NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 39 (1) of the Constitution of Kenya Review Act and Regulation 9 (2) of the Constitution of Kenya Review (Referendum) Regulations, 2010, the Interim Independent Electoral Commission notifies the public as follows:

That a referendum will be held on the proposed new Constitution of Kenya on the 4th of August, 2010 from 7.00am to 5.00 p.m.

Any person or group of persons wishing to campaign during the referendum period must form a referendum committee and register with the Interim Independent Electoral Commission before the 25th of June, 2010.

The referendum campaign period within which any person or referendum committee supporting or opposing the referendum question may carry out campaigns to support or oppose the referendum question shall be between 13th July, 2010 and 2nd August, 2010 and not earlier.

All campaigns in support of or against the referendum shall cease twenty-four hours before 7.00 a.m. of the polling day.

Every referendum committee participating in the referendum shall subscribe to and abide by the Electoral Code of Conduct as provided for under section 34A of the National Assembly and Presidential Elections Act as set out in the fourth schedule thereto and the Constitution of Kenya Review (Referendum) Regulations, 2010.

It should be noted that the Proposed New Constitution was published on 6th May, 2010.
