THE ELECTION PETITIONS, 2013

DESIGNATION OF HIGH COURT JUDGES TO PARTICIPATE IN SERVICE WEEK

I, WILLY MUTUNGA, Chief Justice and President of the Supreme Court, in exercise of the general powers of direction and control vested upon me as Head of the Judiciary under Article 161(2)(a) of the Constitution as read together with Section 5(2)(c) of the Judicial Service Act;

IN CONSULTATION with the Law Society of Kenya acting pursuant to Section 4 (c), (d) and (e) of the Law Society of Kenya Act; and

IN COLLABORATION with the Director of Public Prosecutions, the Department of Prisons, the Probation Department and the Community Service Orders; and

RECOGNISING THAT on account of the diversion and concentration of the human and material resources of the High Court towards the hearing and determination of the Election Petitions

throughout the Republic of Kenya since completion of the elections of 4th March, 2013; and

CONCERNED THAT the curtailment of the fundamental rights and freedoms of citizens incarcerated pursuant to sentences imposed by subordinate courts in respect of which appeals were filed, but which could not be expeditiously heard on account of the said concentration by the Judiciary on Election Petition hearings; and

NOTING THE constitutional imprimatur as to the right to an expeditious and fair hearing of such appellants before a duly constituted court; NOTING FURTHER that the national prisons are excessively congested, over-crowded and inadequate compared to the available facilities for prisoners;

HEREBY DIRECT that a Service Week be conducted wherein the Judges of the superior court named hereunder are hereby authorized to expeditiously hear criminal appeals from subordinate courts and to consider reviews of sentences under law for purposes of decongestion of prisons pursuant to such instructions and guidelines as may be issued by the Principal Judge of the High Court. Such hearings and reviews shall be conducted within the period from 14th through 18th

October, 2013, in the High Courts situated country-wide, and determination rendered thereafter.
