DEDUCTION OF AGENCY FEES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 49 (1) of the Labour Relations Act (No. 14 of 2007), the Minister for Labour makes the following Order:

- (a) All employers who are members of the Kenya Association of Building and Civil Engineering Contractors Group (KABCBC) herein referred to as the "association" to deduct from the wages of each of their individual employee who is not a member of the Kenya Building, Construction, Timber, Furniture and Allied Industries Employees Union herein referred to as the "union" but is sovered by the Collective Bargaining Agreement (RCA No. 214 of 2009) signed between the union and the association a sum equal to two and a half per cent (21/2%) from each employees monthly gross pay (i.e. basic salary plus house allowance).
- (b) Deductions to commence within thirty (30) days of receiving the Order.
- (c) To remit within ten (10) days the sums deducted under item (a) above by crossed cheque made payable to the union, into the union's account No. 1107222516 at Kenya Commercial Bank, Moi Avenue Branch, Nairobi.

Dated the 25th January 2011

- to deduct every month the sum of specified in the schedule in respect of trade union dues from the wages of his/her employees who are members of that trade union;
- (ii) to pay within ten (10) days of the deduction, the total sums deducted under item 1 of the schedule by crossed cheque made payable to Union of National Research and Allied Institutes of Kenya (UNRISK) into that union's account No. 234-793-836 at the Kenya Commercial Bank, Moi Avenue Branch, P.O. Box 30081, Nairobi;
- (iii) to pay within ten (10) days of the date of deduction, the total sums deducted under item 2 of the schedule, by crossed cheque made payable to the Central Organization of Trade Unions (Kenya) into that organization's account No. 229-741-204 at Kenya Commercial Bank, Moi Avenue Branch, P.O. Box 48400, Nairobi;
- (iv) to notify that trade union and the organization in writing within one (1) month of the payment;
- (v) to make written returns to the Registrar of Trade Unions within one (1) month of making all the payments to that trade union and to that organization.
