancy;
- (b) the employer shall have due regard to seniority in time and to the skill, ability and reliability of each employer of the particular class of employees affected by the redundancy;
- (c) no employee shall be placed at a disadvantage for being or not being a member of the trade union;
- (d) any leave due to any employee who is declared redundant shall be paid off in cash;
- (e) an employee declared redundant shall be entitled to one month's notice or one month's wages in lieu of notice;

An employee declared redundant shall be entitled to severance pay at the rate of not less than 15 days for each completed year of service as severance pay."

The clause expressly states that entitlement shall include cases of termination of an employee by the company. In this case the employees' services were terminated exclusively by the company on grounds of redundancy, therefore the terminations herein meet one of the tests set out for entitlement to service benefits/gratuity payments. In the circumstances we rule that the grievants are entitled to be paid service benefits/gratuity payments in addition to the redundancy

payments. We take judicial notice that in cases of redundancy touching on firms who have registered retirement benefits schemes administered by independent managers under the Retirement Benefits Authority (RBA) rules; the employees receive both the redundancy dues and the retirement dues under the retirement schemes. Redundancy dues are essentially compensation for loss of employment whereas retirement dues are funds set aside by the company and the employees (where scheme is contributory) to cater for the employees' needs upon retirement.

In view of the foregoing discussions we Award and Order that the grievant be paid the following dues:

- (a) KSh. 272,895 being the balance of redundancy dues admitted by the Respondent;
- (b) KSh. 940,553 shortfall arising from the faulty calculation formula adopted by the Respondent;
- (c) KSh. 11,080,794 being the grievants service benefits/gratuity payments;
- (d) Two months salary to each employee being compensation for unlawful loss of employment.

The said amounts be paid within 30 days from the date of this award. We are aware that it will be an uphill task for the grievants and the union to enforce this award in view of the fact that the Respondent is no longer in operation as a business entity. Such an eventuality would indeed be tragic. This uncertain and unsatisfactory state of affairs certainly suggests that there is a lacuna in the law governing gratuity entitlement for employees. Gratuity schemes are generally voluntary arrangements between employers and trade unions who have inbuilt the same in the Collective Bargaining Agreements. Their success are dependant on the goodwill of the employers and their healthy financial positions. A healthy enterprise will discharge its gratuity obligations to its employees whenever they arise. But an ailing business is unable to discharge the same obligations.

This sad state of affairs calls for legislation to compel those enterprises that have gratuity schemes to formally develop and register retirement benefits schemes or join existing schemes under the Retirement Benefit Authority rules. This will enable the employers to set aside gratuity entitlements for employees on monthly basis which entitlements will be invested in interest earning accounts. The funds will be beyond the reach of the employers once remitted to the retirement funds managers and the entitlements will be protected even if the employer's business collapses. This is a challenge the authorities charged with the task of legislation should address without delay.
