THE PYRETHRUM (ELECTIONS) RULES, 2003

NOMINATED CANDIDATES FOR ELECTIONS

1. Elections will be held on Tuesday, 20th June, 2006 beginning 8.00 a.m. and close at 5.00 p.m., or immediately thereafter, in the following zones
 - i. Zone 4—Central Rift.
 - ii. Zone 7—Nyanza/Rift valley.
2. Elections will not be held in Zones 1, 2, 3, and 5 and 6 because only one candidate was duly nominated each of those zones in accordance with Rule 12 (3) of the Pyrethrum (Elections) Rules 2003.
3. (a) The licensed growers/registered growers who have delivered dry flowers to the Board for the last three years in the respective Electoral Areas or Zones will be eligible to vote at the polling station and production of original growers identification card and national ID cards.
 (b) The growers are reminded to collect grower's identification cards at the P.B.K. field offices in their respective Electoral Zones.
4. In addition to the polling stations advertised in the *Daily Nation* and *Standard* newspapers of Tuesday, 23rd May, 2006, the following polling stations have been added:
 - (a) Under Zone 4
 - i. Talai Centre
 - (b) Under Zone 7
 - i. Nyancheiki F. C. S
 - ii. Kiamokama F.C.S.
 - iii. Maji Mazuri F. C. S
5. Candidates are requested to appoint not more than two (2) agents per polling station and provide their names and identity card numbers to the respective Presiding Officers in writing before commencement of polling on Tuesday, 20th June, 2006.
