Mandate of the Interim Co-ordinating Secretariat:

The Interim Co-ordinating Secretariat is to—

- (a) Co-ordinate the implementation of the recommendations of the Task Force on the Conservation of the Mau Forest Complex;
- (b) Develop the framework for long-term measures to restore and sustainably manage the Mau Forest Complex and other water towers; and
- (c) Report on progress made to the Prime Minister on a regular basis.

Powers of the Interim Co-ordinating Secretariat:

1. The Interim Co-ordinating Secretariat may establish committees to address technical and other specific issues. The Interim Co-ordinating Secretariat will prepare the Terms of Reference of its committees; and
2. The Interim Co-ordinating Secretariat may invite experts on a needs basis.
